Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
September 2021 Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased by 99.5% in September, as compared with the same month of 2020

During the first nine months of 2021, overnight stays increased 43.4%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

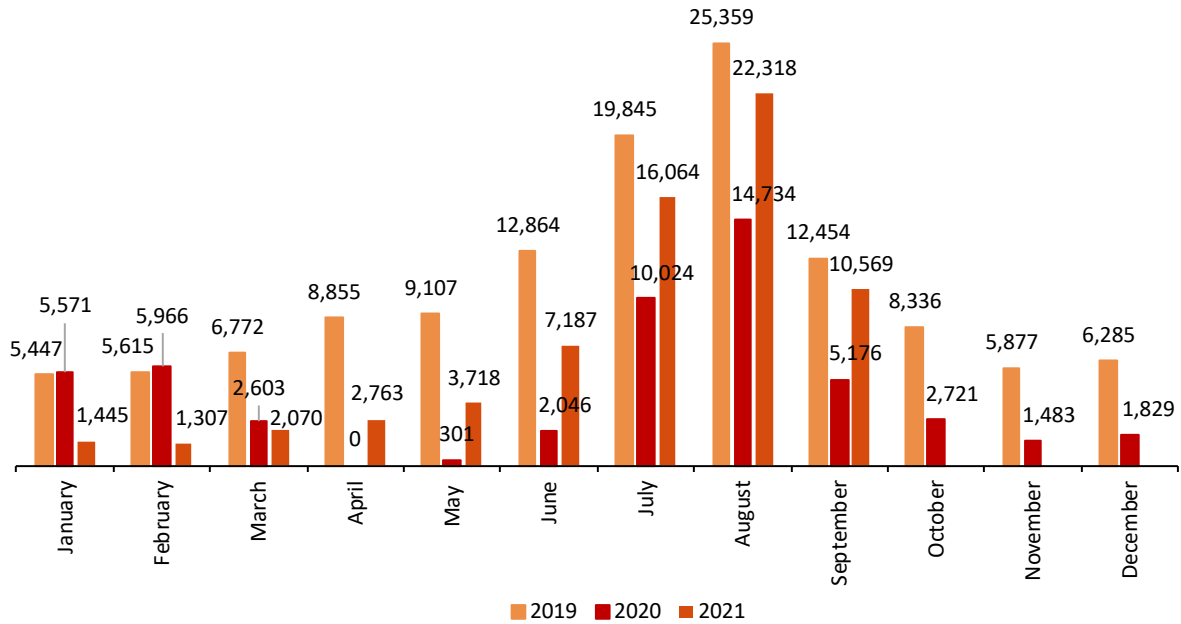
Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 10.5 million in September, 99.5% more than in the same month of 2020.

By traveller origin, overnight stays by travellers resident in Spain amounted to 5.9 million, 42.5% more than in September 2020. On the other hand, those of non-residents reached 4.5 million, with an increase of 319.0%.

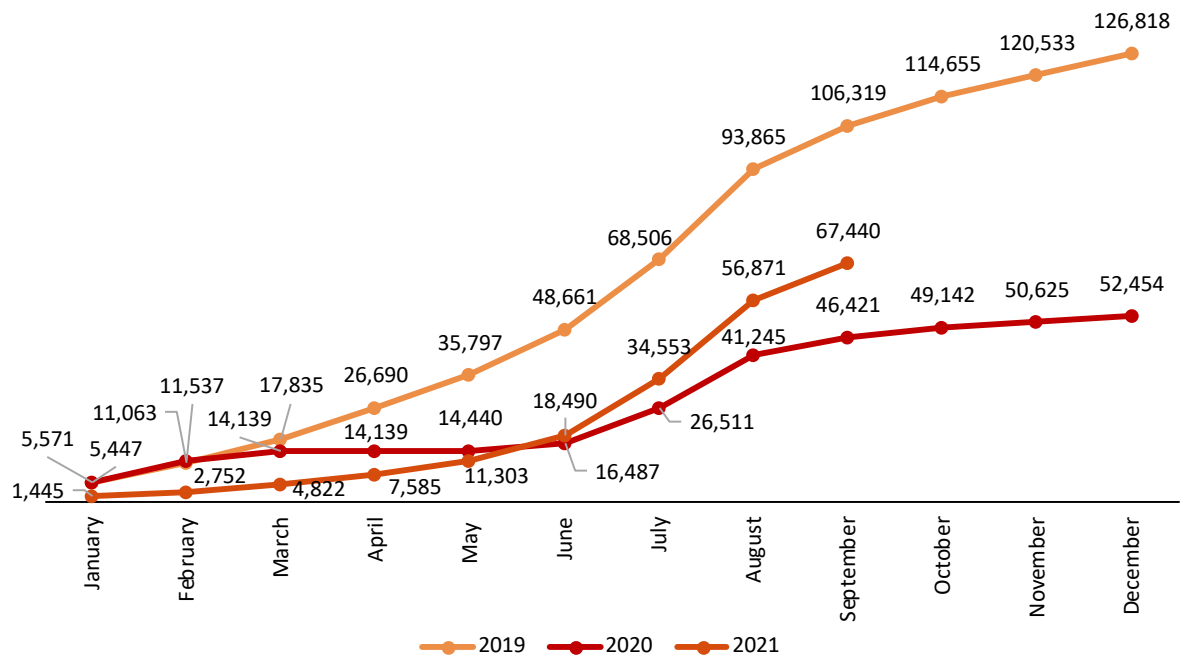
Compared to September 2019, overnight stays in non-hotel establishments showed a decrease of 18.9%. However, it should be noted that overnight stays by travellers residing in Spain were above the levels before the pandemic, exceeding those registered in September 2019 by 18.6%. In turn, overnight stays by non-residents fell by 43.3%.

