Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
August 2010. Provisional data

Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation increase 2.4% in August as compared with the same month of 2009

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 21.5 million in August, 2.4% more than in the same month of 2009. This increase in overnight stays took place for both residents (whose interannual rate stood at 0.6%), and non-residents (4.6%). The average stay increased 0.8% as compared with August 2009, standing at 6.4 nights per traveller.

In the period comprised of July and August, overnight stays increased 2.9% as compared with the same period of 2009. Overnight stays by resident guests increased 1.6%, and those by non-residents increased 4.3%. In the first eight months of the year, overnight stays increased 0.9% as compared with the same period the previous year.

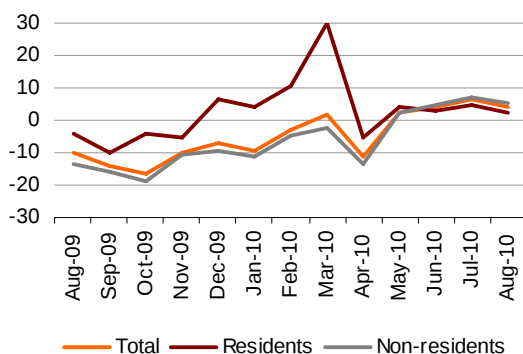

Holiday Dwellings

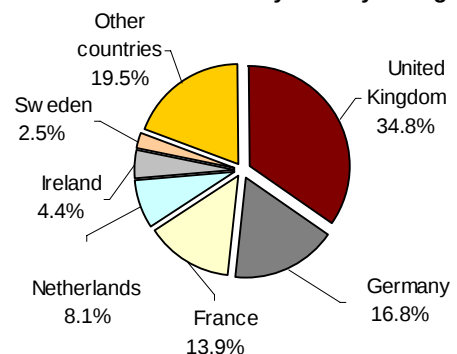
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 10.3 million in August, representing an interannual increase of 4.3%. This increase in overnight stays took place for both residents (2.5%), and non-residents (5.5%). The average stay decreased 0.5% as compared with August 2009, standing at 8.4 nights per traveller.

In the period comprised of July and August, overnight stays increased 5.1% as compared with the same two months of 2009.

Available holiday dwellings increased 0.9%, reaching 568,417 bedplaces. This month, 58.2% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 2.8% more than in August 2009. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 60.5%, with an increase of 5.6%. In turn, 70.2% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual increase of 2.2%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 61.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 2.2 million overnight stays, 4.9% more than in August of last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with more than one million overnight stays, 17.1% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 3.1 million overnight stays, 5.9% more than in August 2009. The second destination of choice was Illes Balears, with more than 2.3 million overnight stays, 8.5% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias and Cataluña.

Illes Balears showed the highest occupancy rate, with 84.1% of the available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Cantabria (75.4%) and Galicia (73.4%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 1.3 million overnight stays and an occupancy of 85.8% of the available holiday dwellings.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona.

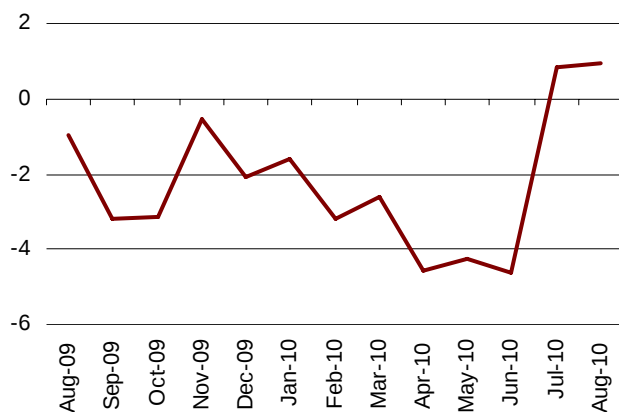
Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 0.9% increase in August, a rate 0.1 points higher than that recorded the previous month.

