**Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
September 2023. Provisional Data

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased by 3.5%, as compared with the same month of 2022**

**Cumulative overnight stays since January grew by 3.7% and are 3.9% higher than in the same period in 2019**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday apartments, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) decreased by 3.5% in September, compared to the same month in 2022. Resident registrations remained unchanged and non-resident registrations increased by 6.2%.

The average stay stood at 4.0 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first nine months of 2023, overnight stays increased 3.7%, as compared to the same period of the previous year. Moreover, they are 3.9% higher than in the same period of 2019.

### **Holiday Dwellings**

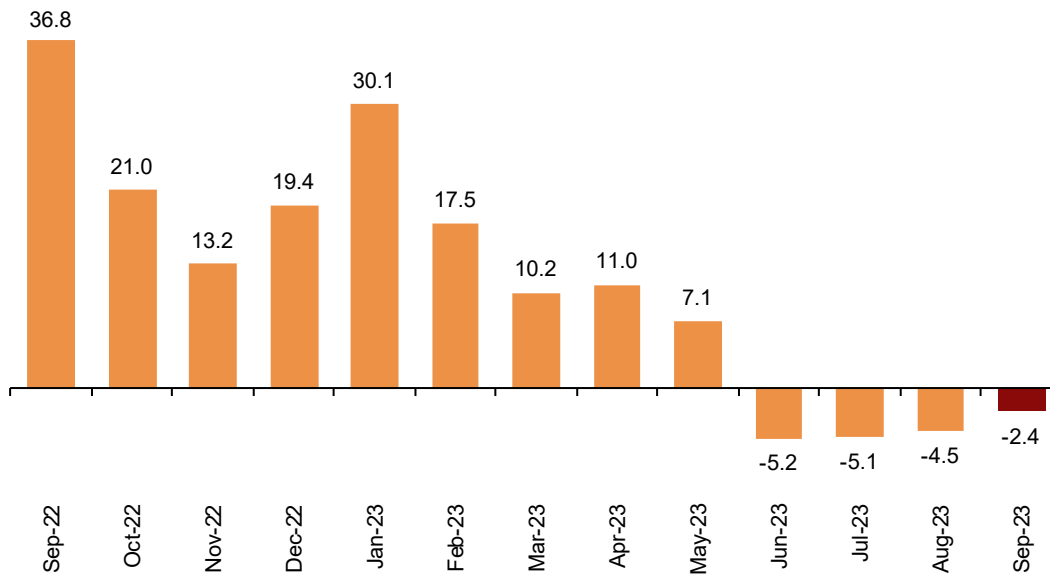
Overnight stays in holiday apartments decreased by 2.4% in September, as compared with the same month in 2022. Resident overnight stays decreased by 6.7% and non-resident overnight stays by 0.3%.

The average stay decreased by 2.3%, standing at 5.1 overnight stays per traveller.

In September, 38.2% of the bed-places available for holiday apartments were occupied, 0.6% less than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 40.9%, with a decrease of 3.0%.

