

## Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey June 2023. Provisional Data

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decreased by 3.0%, as compared with the same month in 2022**

**Cumulative overnight stays since January grew by 9.1% and are 7.4% higher than in the same period in 2019**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday apartments, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) decreased by 3.0% in June, compared to the same month in 2022. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 8.6%, while those by non-residents increased by 2.6%.

The average stay stood at 3.8 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first six months of 2023, overnight stays increased 9.1%, as compared to the same period of the previous year. Moreover, they are 7.4% higher than in the first six months of 2019.

### Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday apartments decreased by 5.2% in June, as compared with the same month in 2022. Resident overnight stays decreased by 13.9% and non-resident overnight stays by 0.3%.

The average stay decreased by 2.1%, standing at 4.8 overnight stays per traveller.

In June, 35.1% of the bed-places available for holiday apartments were occupied, 8.1% less than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 38.6%, with a decrease of 9.9%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday apartments represented 67.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 1.6 million overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 484,338.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.7 million overnight stays, and a decrease of 0.5% as compared with June 2022. Illes Balears had the highest occupancy, at 78.4% of the apartments offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 803,204 overnight stays. Isla de Lanzarote had the highest occupancy rate, with 80.8% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in June were Arona, Tías and San Bartolomé de Tirajana.

## Campgrounds


Overnight stays at campsites registered a decrease of 0.4% in June, as compared with the same month in 2022. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 4.1% while those by non-residents increased by 6.4%.

During June, 40.6% of the pitches offered were occupied, 0.8% less than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 43.8%, with a 6.0% annual decrease.

Non-residents accounted for 61.9% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 23.1% of overnight stays by non-residents, 10.5% more than in June 2022.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 2.4 million overnight stays, representing a decrease of 2.3% in the annual rate. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 61.5% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, the Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with more than 1.1 million overnight stays. Costa Blanca (Alicante) had the highest occupancy rate, with 68.1% of the campsites offered.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Torroella De Montgrí, Mont-Roig del Camp and Benidorm.

## Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 0.9% in June. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 2.7%, while those by non-residents increased by 8.4%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



In rural tourism accommodation, 19.8% of the bed-places were occupied, 2.2% less than June 2022. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 34.7%, with an annual decrease of 12.1%.

Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 200,209 overnight stays, 1.1% fewer than in June 2022. It also achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 62.5% of campsites offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 163,308 overnight stays. Isla de Menorca reached the highest occupancy rate, with 67.2% of the bed-places offered.

Percentage




### Hostels

In June, there were 832,080 overnight stays in hostels, which is an annual decrease of 5.3%. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 19.0% while those by non-residents increased by 13.0%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay


Percentage



35.0% of the bed-places were occupied, 10.2% less than in June 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 35.4%, with a 10.4% decrease.

Percentage




Galicia was the main destination, with 202,526 overnight stays. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 67.5% of the bed-places offered.

## Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 9.3% in June, compared to the same month of 2022, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 4.9%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 5.1%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In June, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, apartments, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) registered a 1.5% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 3.8% while those by non-residents increased by 4.9%.

The average stay decreased by 1.7%, to 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 73.4% corresponded to hotels, and 26.6% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 30.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (17.7%) and France (7.4%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with more than 10.5 million overnight stays. It was followed by Cataluña, with more than 9.5 million, and Andalucía, with more than 7.2 million.

## Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for June 2022 of the Occupancy Survey in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

## Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such a way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample size:** approximately 1,200 establishments.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
