Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
July 2022. Provisional Data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations reached 21.8 million, compared to 15.9 million in the same month of 2021

The accumulated overnight stays of the first seven months are above the levels prior to the pandemic, exceeding those of the same period in 2019

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 21.8 million in July, compared to 15.9 million for same month of 2021; this supposed an increase of 36.8%. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 1.1% while those by non-residents increased by 135.8%.

The average stay stood at 4.7 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first seven months of 2022, overnight stays increased 103.1%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

Holiday Dwellings

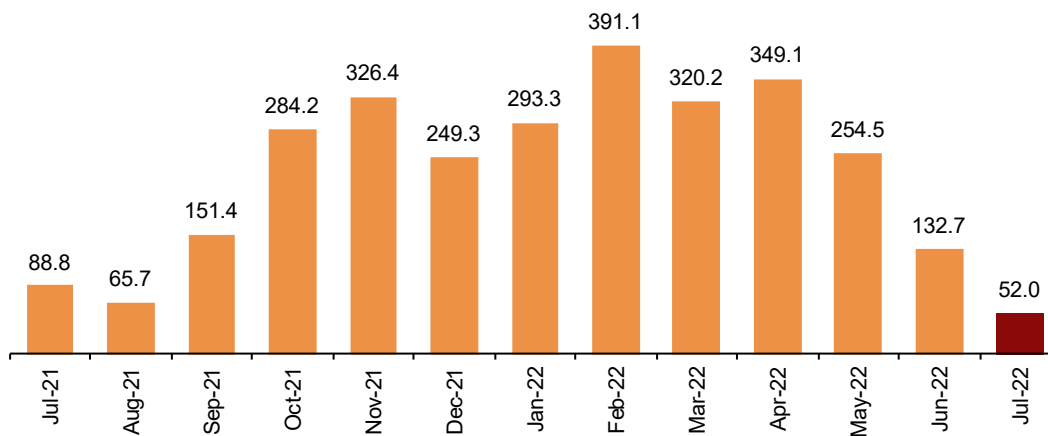
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 52.0% in July. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 8.7%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 163.2%.

The average stay increased 8.7% as compared with June 2021, standing at 5.6 overnight stays per traveller.

In July, 51.5% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 36.5% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 53.1%, with an increase of 33.6%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay

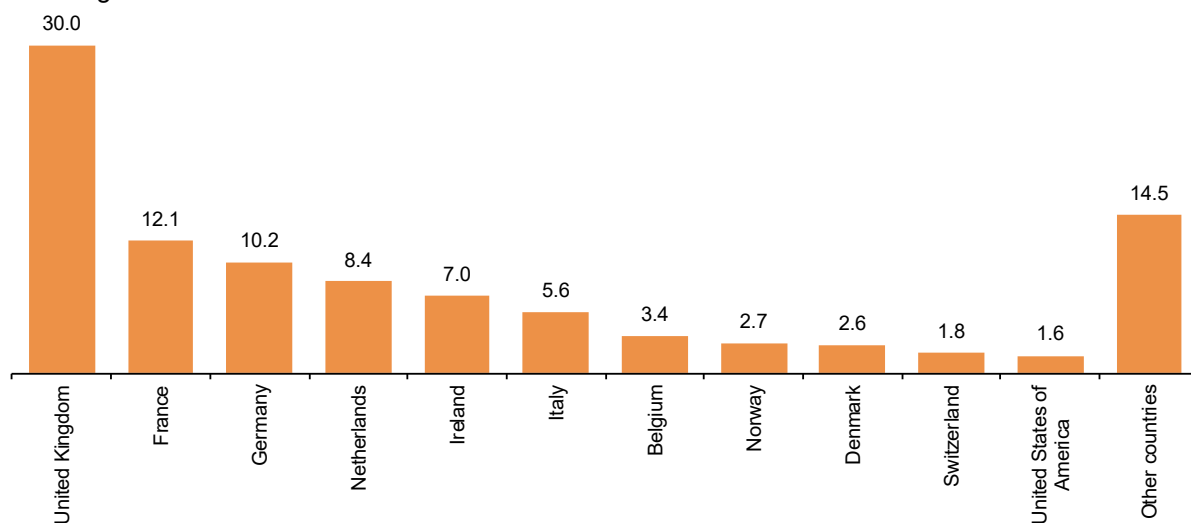
Percentage



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 61.2% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with more than 1.8 million. The following country of origin was France, with 735,493.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.3 million overnight stays, and an increase of 119.9% as compared with July 2021. La comunidad autónoma con mayor ocupación es Illes Balears, con el 77,3% de los apartamentos ofertados.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with more than 1.1 million overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza-Formentera showed the highest occupancy rate, with 86.7% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in July were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