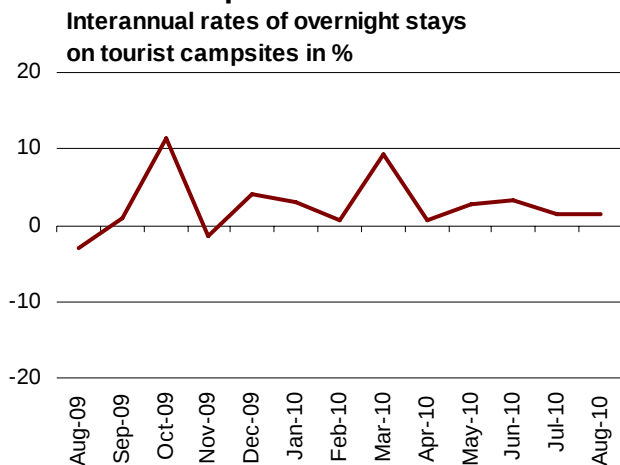
The *normal* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (49.6%), registered an increase of 0.7% as compared with the same month the previous year.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 56.2%, increased their prices by 0.6%.

Tourist Campsites



Tourist campsites exceeded 9.5 million overnight stays in the month of August, indicating an interannual increase of 1.4%. Overnight stays of resident travellers increased 0.5%, and those of non-resident travellers 2.9%. In the July-August period the overnight stays increased 1.4%.

Tourist campsites offered 748,917 bedplaces, 0.1% less than in August 2009. 52.7% of the available lots were occupied, 0.8% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 56.1%, with an interannual decrease of 0.8%.

36.3% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. France was the main country of origin, with 31.9% of the overnight stays by non-residents (0.7% less than in August 2009). The following country of origin was the Netherlands.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 4.6 million overnight stays, 0.7% more. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with more than one million overnight stays, indicating an interannual increase of 0.6%.

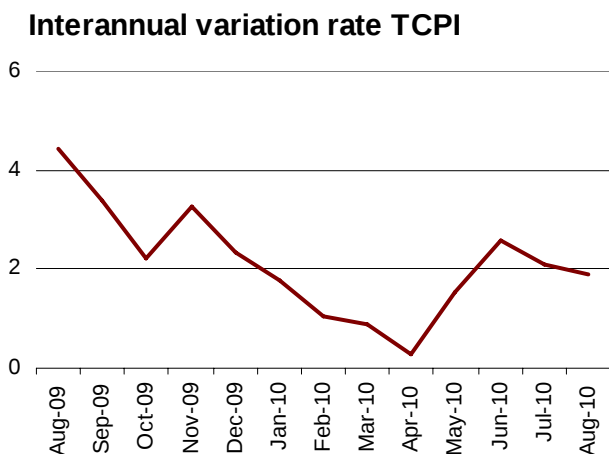
Among residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

País Vasco reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 76.8% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by La Rioja (76.0%) and Comunitat Valenciana (60.3%).

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 2.4 million overnight stays. Costa de Garraf reached the highest occupancy (89.5%).

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays in August were Torroella de Montgrí, Salou and Castelló d'Empúries.

Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced interannual growth of 1.9% in August. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (88.4%), presented an increase of 1.8%.

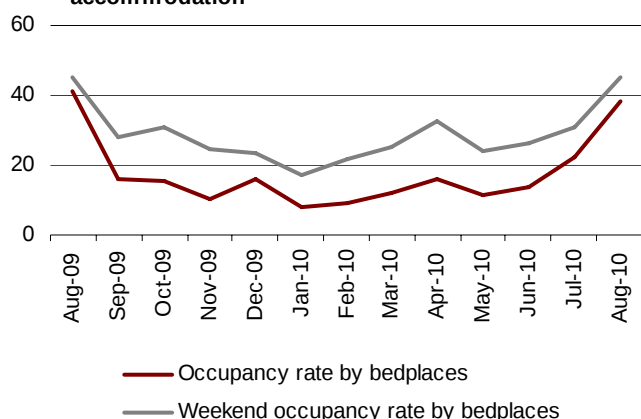
Regarding category, *luxury and first class*, with a weighting of 52.9% this month, registered an interannual increase of 3.1%.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

