## Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys October 2008. Provisional data

### **Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation decrease 9.4% in October, as compared with the same month in 2007**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) reached 6.5 million in October, 9.4% less than in the same month of the previous year. The decrease in overnight stays of residents was recorded for both residents (with an interannual rate of -13.5%), and non-residents (-8.0%).

The average stay grew 1.0% as compared with October 2007, standing at 6.1 nights per traveller.

**During the first ten months of the year 97.2 million overnight stays were registered, 1.9% less than the same period the previous year.**




### **Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 9.9% in October**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 4.9 million in October, representing a 99% decrease as compared with the same month last year. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at -13.7%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of -9.1%.

Available holiday dwellings increased 0.6%, reaching almost 455,300 bedplaces. This month, 34.5% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 10.6% less than in October 2007. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 49.1% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 9.7%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 84.5% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with more than 1.6 million overnight stays, 16.1% less than in October of last year. The following market was Germany, with nearly 963,420 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -5.1%.

**Canarias was the preferred** holiday dwelling **destination**, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, 12.5% less than in October 2007. Illes Balears was the second destination of choice, with 842,260 overnight stays, 11.8% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Andalucía were the main destinations of choice. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays of resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana.

**Comunidad de Madrid** presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 65.8% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Canarias (59.2%) and Andalucía (50.5%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 968,880 overnight stays in October. Costa del Sol reached the highest occupancy rate with 63.7% of available dwellings occupied.

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.


### **Prices for holiday dwellings increase 0.5% in the interannual rate in October**

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 0.5% increase in October, a rate 1.3 points lower than that recorded the previous month.


The rate for *travel agencies and tour-operators*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (59.9%), registered a 0.7% interannual rate increase.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 67.8%, decreased their prices 0.7% as compared with October 2007.

## Overnight stays on tourist campsites decrease 3.5%



Overnight stays on tourist campsites exceeded the one million mark in October, representing an interannual decrease of 3.5%. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 8.6%, while those by non-residents increased 0.1%.

Tourist campsites offered 362,658 bedplaces, 1.9% more than in the same month of 2007. Of the available lots, 33.4% were occupied, for a 3.0% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate reached 35.0%, that is, 4.3% less than in October 2007.

61.5% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 32.8% of overnight stays by non-residents (0.6% less). The following country of origin was Germany.


**Comunitat Valenciana** was the **preferred destination for camping**, with more than 370,493 overnight stays, 1.8% more than in October 2007. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 274,831 overnight stays, indicating a decrease of 9.8%.

Among non-residents, the preferred destinations were Comunitat Valenciana, Cataluña and Andalucía. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana, in that order.

**La Rioja** reached the **highest occupancy rate on campsites** in October, with 60.7% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (52.7%) and Región de Murcia (46.1%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 223,738 overnight stays and 63.5% of the available lots occupied. The **tourist sites** with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Oliva and Mazarrón.

## Prices of tourist campsites increase 2.2% in the interannual rate




The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 2.2% in October. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (61.6%), increased 3.4%.

Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 60.5% this month, recorded an interannual increase of 3.6%.


## Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation decrease 18.0% in October as compared with the same month of the previous year

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation surpassed 528,150 in October, with an interannual decrease of 16.7%. Overnight stays by residents decreased 18.0%, whereas non-resident stays decreased 10.4%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 118,088 bedplaces, 9.4% more than in October 2007. 14.4% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 23.8% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 30.1%, that is, 22.1% less.



**Distribution on rural tourist accommodation of overnight stays of Spanish travellers in %**




**Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation**, with 110,706 overnight stays, 16.6% less than in October 2007. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 64,282 overnight stays, 14.3% less.

**Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination**. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 38.1% of the available bedplaces occupied. It was followed by La Rioja (22.7%) and País Vasco (22.0%).

By tourist area, Pirineo Catalán was the preferred destination, with 35,496 overnight stays in October. Isla de Mallorca reached the highest occupancy rate (41.1%).

## Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 3.7% in the interannual rate



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered an interannual growth of 3.7% in October.

Weekend rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (61.0%), rose 3.9%. By rent modality, complete use, whose weighting was 66.2%, recorded an interannual increase of 4.0%.

## Annex

### **Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation**

**Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation** (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) **registered a 6.1% interannual decrease in October**. This decrease was produced among residents, with an interannual rate of -9.5%, and non-residents, with a -4.2% variation.


The average stay increased 1.0% and stood at 3.6 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of October, 77% accounted for hotels and 23% for non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 29.9% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (29.8%) and the Netherlands (5.2%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 6.6 million overnight stays, 6.7% less than in October 2007. It was followed by Illes Balears, with 5.1 million overnight stays (5.5% less) and Andalucía, with 4.3 million overnight stays (4.7% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña. On the other hand, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
