Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
July 2012. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease 0.8% in July, as compared with the same month of 2011

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 17.2 million in July, 0.8% less than in the same month of 2011. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 5.8%, whilst by non-residents increased 3.2%. The average stay increased 3.0%, standing at 6.0 overnights per traveller.

During first seven months of the year, overnight stays decreased 1.1%, as compared with the same period the previous year.

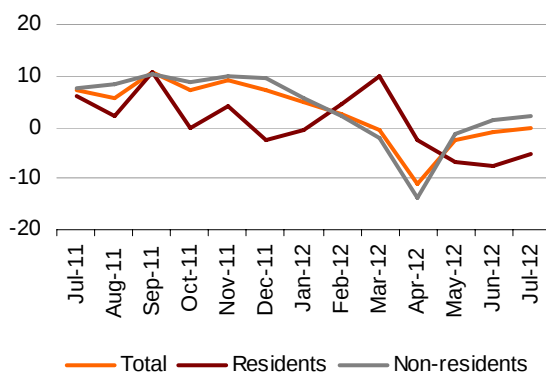
Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 0.2% in July. Overnight stays of residents decreased 5.3%, whilst of non-residents increased 2.3%

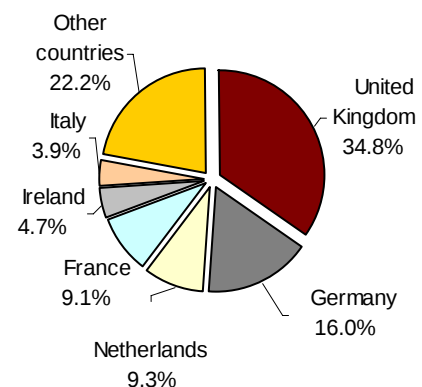
The average stay decreased 0.1%, standing at 7.3 overnights stays per traveller.

In July, 51.5% of the total available bedplaces for holiday dwellings were occupied, 0.6% less than in July 2011. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 54.9%, with an increase of 3.3%.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings of non-resident travellers by country of origin in %



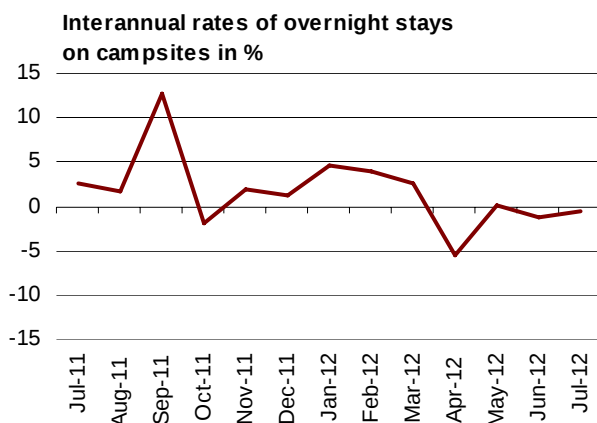
Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 69.5% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 2.3 million overnight stays, 5.3% less than in July last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with one million overnight stays, 14.6% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with a decrease of 0.8% and Illes Balears, with 1.2% less. Illes Balears presented the highest occupancy rate with 82.3% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in holiday dwellings, with 1.2 million overnight stays, and an occupancy of 87.4% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Tourist Campsites



The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an interannual decrease of 0.6%, in July. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 4.1%, and non-resident travellers increased 3.7%.

43.0% of the offered lots were occupied, 3.7% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 48.2%, with an interannual decrease of 1.5%.

47.1% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 39.8% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 7.8% more than in July 2011.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 3.8 million overnight stays, 2.8% more. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 68.6% of the lots offered.

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 2.1 million overnight stays. The coast of Gipuzkoa reached the highest occupancy rate, with 64.2% of the lots offered.

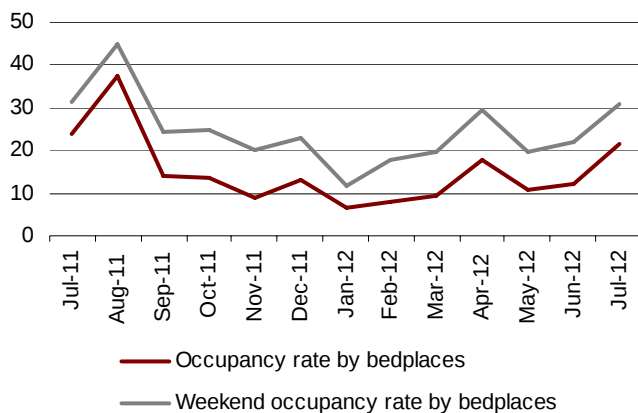
The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Torroella de Montgrí, Castelló d'Empúries and Sant Pere Pescador.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

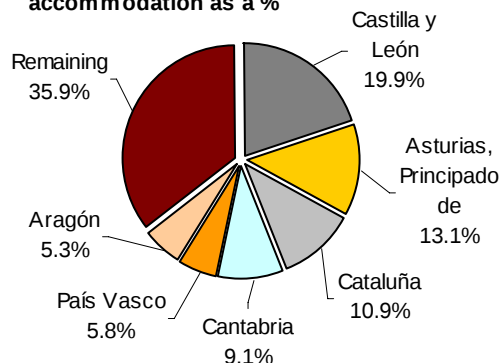
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an interannual decrease of 7.5%, in July. Resident overnight stays dropped 15.6%, whereas those of non-residents growth 18.3%.

21.4% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 10.4% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 30.7%, with a decrease of 2.3%.

Castilla y Leon was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 153,216 overnight stays, 9.8% less than in July 2011. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 69.5% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 96,305 overnight stays. The island of Ibiza and Formentera reached the greatest occupancy (75.3% of the offered bedplaces).

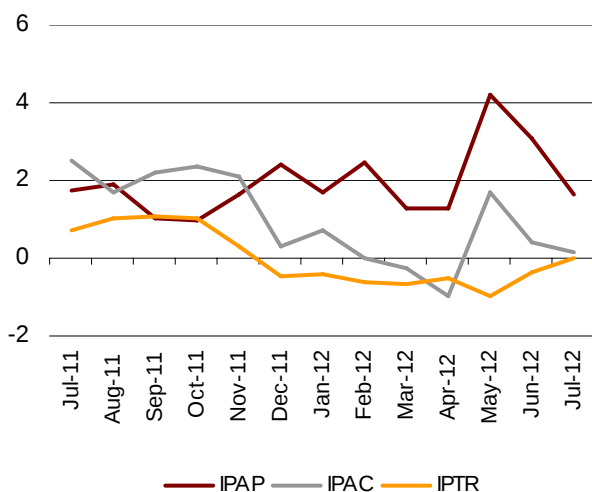
Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 1.7% in July, rate 1.4 points lower than registered the previous month. The *normal* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (47.7%), registered an increase of 0.6%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index registered an increase of 0.1%, as compared with July 2011. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (84.5%), increased 0.1%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index almost unchanged as compared with the same month previous year. The *normal* rate, which accounted for 54.6% of the total weight, increased 0.5%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In July, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a decrease of 1.2%.

Overnight stays by residents decreased 9.2%, whereas non-resident stays increased 4.0%. The average stay increased 2.6%, standing at 4.4 nights per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of July, 69% were accounted for at hotels, and 31% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were United Kingdom (with 25.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (21.1%) and France (9.0%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 12.7 million overnight stays (2.0% more than in July 2011). It was followed by Cataluña, with more than 12. million overnight stays (0.9% more) and Canarias, with more than 8.1 million overnight stays (0.8% less).