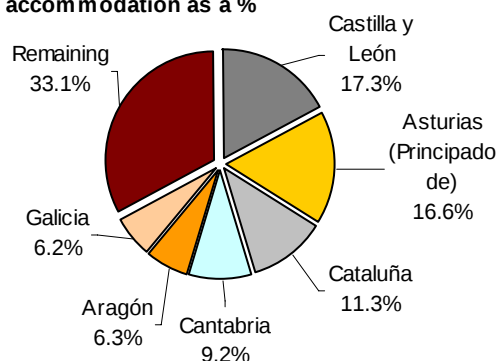
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation exceeded 1.6 million in August, indicating an interannual decrease of 2.8%. Resident overnight stays decreased 4.3%, whereas those by non-residents grew 6.5%. In the July-August period overnight stays decreased 2.8%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 136,735 bedplaces, 3.3% more than in August 2009. 38.6% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 5.9% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 45.0%, that is, 0.2% less in the interannual rate.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 259,669 overnight stays, 3.0% less than in August 2009. It was followed by Principado de Asturias, with 249,755 overnight stays, 6.1% more.

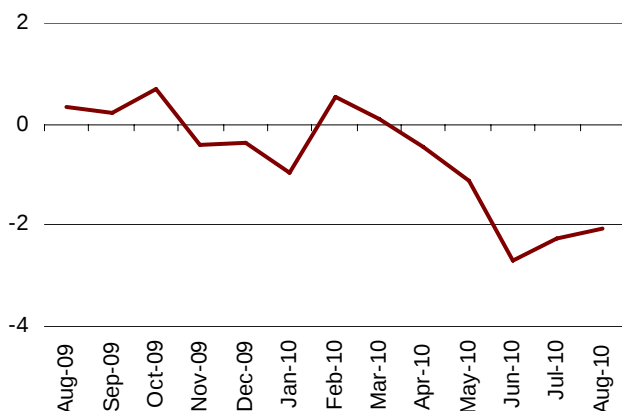
Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Principado de Asturias and Cataluña.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 65.9% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by Principado de Asturias (62.5%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (60.6%).

By tourist area, Costa Verde was the main destination, with 104,658 overnight stays in August. The islands of Ibiza and Formentera reached the highest occupancy (82.2%).

Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 2.1% in August.

The *normal* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (67.0%), fell 2.1%. By rent modality, *complete use*, whose weighting was 64.4%, registered an interannual decrease of 1.7% in August.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

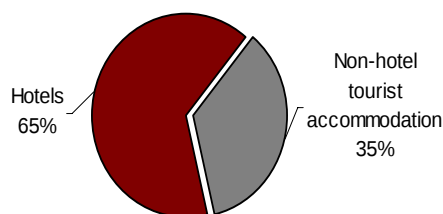
Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 6.7% in August**. Overnight stays by residents increased 1.2% and non-resident stays increased 12.3%. In the **July-August period overnight stays increased 12.2%**.

The average stay decreased 1.1% in August, standing at 4.6 nights per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:

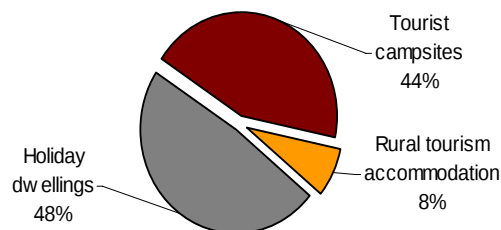

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of August, 65% were accounted for at hotels, and 35% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 24.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (22.0%) and France (12.6%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 13.9 million overnight stays (4.4% more than in August 2009). It was followed by Illes Balears, with more than 12.3 million overnight stays (13.1% more) and Canarias, with more than 8.9 million overnight stays (14.8% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Cataluña and Canarias. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
