Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
September 2022. Provisional Data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations reached 12.8 million, compared to 10.5 million in the same month of 2021

During the first seven months of 2022, accumulated overnight stays increased 61.4%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 12.8 million in September, compared to 10.5 million for same month of 2021; this supposed an increase of 21.6%. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 5.2% while those by non-residents increased by 56.6%.

The average stay stood at 4.1 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first seven months of 2022, overnight stays increased 61.4%, as compared with the same period of the previous year. In terms of campsites, the accumulated overnight stays between January and September were above 2019 levels.

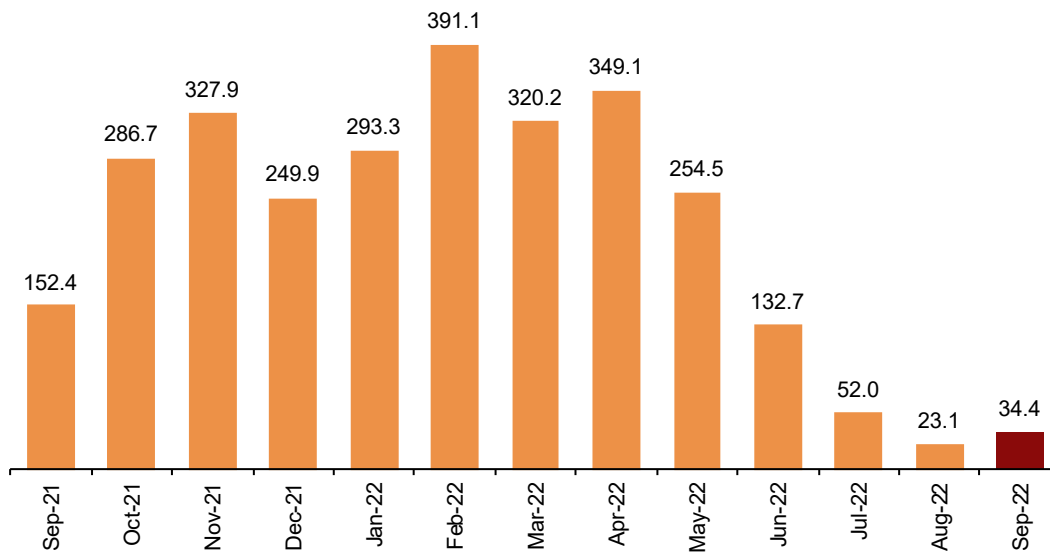
Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays at tourist apartments increased by 34.4% in September as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 7.6%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 73.7%.

The average stay increased 0.4%, standing at 5.3 overnight stays per traveller.

In September, 37.6% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 22.0% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 41.3%, with an increase of 14.7%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay

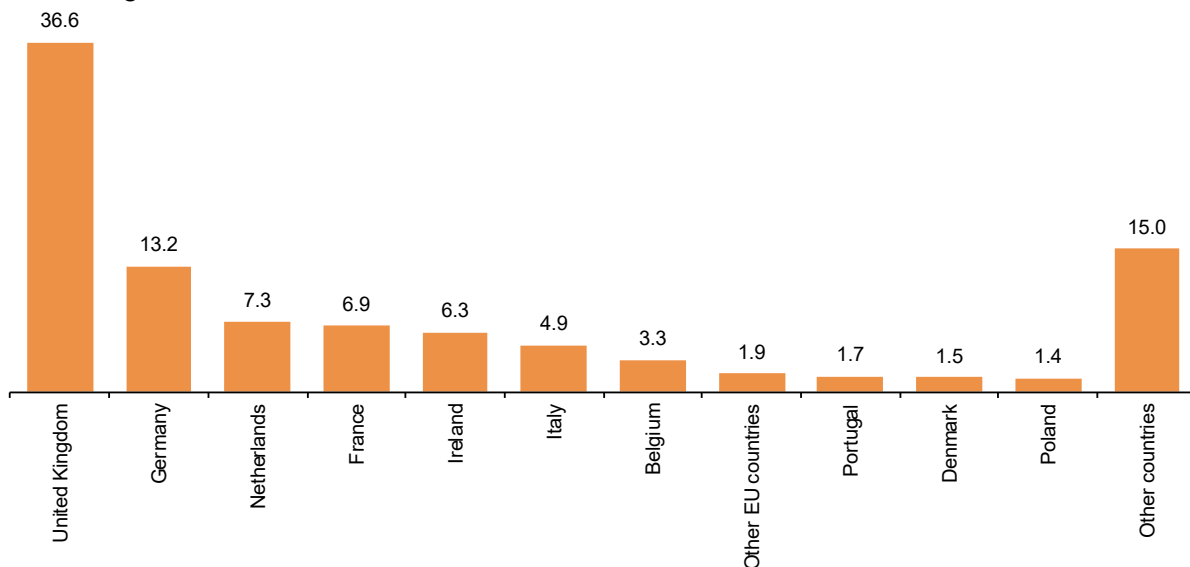

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 66.8% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with more than 1.6 million. The following country of origin was Germany, with 601,838.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays, 45.2% more than in September 2021. The highest occupancy was in Comunidad de Madrid, with 82.9% of apartments offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 739,145 overnight stays. Isla de Lanzarote had the highest occupancy rate, with 84.7% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in September were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Benidorm.

Campgrounds

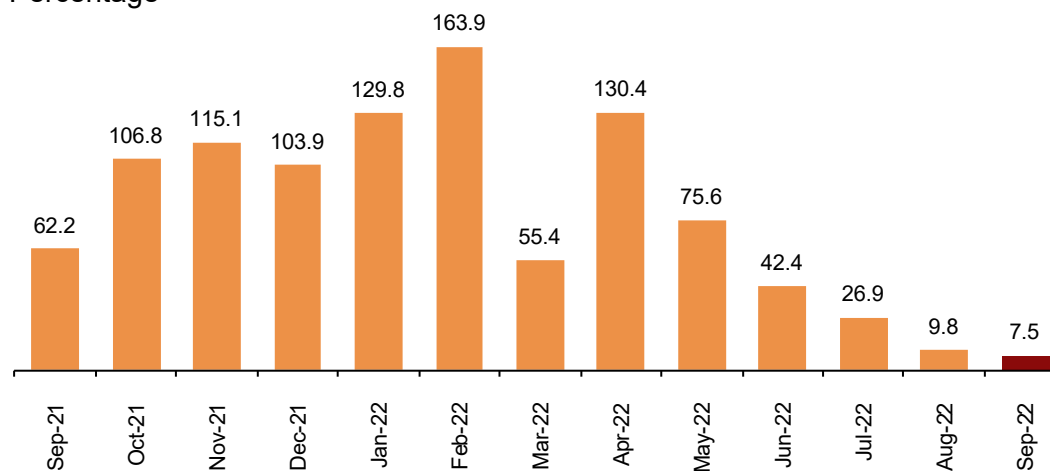
Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 7.5% in September as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 3.5%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 25.8%.

During September, 40.9% of the pitches offered were occupied, 4.4% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 42.8%, with a 2.0% annual decrease.

Non-residents accounted for 43.9% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 23.0% of overnight stays by non-residents, 22.3% more than in September of 2021.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays, representing an increase of 6.5% in the annual rate. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 59.9% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 826,832 overnight stays. Costa Blanca (Alicante) had the highest occupancy rate, with 68.6% of the campsites offered.

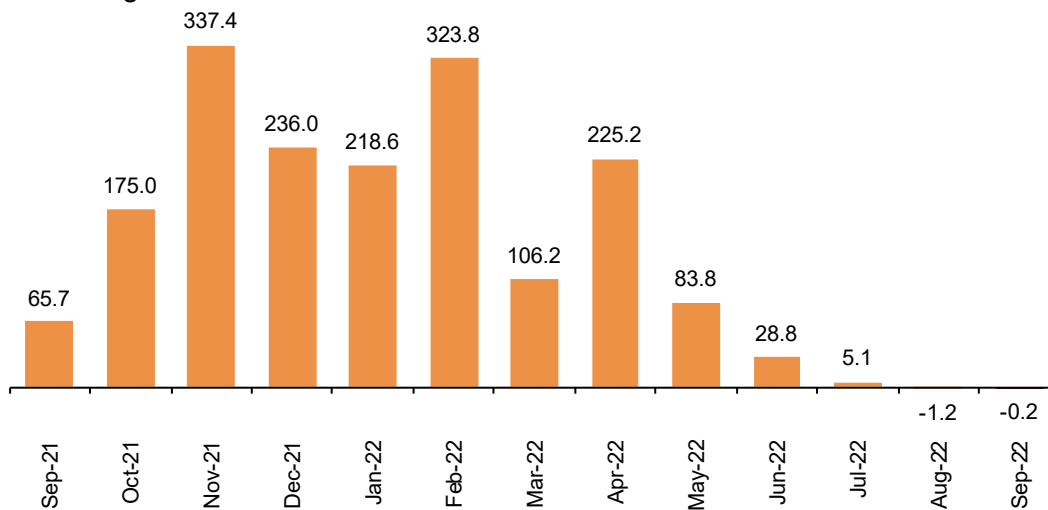
The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Tarragona.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation had an annual decrease of 0.2% in September. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 8.3%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 22.0%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay

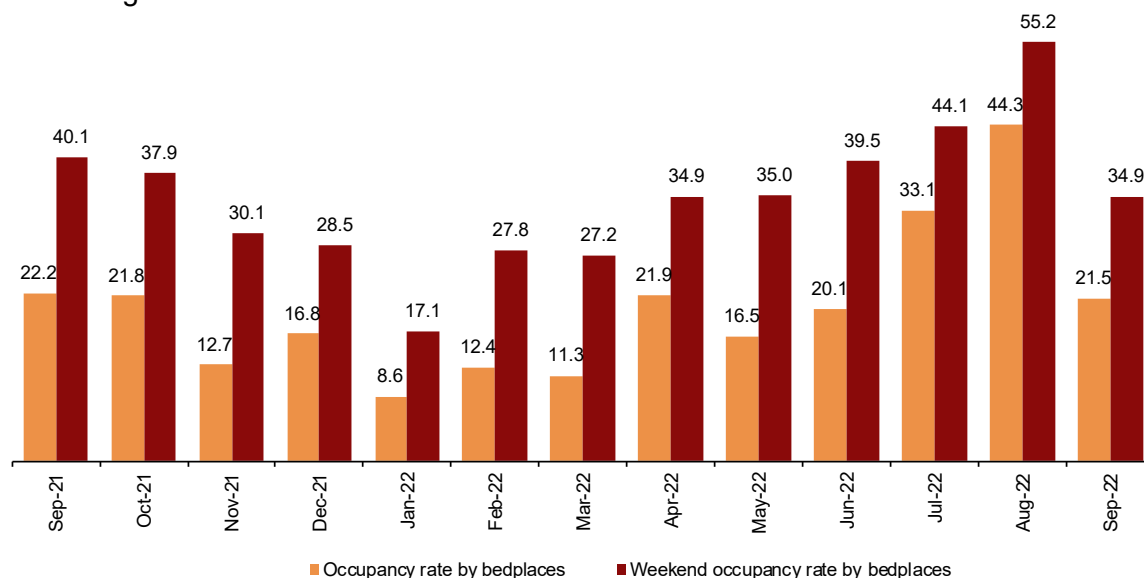

In rural tourism accommodation, 21.5% of the bed-places were occupied, 3.2% less than September 2021. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 34.9%, with an annual decrease of 13.1%.