During the first seven months of 2021, overnight stays increased 43.4%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

Open establishments

In September, a total of 158,792 non-hotel accommodations were open in Spain, which represented 83.2% of the total directory of establishments in this month.

Holiday Dwellings

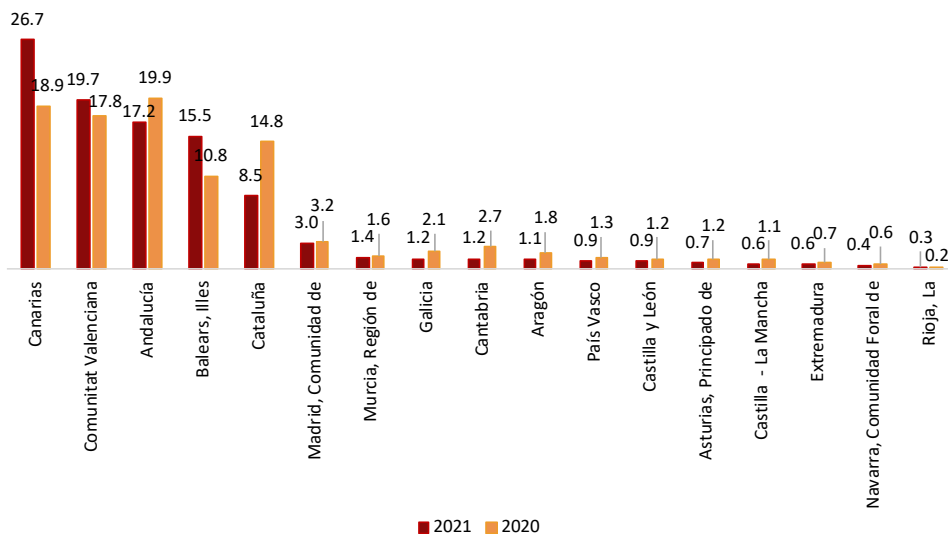
Overnight stays in tourist apartments reached 5.0 million in September, 151.4% more than in August 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers grew by 65.5% and non-resident overnight stays by 390.4%.

By communities, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the main destinations for travellers in the month of September, with 1.3 million, 998,563 and 870,056 overnight stays, respectively.

During the first nine months of 2021, the total number of overnight stays rose by 33.1% compared to the same period of 2020.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred tourist apartment destination, with 566,686 overnight stays in September. The islands of Ibiza-Formentera showed the highest occupancy rate, with 70.1% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in September were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Benidorm.

Campgrounds

Overnight stays at campgrounds came to 3.9 million in September, 63.4% more than in September 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 24.9%, and those by non-residents by 232.3%.

During the first nine months of 2021, total overnight stays at campgrounds rose by 56.5% compared to the same period of 2020.

In September, 39.0% of campsites were occupied. The weekend occupancy rate reached 43.5%.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 1.8 million overnight stays. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 63.2% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination in June, with 741,553 overnight stays. Costa Blanca had the highest occupancy rate, with 69.6% of the campsites offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Tarragona.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodations rose to 1.1 million in September, 64.0% more than in the same month of 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers grew by 30.7% and non-resident overnight stays by 442.92%.

During the first seven months of 2021, the number of overnight stays rose by 30.8% compared to the same period of 2020.

In rural tourism accommodations, 22.2% of bed-places were occupied in September. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 40.4%.

By autonomous communities, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 171,803 overnight stays. This Autonomous Community also presented the highest occupancy rate, with 57.2% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 134,478 overnight stays. In Isla de Menorca, the highest occupancy rate was reached, with 67.0% of the bed-places offered.

Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels¹ stood at 406,709 in September, 145.3% more than for the same month of 2020. Resident overnight stays grew by 125.1% and non-resident overnight stays by 220.3%.

During the first nine months of 2021, the total of overnight stays fell by 69.7% compared to the same period of 2020.

In September, 20.7% of bed-places were occupied. The weekend occupancy rate reached 25.4%.

By communities, Galicia was the main destination, with 117,406 overnight stays. In September, Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 59.0% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased by 12.1% in September compared to the same month in 2020. The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 2.9% and the Rural Tourism Index (RTAPI) increased by 4.7%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In September, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels², holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased to 36.2 million. This represented an increase of 168.0% compared to the same month of 2020. Overnight stays by resident travellers grew by 68.1% and non-resident overnight stays by 530.7%.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodations in September, 70.8% corresponded to hotels, and 29.2% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were Germany (with 23.0% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (19.5%), and France (10.9%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with more than 6.2 million overnight stays. It was followed by Andalucía (with 6.1 million) and Cataluña (with more than 5.8 million).

¹ Since January 2021, tourist hostels have been included in the survey, in addition to those belonging to the Spanish Youth Hostels Network. The data published are not comparable with those of August 2020, and [link coefficients](#) are thus published to allow the annual variation rates to be calculated.

² The press release corresponding to Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends was published on 25 October.

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for September 2020 of the Occupancy Surveys in: The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Population scope: rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