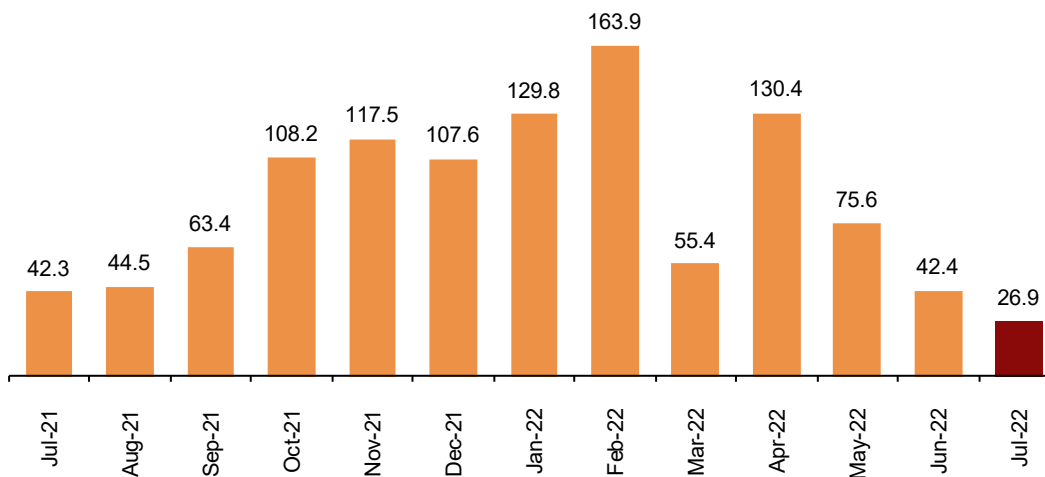
Campgrounds

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered in July an increase of 26.9% as compared with the same month of the previous year. Those by residents grew by 1.9% and those by non-residents did so by 107.6%.

During July, 52.2% of the pitches offered were occupied, 16.1% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 55.3%, with a 12.0% annual increase.

Non-residents accounted for 38.7% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 30.2% of overnight stays by non-residents, 110.4% more than in July of 2021.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 4.3 million overnight stays, representing an increase of 44.1% in the annual rate. País Vasco reached the highest occupancy rate, with 70.2% of campsites offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with more than two million overnight stays. Costa Blanca (Alicante) had the highest occupancy rate, with 73.4% of the campsites offered.

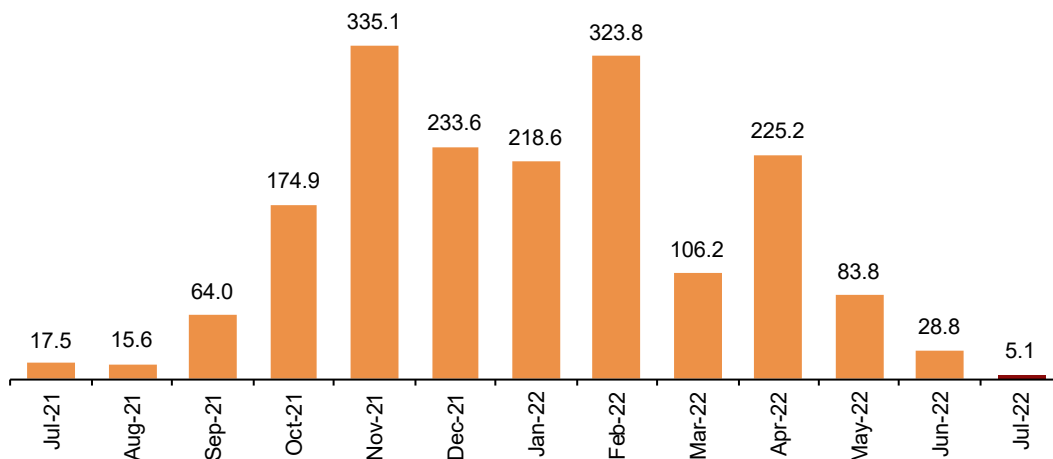
The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Torroella De Montgrí, Mont-Roig del Camp and Tarragona.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 5.1% in July. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 7.3%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 61.8%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay

