Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
July 2021 Provisional Data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased by 58.0% in July, as compared with the same month of 2020

The overnight stays of travellers residing in Spain stood about the levels from before the pandemic. They were 19.3% higher than those of July 2019

During the first seven months of 2021, overnight stays increased 29.1%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.


Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist lodgings (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 16.0 million in July, 58.0% more than in the same month of 2020.

By traveler origin, overnight stays by travelers resident in Spain amounted to 11.6 million, 51.2% more than in July 2020. Those of non-residents reached 4.4 million, with an increase of 79.4%.


Compared to July 2019, overnight stays in non-hotel establishments showed a decrease of 21.7%. However, it should be noted that overnight stays by travellers residing in Spain were above the levels before the pandemic, exceeding those registered in July 2019 by 19.3%. In turn, overnight stays by non-residents fell by 59.1%.

During the first seven months of 2021, overnight stays increased 29.1%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

Open establishments

In July, a total of 157,617 non-hotel accommodations were open in Spain, which represented 80.7% of the total directory of establishments in this month.

Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in tourist apartments reached 6.5 million in July, 88.0% more than in July 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers grew by 81.2% and non-resident overnight stays by 101.7%.

During the first seven months of 2021, the total number of overnight stays rose by 2.6% compared to the same period of 2020.

By communities, Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucia and Canarias were the main destinations for travellers in the month of July, with 1.7, 1.1 and 1.0 overnight stays, respectively.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred tourist apartment destination, with 927,473 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza-Formentera showed the highest occupancy rate, with 74.6% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in July were Bernidorm, San Bartolomé de Tirajana and Oropesa del Mar.

Tourist Campsites

Overnight stays in camping sites came to 7.2 million in July, 45.2% more than in July 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 43.3%, and those by non-residents by 51.6%.

During the first seven months of 2021, the total of overnight stays in this type of accommodation rose by 63.7% compared to the same period of 2020.

In July, 45.7% of available pitches were occupied, and the weekend occupancy rate reached 49.7%.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for campsites, with more than 3.0 million overnight stays La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 73.5% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Brava was the preferred destination in July, with 1.3 million overnight stays. Costa Blanca had the highest occupancy rate, with 70.7% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with more overnight stays were Torroella De Montgrí, Tarragona and Mont-Roig del Camp.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodations rose to more than 1.6 million in June, 15.9% more than in the same month of 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 6.7%, and those by non-residents by 90.4%.

During the first seven months of 2021, the number of overnight stays rose by 34.2% compared to the same period of the previous year.

In rural tourism accommodation, 32.3% of bedplaces were occupied in July. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 42.1%.

By autonomous communities, Principado de Asturias was the preferred destination, with 229,085 overnight stays. On the other hand, Illes Balears had the highest occupancy rate, with 57.2% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 141,975 overnight stays. In Isla de Menorca, the highest occupancy rate was reached, with 72.4% of the bed-places offered.

Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels¹ stood at 607,627 in July, 147.4% more than for the same month of 2020. Resident overnight stays grew by 144.3% and non-resident overnight stays by 168.7%.

During the first six four of 2021, the total of overnight stays fell by 41.8% compared to the same period of 2020.

In July, 29.6% of bed-places were occupied. The weekend occupancy rate reached 28.9%.

By communities, Galicia was the main destination, with 143,271 overnight stays. In July, Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 59.5% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 9.3% in July compared to the same month of 2020, the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) by 1.0%, and the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 3.9%.

¹ Since January 2021, tourist hostels have been included in the survey, in addition to those belonging to the Spanish Youth Hostels Network. The data published are not comparable with those of July 2020, and [link coefficients](#) are thus published to allow the annual variation rates to be calculated.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In July, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels², holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased to 42.4 million. This represented an increase of 93.9% compared to the same month of 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers grew by 74.1% and non-resident overnight stays by

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodations in July, 62.2% corresponded to hotels, and 37.8% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were Germany (with 20.8% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), France (16.2%), and the United Kingdom (12.7%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with more than 8.1 million overnight stays. These are followed by Andalucía (with more than 7.4 million) and Illes Balears (with more than 6.8 million).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for July 2020 of the Occupancy Surveys in: Holiday Dwellings (HDOS), Campsites (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodation (RTAOS) and Hostels (HOS). As well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
