## Non-hotel tourist accommodation occupancy surveys October 2007. Provisional data

### Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation decrease 1.1% in October, as compared to the same month in 2006

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 7.2 million in October, 1.1% less than in the same month of the previous year. While overnight stays corresponding to residents increased 3.8%, that corresponding to non-residents decreased 2.7%..

The average stay decreased 0.8%, and stood at 6.1 nights per traveller.

During the first ten months of the year, over 99.7 million overnight stays were recorded, a decrease of 1% over the same period of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents increased 1%, while those of non-residents decreased 2.2%.


### Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 2.8% in October

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 5.4 million in October, representing a 2.8% decrease as compared to the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays increased 1.6 % and non-resident overnight stays decreased 3.6%.


During the first ten months of the year, overnight stays decreased 1.7%. Resident overnight stays increased 2.7%, while non-resident overnight stays decreased 3.1%.

Available holiday dwellings decreased 3.8%, reaching almost 452,800 bedplaces. In October 38.7% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 1.6% more than in the same month last year. On the other hand, 54.4% of the total number of holiday dwellings offered were occupied, an increase of 4.1%.

Non-resident overnight stays amounted to 84% of the total in holiday dwellings. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with over 1.9 million overnight stays, 5.8% fewer than in October of the previous year.

The next country of origin was Germany, with more than one million overnight stays, and an interannual rate of -9.2%.

**Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination**, with more than three million overnight stays, 5.4% less than in October 2006. The second destination was Illes Balears, with more than 954,000 overnight stays, 2.3% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of choice, whereas Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana, and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers.

**Comunidad de Madrid** presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 81.4% of available holiday dwellings occupied. They were followed by Canarias (64.5%) and Navarra (53%).

By **tourist areas**, the Island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with almost 1.1 million overnight stays in October and a 66.1% occupancy rate.


San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Mogán were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.

### **Prices for holiday dwellings increase 0.9% in October**


The Holiday Dwellings Price Index registered a 0.9% increase in October, a rate 2.8 points lower than that for the previous month.

The interannual rate of the *tour operator and travel agency* price, which had the greatest weight in this month's weight structure (59%), decreased 0.6%.

By modalities, 2/4 bedplace apartments, whose weight was 68.5%, decreased their prices by 0.1%, as compared to October 2006.



## Overnight stays in tourist campsites increase 4.3%



Overnight stays in tourist campsites exceeded 1.1 million in October, representing a 4.3% interannual rate increase. Overnight stays by residents increased 4.5%, while overnight stays by non-resident guests increased 4.1%.

Tourist campsites offered around 356,000 lots, 2.1% less than in the same month of 2006. 33.9% of the available lots were occupied, 6.9% more in the interannual rate, and the weekend occupancy rate by lots reached 36.3%, that is, 4.4% more than in October 2006.

58.2% of overnight stays in tourist campsites were made by non-residents. The **United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, accounting for 33% of overnight stays by non-residents (12.2% more than in 2006). The next country of origin was Germany.


**Comunitat Valenciana** was the **preferred camping destination**, with more than 364,000 overnight stays, 1.1% less than in the October 2006. Cataluña was the second preferred destination, with over 325,000 overnight stays, with an increase of 10.7%.

Among non-residents, Comunitat Valenciana, Cataluña and Andalucía were the preferred destinations. Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident guests.

In October, the **highest campsite occupancy rate** was registered in **La Rioja** (with 57.9% of the available lots), followed by Comunitat Valenciana (55.6%) and Comunidad de Madrid (47%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with over 210,600 overnight stays, while Costa del Garraf registered the highest occupancy rate in October (67.6%). Benidorm, Cartagena and Oliva were the **tourist sites** with the most overnight stays.

## Prices of tourist campsites increase 3.3%



The Tourist Campsite Price Index interannual growth rate increased 3.3% in October. The *normal* price, which had the greatest weight in the weight structure for this month (60.8%), increased 3.5%.


Regarding categories, second class, with a 59.2% weight in October, registered an increase of 3%.

## Overnight stays by residents in rural tourist accommodation increase 6.2% in October, as compared to the same month of the previous year


Overnight stays in rural tourist accommodation exceeded 628,300 in October, a 5% increase with regard to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents increased 6.2%, and non-resident stays decreased 0.5%

Rural tourist accommodation offered 106,700 bedplaces in October, 6.6% more than in the same month of 2006. 18.9% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 1.5% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 38.7%, that is, 0.1% more than in October of the previous year.

**Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourist accommodation**, with more than 132,900 overnight stays, 7.5% more than in October 2006. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with more than 74,600 overnight stays (9.3% more)

**Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination**, while the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident guests were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Andalucía.

The highest occupancy rate in rural tourist accommodation in October was registered in Illes Balears (with 46.3% of the available bedplaces), followed by La Rioja (26.9%) and Navarra (25.5%).

By **tourist area**, the Island of Mallorca was the main destination of choice, with 43,600 overnight stays, and 46.2% of occupation.

## Annex

### Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

**Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation** (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a **0.3% interannual increase in October**. Resident overnight stays decreased 0.4%, while non-resident overnight stays increased 0.7%.


**The average stay decreased 1.8%**, standing at 3.5 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in October, 77% were accounted for at hotels and 23% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 32.4% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (with 29.5%) and Dutch (with 4.8%).

**Illes Balears** was the **preferred destination** considering overall Spanish tourist accommodation, with nearly 7.1 million overnight stays, 2.1% less than in October 2006. Next were Illes Balears, with over 5.3 million overnight stays (5% less) and Andalucía, with more than 4.5 million overnight stays (3.4% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña. On the other hand Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