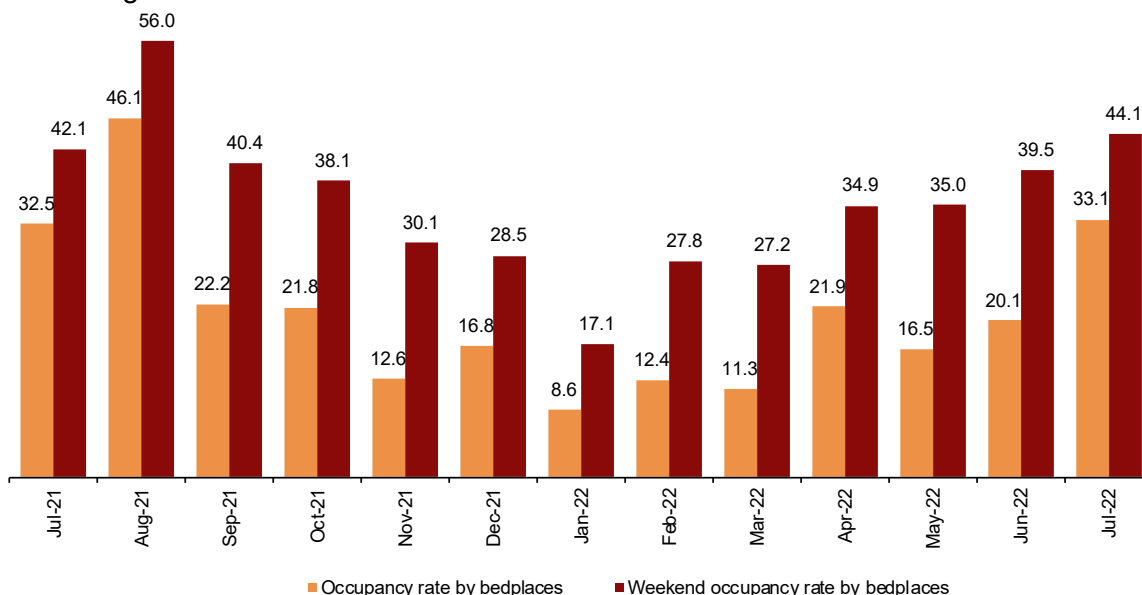

In rural tourism accommodation, 33.1% of the bed-places were occupied, 1.9% more than July 2021. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 44.1%, with an annual increase of 4.6%.