**Annual variation rate for overnight stay**

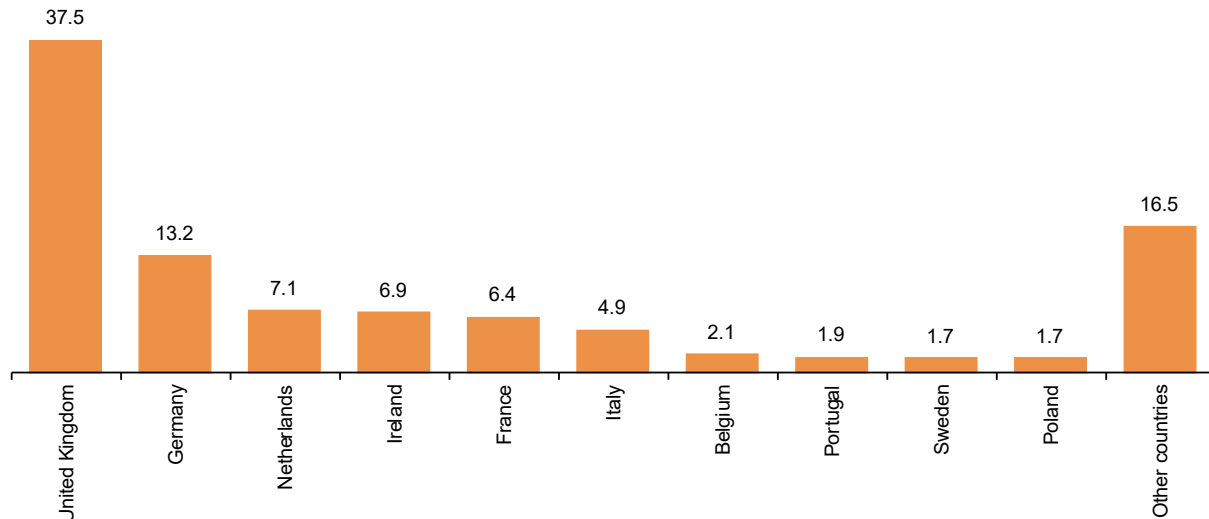

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday apartments represented 68.3% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 1.7 million overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 613,112.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays, and an increase of 0.9% as compared with September 2022. Illes Balears had the highest occupancy, at 83.2% of the apartments offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 750,223 overnight stays. Isla de Lanzarote had the highest occupancy rate, with 87.1% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in September are San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

## Campgrounds

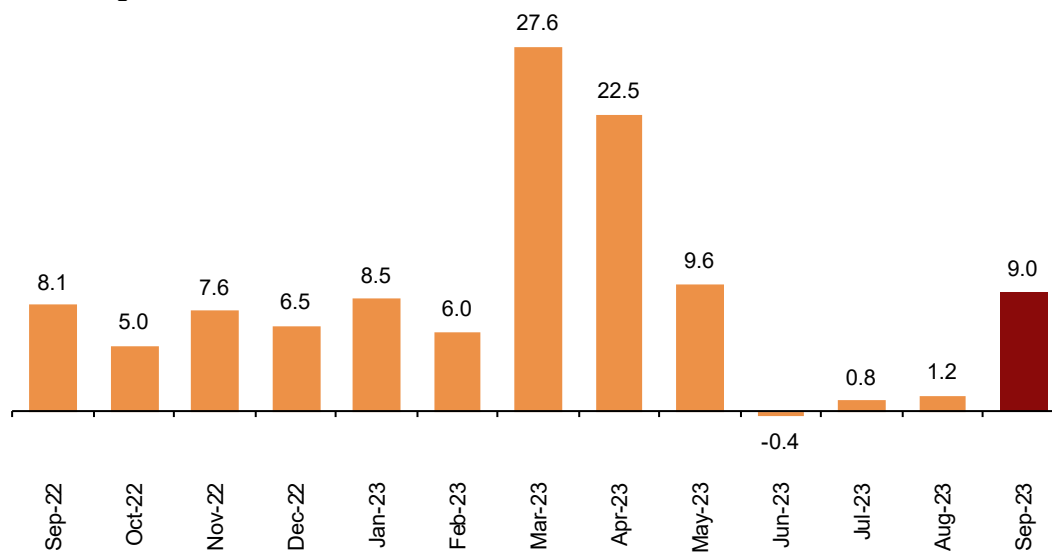
Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 9.0% in September, as compared with the same month in 2022. Resident overnight stays grew by 3.2%, and those of non-residents by 16.5%.

During September, 41.0% of the pitches offered were occupied, 0.5% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 43.6%, with an annual increase of 1.0%.

Non-residents accounted for 46.6% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 26.0% of overnight stays by non-residents, 24.7% more than in September of 2022.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 2.2 million overnight stays, representing an increase of 13.2% in the annual rate. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 63.6% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 971,126 overnight stays. Costa Blanca (Alicante) had the highest occupancy rate, with 69.4% of the campsites offered.

