**Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
September 2010. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation increase
2.7% in September, as compared with the same month of 2009**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded nine million in September, 2.7% more than in the same month of 2009. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 4.6%, whereas those made by travellers not resident in Spain increased 7.6%.

The average stay decreased 2.4%, as compared with September 2009, standing at 5.7 nights per traveller.

During the first nine months of the year, overnight stays increased 1.1%, as compared with the same period the previous year.

Travellers and overnight stays in collective non-hotel tourist accommodation during the month of September were:



Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 5.9 million in September, representing an increase of 5.1% over the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents experienced a decrease of 1.3%, while those of non-residents increased 7.6%.

The average stay decreased 3.9%, as compared with September 2009, standing at 7.2 nights per traveller.

Holiday dwellings offered 536,129 bedplaces, 1.0% less than in September 2009. This month, 37.1% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 6.1% more in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 40.2%, with an increase of 7.4%. In turn, 54.1% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual increase of 8.1%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 73.2% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.8 million overnight stays, 5.1% more than in September last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 900,947 overnight stays, 12.1% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 2.1 million overnight stays, 4.9% more than in September 2009. The second destination of choice was Illes Balears, with more than 1.5 million overnight stays, 4.9% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

Illes Balears showed the highest occupancy rate, with 70.9% of the available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (63.5%) and Canarias (56.9%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 893,232 overnight stays and an occupancy of 76.3% of the available holiday dwellings.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona.


Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 2.4% decrease in September, a rate 1.5 points lower than that recorded the previous month.


The rate for *Tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (58.4%), registered a decrease of 2.1% as compared with the same month the previous year.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 63.8%, decreased their prices by 1.6%.

Tourist Campsites



Tourist campsites exceeded 2.4 million overnight stays in the month of September, indicating an interannual decrease of 0.5%. Overnight stays of resident travellers decreased 6.1%, whereas those of non-resident travellers increased 7.1%.

Tourist campsites offered 648,722 bedplaces, 0.4% less than in September 2009. 31.1% of the available lots were occupied, 1.1% more. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 34.9%, with an interannual increase of 3.6%.

45.8% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 24.8% of the overnight stays by non-residents (3.4% more than in September 2009). The following country of origin was Germany.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 1.1 million overnight stays, 6.2% less. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 400,540 overnight stays, indicating an interannual increase of 6.6%.


Among residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 60.7% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (47.7%) and Comunitat Valenciana (46.2%).

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 517,907 overnight stays. Costa de Maresme reached the highest occupancy (51.4%).

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays in September were Benidorm, Salou and Torroella de Montgrí.

Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual drop of 2.3% in September. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (70.3%), presented a decrease of 3.9%.


Regarding category, *luxury and first class*, with a weighting of 49.3% this month, registered an interannual decrease of 4.5%.

Rural Tourism Accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 588,946 in September, indicating an interannual decrease of 6.5%. Resident overnight stays decreased 11.2%, whereas those by non-residents grew 12.2%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 135,054 bedplaces, 2.8% more than in September 2009. 14.5% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 9.0% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 26.0%, that is, 7.2% less in the interannual rate.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 94,746 overnight stays, 8.8% less than in September 2009. It was followed by Illes Balears, with 76,899 overnight stays, 18.7% more.


Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Principado de Asturias and Cataluña.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 55.1% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by País Vasco (24.1%) and Cantabria (20.2%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 67,354 overnight stays in September and an occupancy of 57.9%.

Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 2.3% in September.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (51.1%), fell 2.3%. By rent modality, *complete use*, whose weighting was 50.7%, registered an interannual decrease of 2.0% in September.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 7.0% in September**. Overnight stays by residents decreased 0.8%, whereas non-resident stays increased 12.1%.

The average stay increased 0.1% in September, standing at 3.9 nights per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of September, 77% were accounted for at hotels, and 23% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 28.9% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (27.0%) and France (5.9%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than nine million overnight stays (9.5% more than in September 2009). It was followed by Cataluña, with more than seven million overnight stays (3.7% more) and Canarias, with more than 6.4 million overnight stays (11.3% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Canarias and Cataluña. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