Percentage

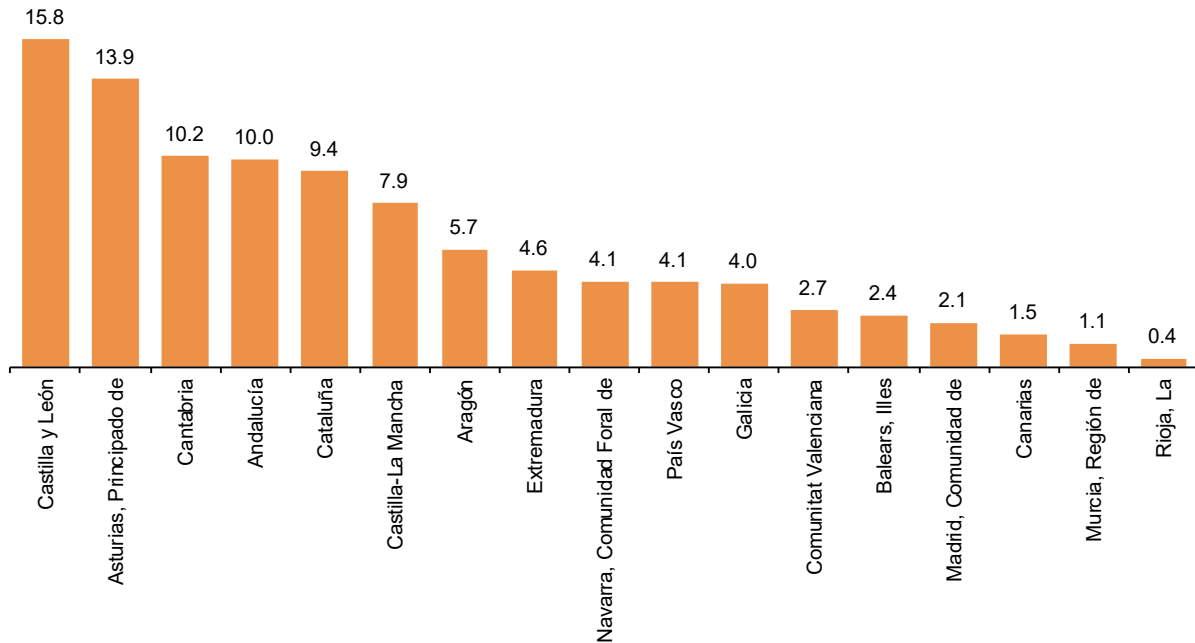


By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 224,211 overnight stays, 23.0% more than in July 2021. This Autonomous Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 69.1% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 178,911 overnight stays. In Isla de Menorca, the highest occupancy rate was reached, with 75.2% of the bed-places offered.

Percentage

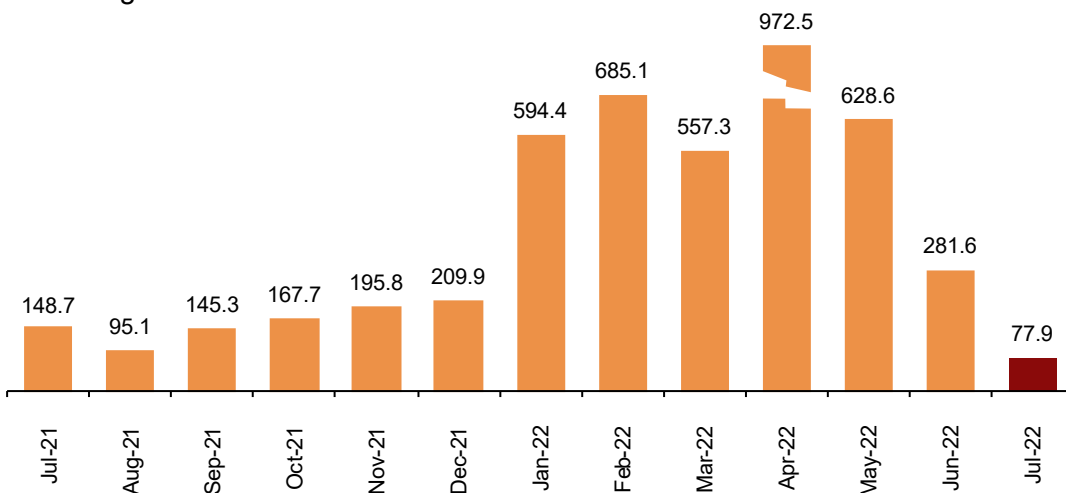


Hostels

In July, there were more than 1.1 million overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 77.9%. Resident overnight stays increased by 48.5% and non-resident overnight stays by 190.2%.