Percentage

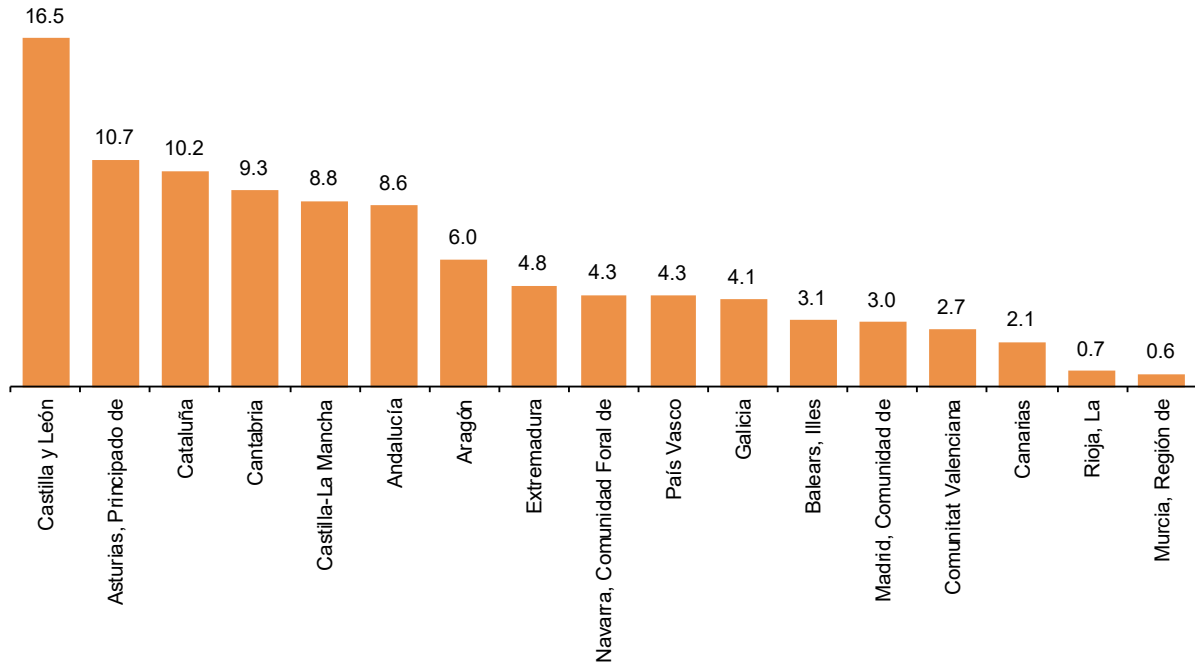


By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 204,272 overnight stays, 19.8% more than in September 2021. It also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 65.7% of bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 166,529 overnight stays. In Isla de Menorca, the highest occupancy rate was reached, with 73.5% of the bed-places offered.

Percentage

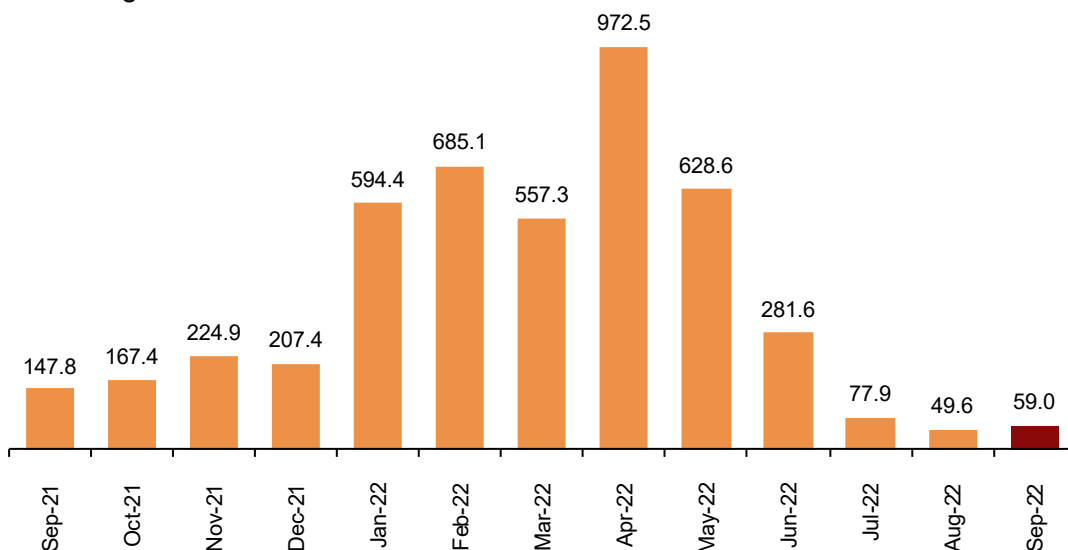


Hostels

In September, there were 651,019 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 59.0%. Resident overnight stays increased by 12.4% and non-resident overnight stays by 119.3%.