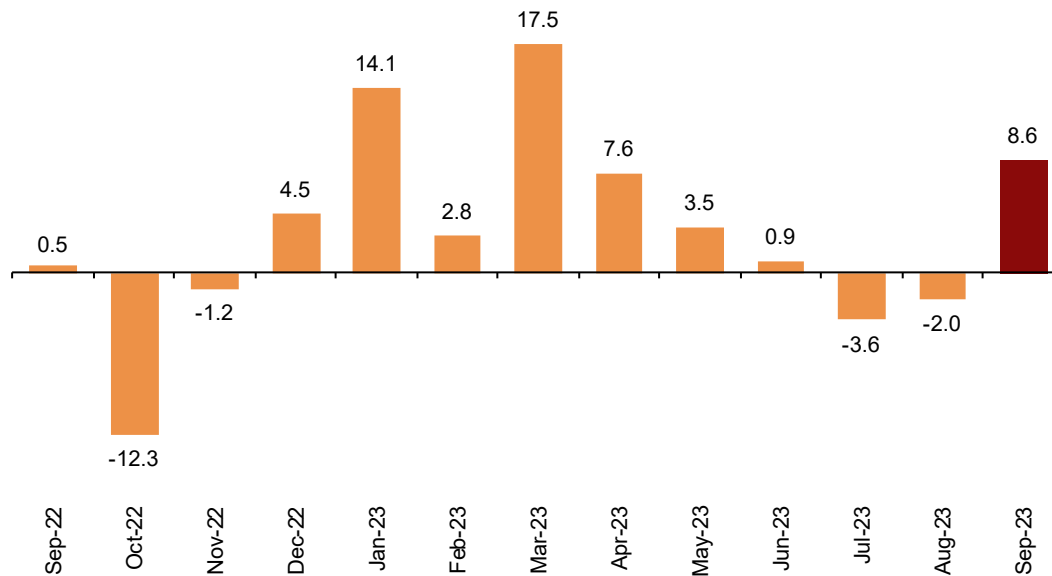
The tourist sites with the most overnight stays are Benidorm, Torroella de Montgrí and Mont-Roig del Camp.

### Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 8.6% in September. Resident overnight stays grew by 3.3%, and those of non-residents by 19.6%.

#### Annual variation rate for overnight stay

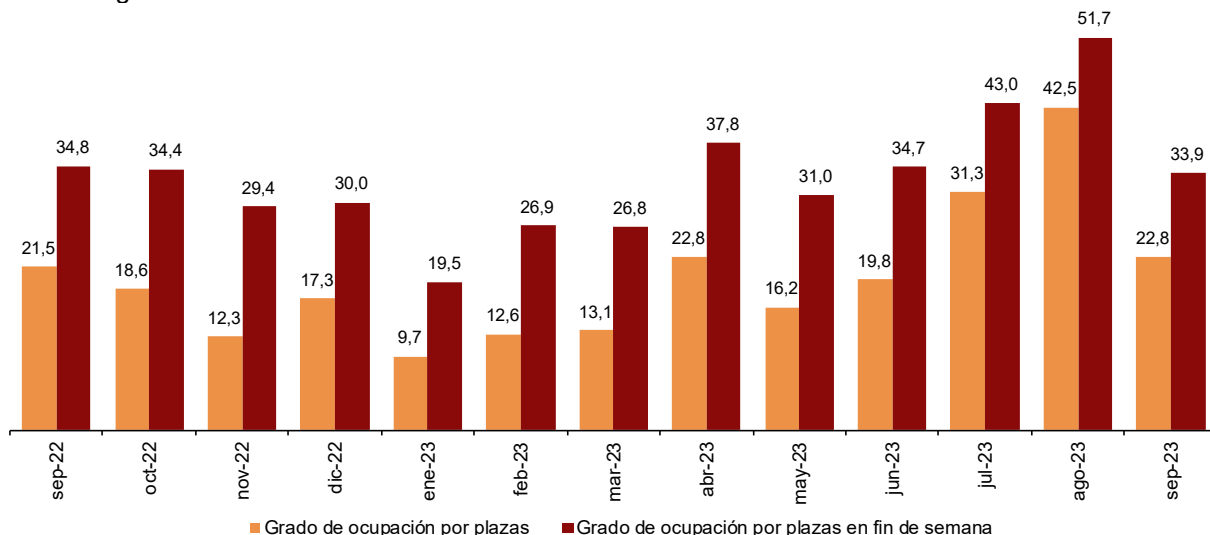

In rural tourism accommodation, 22.8% of bedplaces are occupied, 6.1% more than in September 2022. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 33.9%, with an annual decrease of 2.6%.

