Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys October 2019. Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease by 6.0% in October, as compared to the same month of 2018

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (apartments, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 8.3 million in October, 6.0% less than in the same month of 2018. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 7.6% and those by non-residents did so by 5.4%.

The average stay stood at 4.5 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first 10 months of 2019, overnight stays decreased by 0.4%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased by 7.2% in October. Resident overnight stays decreased by 7.2% and non-resident overnight stays did so by 7.3%.

It should be pointed out that the annual variation rates of overnight stays in holiday dwellings showed negative growth over the last few months (with the exception of April and August 2019, when Easter and Summer took place), mainly due to the fact that there are holiday dwelling establishments that are being reclassified, becoming considered as private housing for holiday use and therefore leaving the scope of observation of the Holiday Dwellings Occupancy Survey (HDOS).

The average stay decreased by 7.2% as compared with October 2018, standing at 5.5 overnight stays per traveller.


In October, 33.9% of the beds available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 7.7% less than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 37.9%, with a decrease of 8.0%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 82.0% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.7 million overnight stays, that is, 4.5% less than in October 2018. The following country of origin was Germany, with 584,535 overnight stays, 23.3% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 2.3 million overnight stays, a decrease of 10.5% as compared with October 2018. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 79.8% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Tenerife was the preferred destination, with 750,811 overnight stays. La Costa de Barcelona reached the highest occupancy rate, with 86.0% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in October were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.


Tourist Campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered a decrease of 1.7% in October as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 6.6%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 1.4%.

In October, 36.8% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 1.8% more than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 39.1%, with a decrease of 0.8%.

63.2% of overnight stays in tourist campsites were made by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 30.7% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 6.3% less than in October 2018.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 704,211 overnight stays, representing an annual decrease of 4.2%. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate, with 62.6% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca registered the highest number of overnight stays (387,914) and the highest occupancy rate (77.8% of the pitches offered).

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Cartagena.


Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation had an annual decrease of 8.8% in October. Resident overnight stays decreased by 10.7% and non-resident overnight stays did so by 4.4%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 15.6% of the bed-places were occupied in October, 11.5% more than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 33.8%, with a 12.5% decrease.

Occupancy rate


Percentage



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 142,772 overnight stays, 11.2% less than in October 2018. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 39.7% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 98,834 overnight stays. The island of Menorca registered the highest occupancy rate, with 41.0% of the bed-places offered.

Distribution of overnight stays: residents



Hostels


Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual decrease of 1.0% in October. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 1.8%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 0.5%.

In October, 25.9% of the offered bedplaces were occupied, that is, 4.1% less than in Octiver 2018. The weekend occupancy rate reached 33.9%, with a decrease of 6.7%.

Occupancy rate Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 79,532 overnight stays, 2.7% less than in October 2018. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 42.5% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) dropped 1.6% in October as compared to the same month in 2018.

For its part, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 3.2% and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) increased by 1.2%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In October, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 2.9% decrease in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents recorded an annual decrease of 6.1%, whilst those by non-residents decreased by 1.6%.


The average stay decreased by 4.3% in October, and stood at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays made in collective tourist accommodation, 79% corresponded to hotels and 21% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 28.3% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (20.4%) and France (7.4%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with 8.1 million overnight stays (7.9% less than in October 2018). It was followed by Illes Balears, with more than 6.6 million (a decrease of 5.8%) and Andalucía, with 6.1 million, (an annual decrease of 0.6%).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for October in the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that holiday dwelling establishments apply to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday dwelling establishments and/or companies operating holiday dwellings.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such a way that among all the establishments they cover the complete month.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and size of establishment, and for Canarias and Illes Balears stratified at island-size level.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that campsites apply to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such a way that all the establishments cover the whole month.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Rural Tourism Accommodation Occupancy Survey (RTAOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the fundamental characteristics of this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
