

## Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey October 2023. Provisional Data

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased by 7.3%, as compared with the same month of 2022**

**Cumulative overnight stays since January grew by 3.9% and are 4.6% higher than in the same period in 2019**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday apartments, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) increased by 7.3% in October, compared to the same month in 2022. Those by residents grew by 3.6% and those by non-residents did so by 9.4%.

The average stay stood at 4.0 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first 10 months of 2023, overnight stays increased 3.9%, as compared to the same period of the previous year. Moreover, they are 4.6% higher than in the same period of 2019.

### Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 6.0% in October, as compared to the same month in 2022. Resident overnight stays increased by 1.8% and non-resident overnight stays by 7.3%.

The average stay decreased 1.4%, standing at 5.2 overnight stays per traveller.

In October, 35.2% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 0.2% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 39.8%, with an increase of 4.1%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday apartments represented 76.6% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 1.4 million overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 575,139.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays, and an increase of 3.1% as compared with October 2022. Comunidad de Madrid had the highest occupancy rate, at 76.7% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, Tenerife was the preferred destination, with 744,252 overnight stays. Costa de Barcelona had the highest occupancy rate, with 87.4% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in October are San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

## Campgrounds


Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 12.7% in October, as compared with the same month in 2022. Both by residents and by non-residents register that same annual variation.

During October, 41.8% of the campsites offered were occupied, 6.4% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 45.4%, with an 8.9% annual increase.

Non-residents accounted for 53.4% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 31.2% of overnight stays by non-residents, 19.3% more than in October of 2022.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 888,784 overnight stays, representing an increase of 10.9% in the annual rate. Comunitat Valenciana reached the highest occupancy rate, with 63.5% of campsites offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 445,096 overnight stays. It also had the highest occupancy rate, with 79.9% of the campsites offered.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Sant Pere Pescador.

## Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 4.1% in October. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 1.9%, while those by non-residents increased by 19.4%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



In rural tourism accommodation, 18.7% of bedplaces are occupied, 0.7% more than in October 2022. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 36.6%, with an annual increase of 6.3%.

Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León is the preferred destination, with 154,254 overnight stays, 2.5% less than in October 2022. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 52.0% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 128,119 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza-Formentera registered the highest occupancy rate, with 53.6% of bed-places offered.

Percentage




### Hostels

In October, there were 629,167 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 2.8%. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 12.0% while those by non-residents increased by 14.2%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



Percentage




Galicia was the main destination, with 141,560 overnight stays. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 66.6% of the bed-places offered.

## Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 8.4% in October, compared to the same month in 2022, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 4.9%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 4.3%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In October, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) registered an 8.4% increase in the annual rate. Those by residents grew by 0.1% and those by non-residents did so by 12.6%.

The average stay increased by 1.6%, to 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 76.3% corresponded to hotels, and 23.7% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 27.0% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (19.5%) and France (7.9%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with more than 8.4 million overnight stays. It was followed by Illes Balears, with more than 7.2 million, and Cataluña, with more than 6.6 million.

## **Revision and updating of data**

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for October 2022 of the Occupancy Survey in: The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

## **Methodological note**

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** one month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such a way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** one month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such a way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample size:** approximately 1,200 establishments.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** one month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
