## Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey June 2022. Provisional Data

# Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations reached 13.4 million, compared to 7.3 million in the same month of 2021

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 13.4 million in June, compared to 7.3 million for same month of 2021; this supposed an increase of 82.9%. Overnight stays by residents increased by 20.6%, and those by non-resident by 279.2%.

The average stay stood at 3.9 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first six months of 2022, overnight stays increased 159.7%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.


### **Holiday Dwellings**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 132.7% in June. Resident overnight stays grew by 24.1%, and those of non-residents by 355.0%.

The average stay increased 15.9% as compared with June 2021, and stood at 4.9 overnight stays per traveller.


In June, 38.1% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 92.5% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 42.8%, with an increase of 68.0%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 64.2% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with more than 1.5 million. The following country of origin was Germany, with 517,079.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.7 million overnight stays, and an increase of 223.4% as compared with June 2021. The autonomous community with the highest occupancy was Comunidad de Madrid, with 81.7% of apartments offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 768,715 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza-Formentera showed the highest occupancy rate, with 77.9% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in June were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

### **Campgrounds**

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered in June an increase of 42.4% as compared with the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 11.9% and non-resident overnight stays by 181.5%.

During June, 41.8% of the pitches offered were occupied, 21.1% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 48.0%, with a 18.3% annual increase.

Non-residents accounted for 35.6% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 22.2% of overnight stays by non-residents, 225.3% more than in June of 2021.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 2.5 million overnight stays, representing a increase of 57.1% in the annual rate. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 58.5% of the pitches offered.


By tourist area, the Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 1.1 million overnight stays. Costa Blanca had the highest occupancy rate, with 69.1% of apartments offered.

The tourist spots with the most overnight stays were Mont-Roig del Camp, Torroella de Montgríand Benidorm.

### Rural tourism accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 28.8% in June. Resident overnight stays grew by 9.2%, and those of non-residents by 107.7%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 20.1% of the bed-places were occupied, 20.1% more than June 2021. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 39.5%, with an annual increase of 16.9%.

### Occupancy rate




By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 198,135 overnight stays, 61.1% more than in June 2021. This Autonomous Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 64.6% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 158,307 overnight stays. In Isla de Menorca, the highest occupancy rate was reached, with 71.3% of the bed-places offered.

### Distribution of overnight stays: residents



### **Hostels**

In June, there were 837,135 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 281.6%. Resident overnight stays increased by 174.7% and non-resident overnight stays by 638.7%.


### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



Of the available bed-places, 36.6% were occupied, 161.1% more than in June 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 38.9%, with a 114.1% increase.

Percentage




Galicia was the main destination, with 195,348 overnight stays. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 70.0% of the bed-places offered.

### **Price indices**

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 11.7% in June compared to the same month of 2021, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 5.4%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 7.1%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In June, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased by 125.0% in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 29.9%, and those of non-residents by 320.6%.


The average stay grew by 19.9%, to 3.4 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 72.3% corresponded to hotels, and 27.7% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 29.8% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (19.3%) and France (7.7%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with over 10.5 million overnightstays (248.2% more than in June 2021). It was followed by Cataluña, with over 9.6 million overnight stays (and an increase of 124.4%) and Andalucía, with over 7.1 million, (and an annual increase of 81.5%).

### Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for June 2021 of the Occupancy Surveys in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

### Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation**: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** guestionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