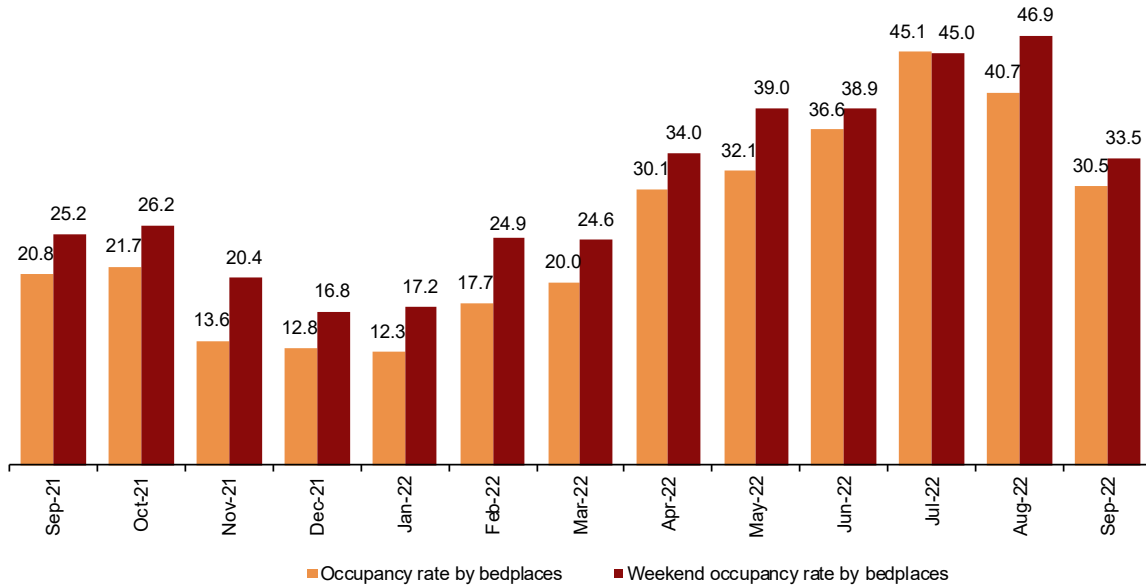
Annual variation rate for overnight stay

30.5% of the available bedplaces were occupied, 46.8% more than in September 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 33.5%, with a 32.8% increase.