Percentage

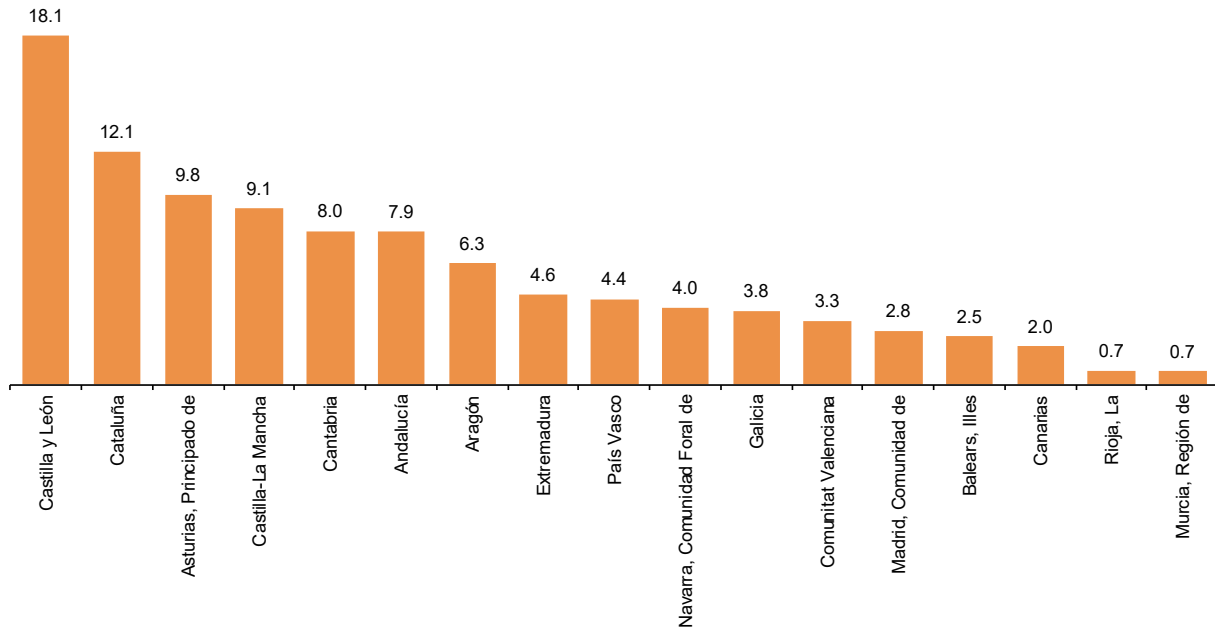


By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears is the preferred destination, with 220,869 overnight stays, 7.6% more than in September 2022. It also achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 69.0% of campsites offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 179,629 overnight stays. Isla de Menorca reached the highest occupancy rate, with 74.7% of the bed-places offered.

Percentage

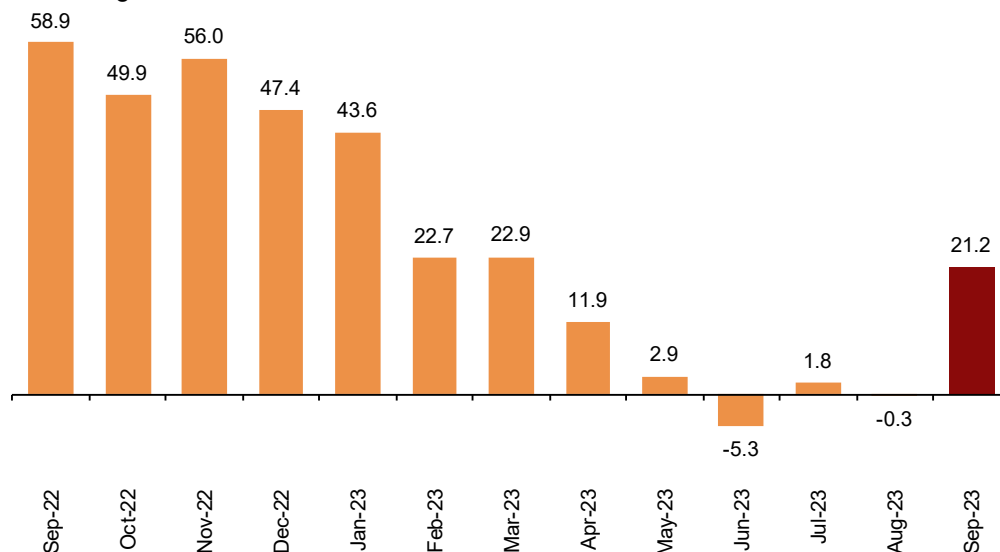


**Hostels**

In September, there were 788,941 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 21.2%. Resident overnight stays increased by 18.9% and non-resident overnight stays by 22.8%.