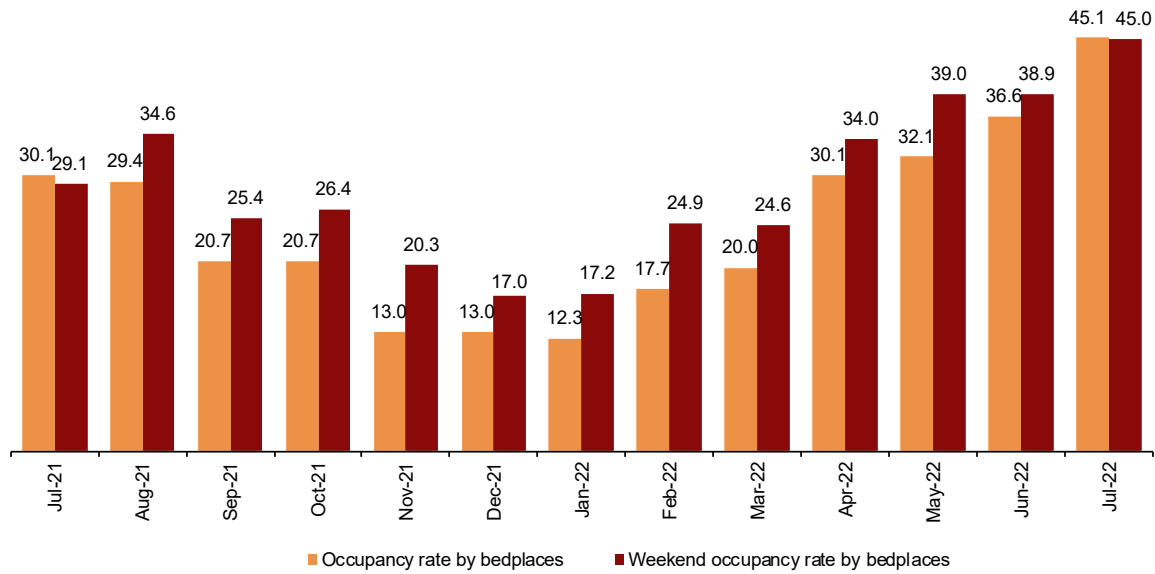
Annual variation rate for overnight stay

Of the available bed-places, 45.1% were occupied, 49.7% more than in July 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 45.0%, with a 54.6% increase.