Percentage

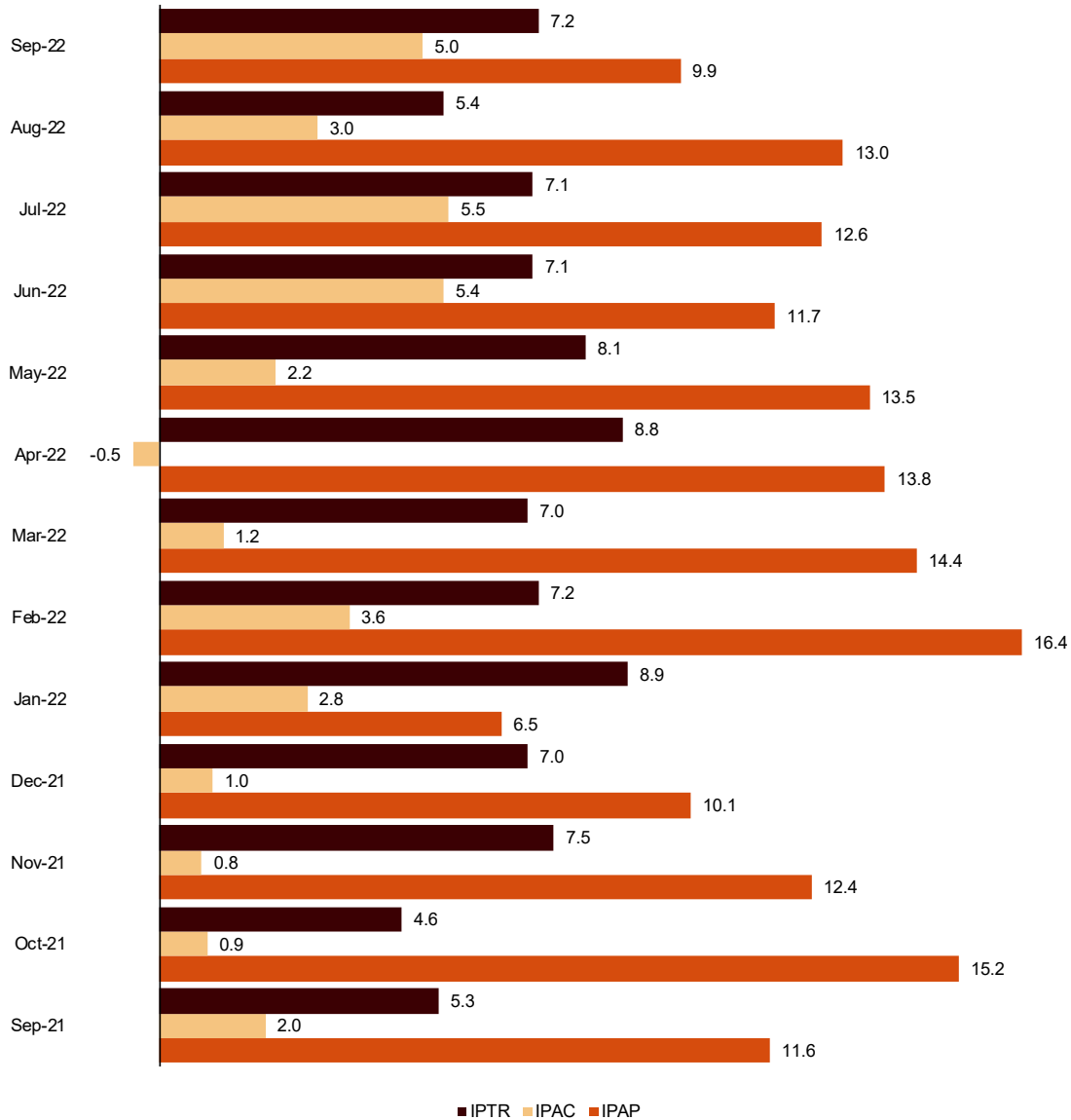


Galicia was the main destination, with 163,518 overnight stays. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 68.6% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 9.9% in September compared to the same month of 2021, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 5.0%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 7.2%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In September, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased by 34.6% in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 0.6%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 68.5%.

The average stay grew by 3.2%, to 3.5 overnight stays per traveller.

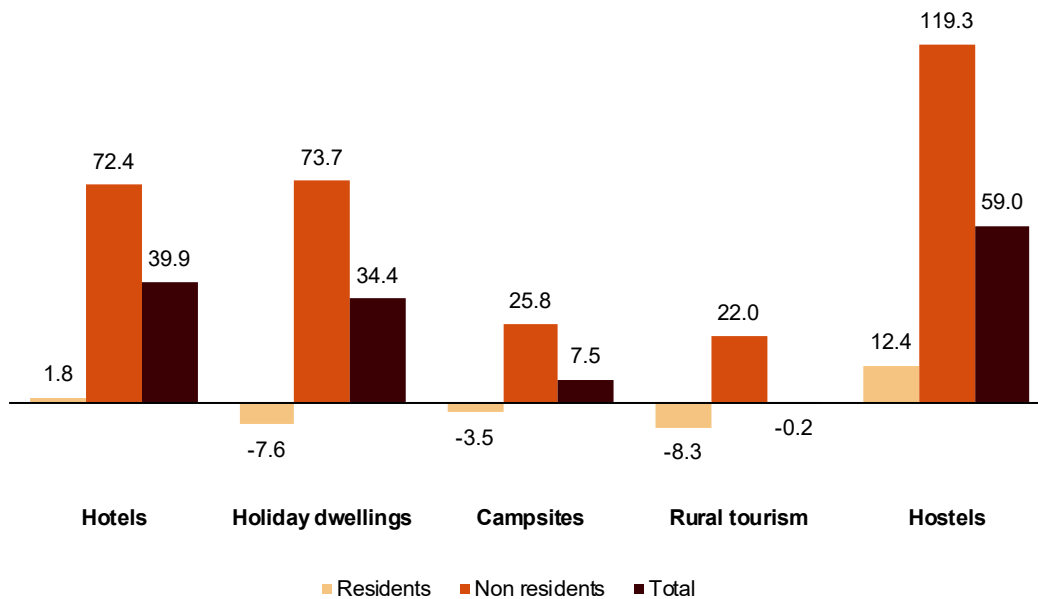

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 73.6% corresponded to hotels, and 26.4% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were the United Kingdom (with 28.5% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (19.3%) and France (8.3%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with over 10.3 million overnight stays (63.6% more than in September 2021). It was followed by Cataluña, with over 8.7 million overnight stays (and an increase of 47.4%) and Canarias, with over 7.6 million, (and an annual increase of 39.9%).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for September 2021 of the Occupancy Surveys in: The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Population scope: rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
