Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
September 2012. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 0.1% in September, as compared with the same month of 2011

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 9.8 million in September, 0.1% more than in the same month of 2011. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 5.7%, whilst by non-residents increased 3.6%. The average stay increased 0.3% as compared with September 2011, standing at 5.7 overnights per traveller.

In the first nine months of the year, overnight stays decreased 1.4% as compared with the same period the previous year.


Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings barely changed in September, as compared with the same month from the previous year. Overnight stays of residents decreased 8.2%, whilst of non-residents increased 3.0%.


The average stay decreased 1.3%, standing at 6.9 overnights stays per traveller.

In September, 40.1% of the total available bedplaces for holiday dwellings were occupied, 1.1% less than in September 2011. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 41.0%, with an annual decrease of 5.7%.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings of non-resident travellers by country of origin in %




Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 75.4% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than two million overnight stays, 0.8% less than in September last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 861,828 overnight stays, 1.8% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with a decrease of 5.0% and Illes Balears, with 1.2% less. Illes Balears presented the highest occupancy rate with 75.4% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in holiday dwellings, with one million overnight stays, and an occupancy of 81.9% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Tourist Campsites



The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an interannual increase of 0.9%, in September. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 1.6%, whilst non-resident travellers increased 3.9%.

31.7% of the offered lots were occupied, 1.6% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 34.1%, with an interannual decrease of 1.5%.

46.8% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. Germany was the main country of origin, with 22.0% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 0.3% more than in September 2011.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 1.4 million overnight stays, 7.1% more. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 61.2% of the lots offered.

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 646,071 overnight stays. La Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy rate, with 51.6% of the lots offered.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Salou, Benidorm and Sant Pere Pescador.

Rural Tourism Accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an interannual decrease of 1.4%, in September. Resident overnight stays dropped 9.8%, whereas those of non-residents growth 20.5%.

13.4% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 4.7% of annual decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 21.1%, with a decrease of 12.5%.

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 112,605 overnight stays, 31.2% more than in September 2011, reaching as well the highest occupancy rate, with 68.4% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 93,563 overnight stays. The island of Ibiza and Formentera reached the greatest occupancy (74.8% of the offered bedplaces).


Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an annual change of 1.2% in September, rate 0.1 points higher than registered the previous month. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (53.1%), registered an increase of 2.0%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index registered a decrease of 0.4%, as compared with September 2011. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (66.4%), increased 0.9%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered an interannual decrease of 0.8% in September. The *week end* rate, which accounted for 53.2% of the total weight, decreased 1.4%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In September, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) did not register any change.

Overnight stays by residents decreased 9.7%, whereas non-resident stays increased 5.3%.

The average stay increased 1.5%, standing at 4.0 nights per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of September, 76% were accounted for at hotels, and 24% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were United Kingdom (with 29.5% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (24.6%) and France (6.3%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 10.3 million overnight stays (2.4% more than in September 2011). It was followed by Cataluña, with more than 8.2 million overnight stays (4.6% more) and Canarias, with more than seven million overnight stays (2.2% less).
