Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys
September 2008. Provisional data

Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation decrease 3.2% in September, as compared with the same month in 2007

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 9.7 million in September, 3.2% less than in the same month of the previous year. The decrease in overnight stays of residents was recorded for both residents (with an interannual rate of -0.6%), and non-residents (-4.7%).

The average stay grew 1.4% as compared with September 2007, standing at 6.2 nights per traveller.

During the first nine months of the year, 90.7 million overnight stays were registered, 1.3% less than the same period the previous year.




Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 5.3% in September

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 6.6 million in September, representing a 5.3% decrease as compared with the same month last year. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at -7.1%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of -4.7%.

Available holiday dwellings increased 0.5%, exceeding 530,100 bedplaces. This month, 41.3% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 6.0% less than in September 2007. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 57.9% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 5.5%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 73.3% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays, 9.5% less than in September of last year. The following market was Germany, with nearly 990,000 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -7.8%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling **destination**, with more than 2.5 million overnight stays, 7.8% less than in September 2007. Illes Balears was the second destination of choice, with more than 1.6 million overnight stays, 5.1% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the main destinations of choice. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays of resident travellers were Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña.

Illes Balears presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 70.5% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (63.8%) and Andalucía (60.5%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with more than one million overnight stays in September and 79.6% of available dwellings occupied.

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.

Prices for holiday dwellings increase 1.7% in September

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 1.7% increase in September, a rate 5.3 points lower than that recorded the previous month.

The rate for *travel agencies and tour-operators*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (57.8%), registered a 3.5% interannual rate increase.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 65.9%, increased their prices 1.6% as compared with September 2007.

Overnight stays on tourist campsites increase 1.5%



Overnight stays on tourist campsites exceeded the figure of 2.5 million in September, representing an interannual increase of 1.5%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 8.7%, while those by non-residents decreased 6.5%.

Tourist campsites offered 666,575 bedplaces, 1.3% more than in the same month of 2007. 32.3% of the available lots were occupied, for a 1.8% increase in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate reached 34.5%, that is, 2.9% more than in September 2007.

43.9% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 23.7% of overnight stays by non-residents (12.8% less). The following country of origin was Germany.


Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 1.3 million overnight stays, 1.2% less than in September 2007. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 384,621 overnight stays, indicating an increase of 1.9%.

Among non-residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites in September, with 67.0% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (51.1%) and Comunidad de Madrid (47.2%).

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 583,000 overnight stays in September. Costa del Garraf recorded the highest occupancy rate by lot (59.4%). The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Salou, Benidorm and Blanes.

Prices of tourist campsites increase 1.6%



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 1.6% in September. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (70.8%), increased 1.6%.


Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 50.4% this month, recorded an interannual increase of 2.5%.

Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation decrease 0.8% in September as compared with the same month of the previous year


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation surpassed 631,850 in September, with an interannual increase of 1.2%. Overnight stays by residents decreased 0.8%, whereas non-resident stays increased 8.3%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 119,218 bedplaces, 11.2% more than in September 2007. 17.6% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing an 8.9% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 30.4%, that is, 0.1% less.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 103,158 overnight stays, 9.2% more than in September 2007. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 76,530 overnight stays, 18.2% more.


Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Principado de Asturias.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 60.9% of the available bedplaces occupied. It was followed by País Vasco (30.5%) and Cantabria (23.9%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 60,417 overnight stays and 61.8% of the available bedplaces occupied.

Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 3.8%

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered an interannual growth of 3.6% in September.

The *normal* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (60.6%), rose 3.2%.

By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 55.4%, recorded an interannual increase of 4.2%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) **registered a 2.9% interannual decrease in September**. Both resident overnight stays and non-resident overnight stays decreased 2.9%, respectively.


The average stay increased 0.6% and stood at 3.9 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of September, 75% were accounted for at hotels and 25% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom, with 30.4% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays, Germany, with 27.2%. and France, with 5.7%.

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than nine million overnight stays, 4.9% less than in September 2007. It was followed by Cataluña, with 7 million overnight stays (2.9% less) and Canarias, with 6.6 million overnight stays (3.0% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Canarias and Cataluña. On the other hand, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