**Annual variation rate for overnight stay**

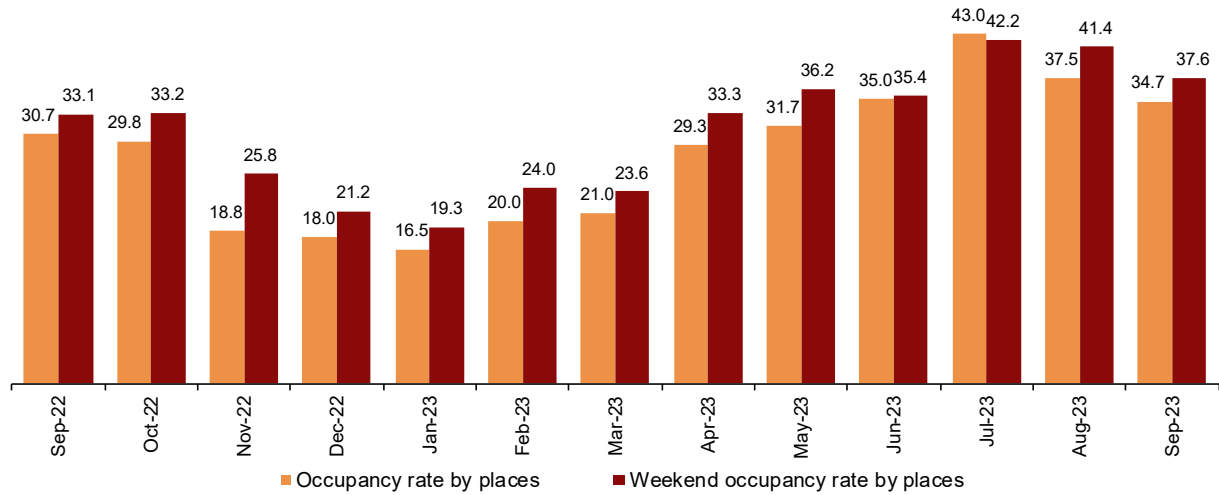

34.7% of the bedplaces are occupied, 13.0% more than in September 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 37.6%, an increase of 13.4%.

Percentage



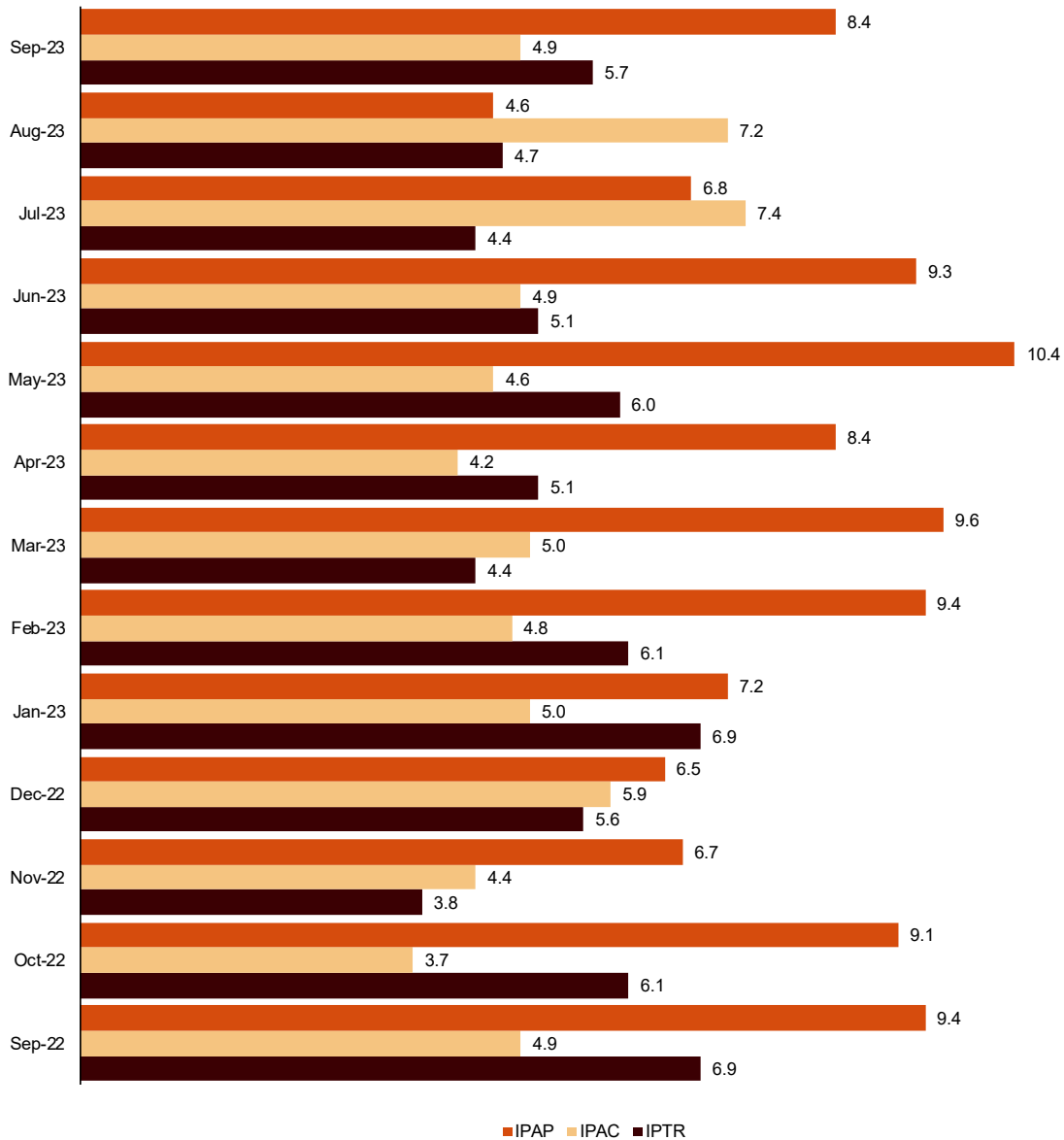
Galicia was the main destination, with 207,524 overnight stays. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 65.0% of the bed-places offered.

