Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey July 2008. Provisional data

Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation decrease 0.3% in July, as compared with the same month in 2007

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 17.6 million in July, 0.3% less than in the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays of residents decreased 6.0%, whereas those of non-residents increased 4.0%.

The average stay increased 0.9% as compared with July 2007, standing at 6.4 nights per traveller.

During the first seven months of the year, overnight stays decreased 1.0%, as compared with the same period the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 3.1%, while those by non-residents increased 0.1%.



Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 0.7% in July


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 9.4 million in July, representing a 0.7% decrease as compared with the same month last year. Resident overnight stays decreased by 4.9%, while non-resident overnight stays increased by 1.2%.

Available holiday dwellings increased 0.3%, exceeding 552,000 bedplaces. This month, 54.1% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 1.5% less than in July 2007. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 64.9% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 2.8%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 70.1% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, 3.3% less than in July of last year.

The following market was Germany, with over 1,234,800 overnight stays and an interannual rate of 1.9%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling **destination**, with more than 3.2 million overnight stays, 2.2% less than in July 2007. Illes Balears was the second destination of choice, with more than 2.2 million overnight stays, 1.1% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the main destinations of choice. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays of resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias and Cataluña.

Illes Balears presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 70.5% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Andalucía (52.9%) and Cataluña (52.1%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with more than 1.4 million overnight stays in July and an occupancy rate of 76.7%.


San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tias and Arona were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.

Prices for holiday dwellings increase 6.0% in July


The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 6.0% increase in July, a rate 4.1 points lower than that recorded the previous month.

The tour-operator and travel agency rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (52%), registered a 7.8% interannual rate increase.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 60.4%, increased their prices 6.4% as compared with July 2007.



Overnight stays on tourist campsites remain the same



Overnight stays on tourist campsites exceeded the figure of 7.2 million in July, a very similar figure to the same month in 2007. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 7.9%, while those by non-residents increased 9.0%.

Tourist campsites offered more than 747 thousand bedplaces, 0.5% more than in the same month of 2007. 48.1% of the available lots were occupied, for a 4.6% increase in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate reached 52.6%, that is, 0.9% more than in July 2007.

50.9% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The Netherlands was the main country of origin**, with 37.7% of overnight stays by non-residents (17.0% more). The following country of origin was the France.


Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with almost 4.0 million overnight stays, 3.9% more than in July 2007. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with more than 658,000 overnight stays, indicating a decrease of 5.8%.

Among non-residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites in July, with 66.3% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Cataluña (57.5%) and País Vasco (55.0%).

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 2.2 million overnight stays in July. Parque Nacional Aiguamolls de l'Empordá recorded the highest occupancy rate by lot (73.6%). The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Torroella de Montgrí, Castell-Platja d'Aro and Salou.

Prices of tourist campsites increase 5.2%





The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 5.2% in July. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weight structure for this month (85.4%), increased 5.7%.

Regarding category, luxury and first-class, with a weighting of 50.4% in July, recorded an interannual increase of 5.0%.

Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation decrease 2.6% in July as compared with the same month of the previous year

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation surpassed 993,000 in July, with an interannual decrease of 0.7%. Overnight stays by residents decreased 2.6%, and non-resident stays increased 6.5%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 119,717 bedplaces, 10.3% more than in July 2007. 26.5% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 9.9% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 38.0%, that is, 5.8% less.




Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with more than 143,000 overnight stays, 2.1% less than in July 2007. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 118,805 overnight stays, 5.3% less.

Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Asturias and Cataluña.

In July, Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 64.7% of the available bedplaces occupied. It was followed by País Vasco (44.4%) and Cantabria (35.1%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 66,585 overnight stays. This area also reached the highest occupancy rate, 64.5%.

Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 4.0%



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered interannual growth of 4.0% in July. The normal rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weightings structure this month (68.1%), rose 3.6%.

By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 64.7%, recorded an interannual increase of 3.9%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) **registered a 0.5% interannual increase in July**. Resident overnight stays decreased 3.5%, and non-resident overnight stays increased 3.3%.


The average stay grew 0.3% and stood at 4.4 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of July, 66% were accounted for at hotels and 34% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were The United Kingdom, with 25.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays, Germany, with 23.7% and The Netherlands, with 9.7%.

Cataluña was the **preferred destination** regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 11.8 million overnight stays, 3.6% more than in July 2007. It was followed by Illes Balears, with 11.1 million overnight stays (0.8% less) and Canarias, with more than eight million overnight stays (0.7% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Cataluña and Canarias. On the other hand, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Canarias were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
