Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
September 2013. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decreased 0.7% in September⁽¹⁾, as compared with the same month of 2012

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded 9.8 millions in September, 0.7% less than in the same month of 2012. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 3.2% while those of non-residents increased 0.6%. The average stay increased 0.2%, standing at 5.7 overnights per traveller.


During the first nine months of 2013, the overnight stays increased 0.4%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 0.5% in September. Overnight stays of residents decreased 1.0% whereas overnight stays of non-residents increased 1.1%. The average stay increased 0.6% standing at 7.0 overnight stays per traveller.




⁽¹⁾ Due to the update made in the rural tourist accommodation directory in Región de Murcia, the data published cannot be directly compared to those published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficient

In September, 40.0% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 0.8% less than in the same month of 2012. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 41.8%, with an annual increase of 1.5%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 75.2% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than two million overnight stays, 0.9% less than in September 2012. The following country of origin was Germany, with 940,944 overnight stays, 11.8% more.

Canarias and Illes Balears were the preferred holiday dwelling destinations, with annual rates of overnight stays of 1.4% and 2.9%, respectively. Illes Balears registered the highest occupancy rate with 80.6% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 949,669 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 87.5%.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona.


Campsites

The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered a 3.2% annual decrease in September. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 5.9%, whereas those of non-resident travellers did so by 0.2%.

During the month of September, 32.0% of the offered pitches were occupied, 1.5% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 33.3%, with an annual decrease of 0.9%.

48.5% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 22.0% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 11.2% more than in September 2012.

Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding campsites, with more than 1.3 million overnight stays, 4.7% less than in September 2012. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 58.7% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 551,344 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy, with 53.0% of the pitches offered.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Mont-Roig del Camp, Benidorm and Torroella de Montgrí.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual decrease of 3.8%, in September⁽¹⁾. Residents' overnight stays decreased 2.8%, and those of non-residents did so by 5.7%.

13.1% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 2.8% decrease, as compared to September 2012. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 24.1%, with an increase of 13.4%.


Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 102,986 overnight stays, 8.5% less than in September 2012. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate as well, with 64.9% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 84,733 overnight stays and an occupancy rate that stood at 66.5%.

Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in %




Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) registered an increase of 2.8%, as compared to September 2012. The tour operators and travel agencies rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (54.0%), increased 4.0%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased 1.9% in the annual rate. The normal rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for September (66.9%), increased by 1.2%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 0.1% decrease in September. The normal rate, which accounted for 53.9% of the total weight, increased 0.8%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 1.4% increase in September ⁽¹⁾, as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays of residents decreased 1.0%, whereas those of non-residents increased 2.5%.


The average stay increases 0.4% as compared to September 2012, standing at 4.0 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 77% were accounted for hotels, and 23% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.

Distribution of travellers and overnight stays by modality over total non-hotel accommodation in %



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 29.6% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (24.6%) and France (6.4%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with over 10.3 million overnight stays (0.1% less than in September 2012). Followed by Cataluña, with over 8.1 million overnight stays (1.8% less) and Canarias, with over 7.1 million overnight stays (2.3% more).