**Price indices**

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 8.4% in September, compared to the same month of 2022, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 4.9%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 5.7%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In September, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, apartments, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) registered a 5.2% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 1.4% while those by non-residents increased by 8.9%.

The average stay decreased by 0.3%, to 3.4 overnight stays per traveller.

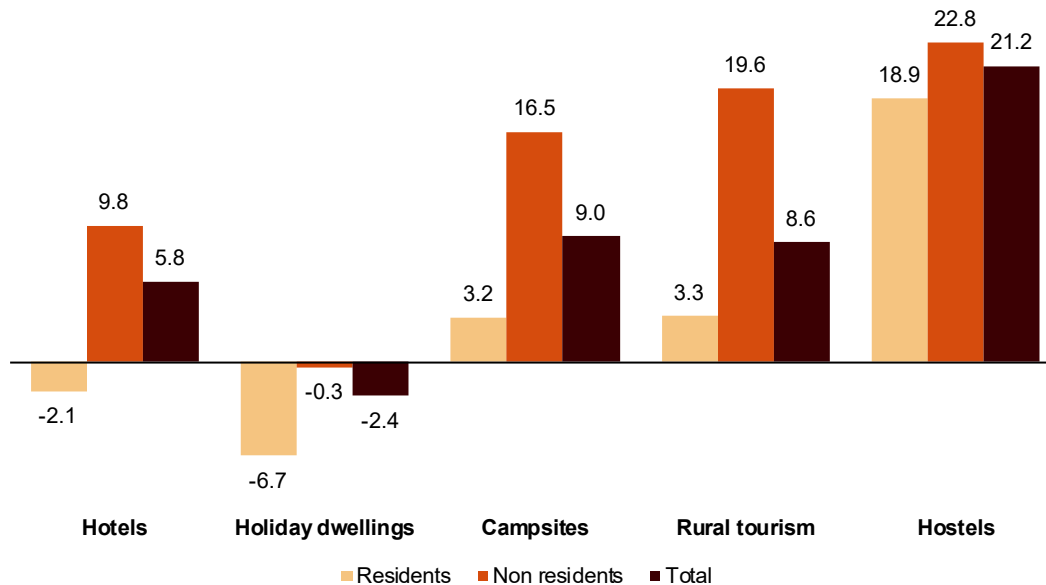

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 73.9% corresponded to hotels, and 26.1% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 27.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (18.9%) and France (8.0%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with more than 10.6 million overnight stays. It is followed by Cataluña, with more than 9.6 million, and the Islas Canarias, with more than 7.8 million.

## Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for September 2022 of the Occupancy Survey in: The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

## Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such a way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such a way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample size:** approximately 1,200 establishments.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