Percentage

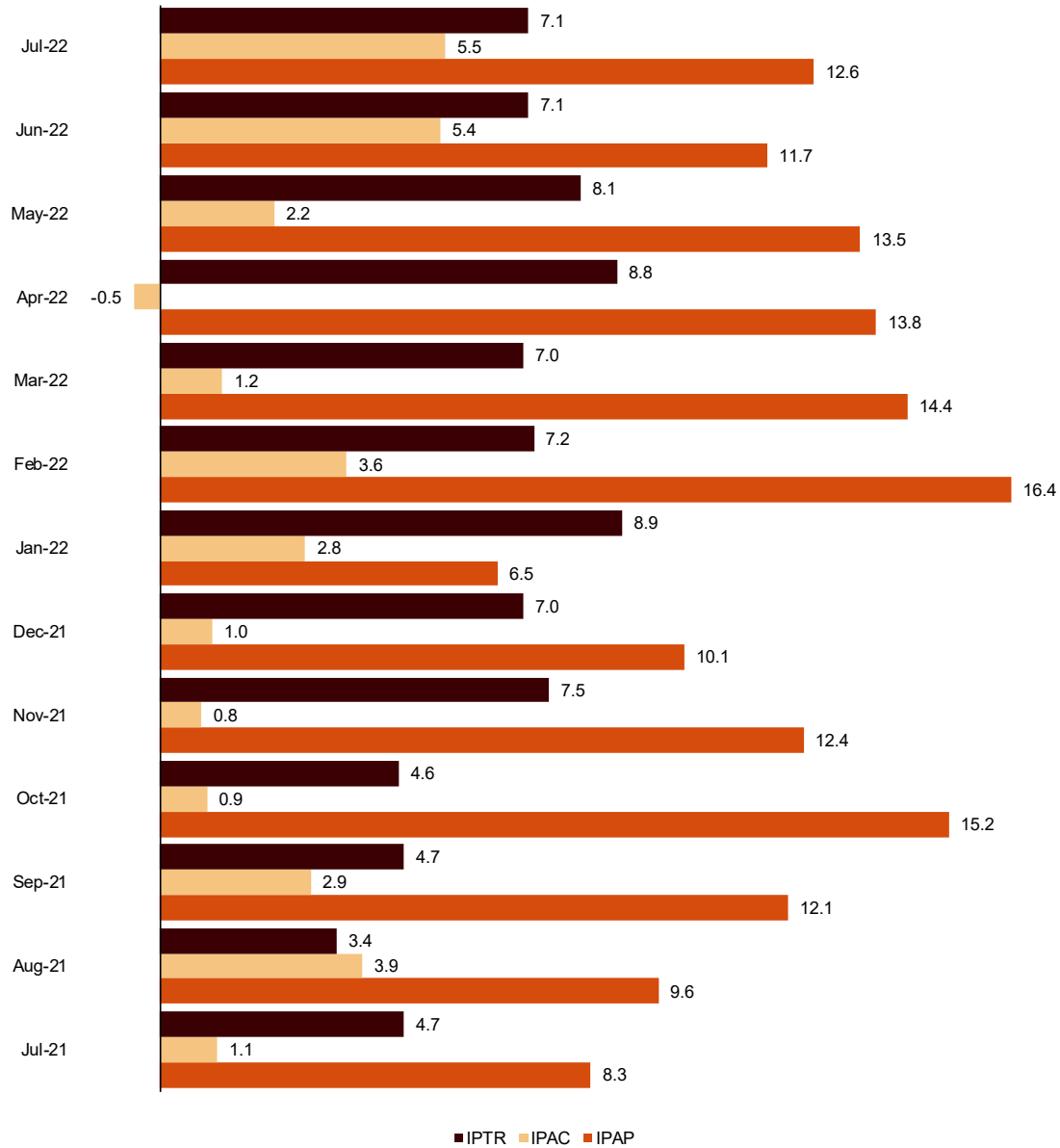


Galicia was the main destination, with 247,795 overnight stays. Comunitat Valenciana reached the highest occupancy rate, with 70.6% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 12.6% in July compared to the same month of 2021, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 5.5%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 7.1%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In July, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased by 51.7% in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 2.6%, and those of non-residents by 133.1%.

The average stay grew by 9.3%, to 3.8 overnight stays per traveller.

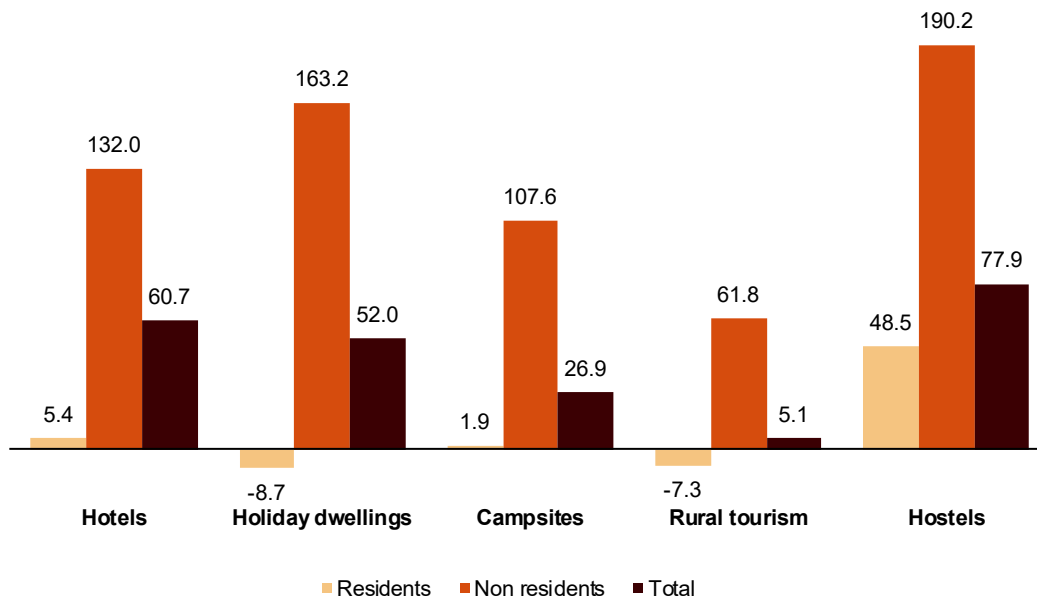

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 65.9% corresponded to hotels, and 34.1% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 25.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (15.4%) and France (11.3%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with over 13.9 million overnight stays (72.9% more than in July 2021). It was followed by Illes Balears, with over 12.5 million overnight stays (and an increase of 84.1%) and Andalucía, with over 9.1 million, (and an annual increase of 23.7%).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for July 2021 of the Occupancy Surveys in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
