Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys November 2008. Provisional data

Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation decrease 5.3% in November, as compared with the same month in 2007

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 5 million in November, 5.3% less than in the same month of the previous year. The decrease in overnight stays of residents was recorded for both residents (with an interannual rate of -16.7%), and non-residents (-1.6%).

The average stay grew 0.9% as compared with November 2007, standing at 6.4 nights per traveller.

During the first eleven months of the year 102.2 million overnight stays were registered, 2.0% less than the same period the previous year.




Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 3.7% in November

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.8 million in November, representing a 3.7% decrease as compared with the same month last year. The decrease in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at -12.7%, and non-residents, who presented a variation of -2.2%.

Available holiday dwellings increased 1.8%, exceeding 347,580 bedplaces. This month, 36.9% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 5.5% less than in November 2007. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 58.1% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 5.4%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 86.9% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with more than 1 million overnight stays, 2.3% less than in November of last year. The following market was Germany, with 700,769 overnight stays and an interannual rate of 2.0%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling **destination**, with more than 3.0 million overnight stays, 3.3% less than in November 2007. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 271,850 overnight stays, 11.7% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the main destinations of choice. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays of resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana.

Canarias presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 72.9% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (62.9%) and País Vasco (53.9%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 1.2 millions overnight stays in November and 79.0% of available dwellings occupied.


San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.

Prices for holiday dwellings decrease 0.6% in the interannual rate in November


The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 0.6% increase in November, a rate 1.1 points lower than that recorded the previous month.

The rate for *travel agencies and tour-operators*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (66.4%), registered a 0.8% interannual rate decrease.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 73.7%, decreased their prices 0.8% as compared with November 2007.



Overnight stays on tourist campsites decrease 4.9%



Overnight stays on tourist campsites exceeded the 764,210 mark in November, representing an interannual decrease of 4.9%. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 20.6%, while those by non-residents increased 3.9%.

Tourist campsites offered 285,719 bedplaces, 2.4% less than in the same month of 2007. Of the available lots, 36.2% were occupied, for a 0.5% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate reached 37.2%, that is, 2.0% less than in November 2007.

70.2% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 40.4% of overnight stays by non-residents (5.3% more than in November 2007). The following country of origin was Germany.


Comunitat Valenciana was the **preferred destination for camping**, with more than 330,817 overnight stays, 4.9% more than in November 2007. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with 135,752 overnight stays, indicating a decrease of 7.6%.

Among non-residents, the preferred destinations were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana, in that order.

La Rioja reached the **highest occupancy rate on campsites** in November, with 65.5% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (51.3%) and Región de Murcia (48.8%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 218,797 overnight stays and 65.5% of the available lots occupied. The **tourist sites** with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Mazarrón.

Prices of tourist campsites increase 1.0% in the interannual rate




The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 1.0% in November. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (53.5%), decreased 1.4%.

Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 60.7% this month, recorded an interannual increase of 0.1%.


Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation decrease 20.2% in November as compared with the same month of the previous year

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation surpassed 395,240 in November, with an interannual decrease of 19.4%. Overnight stays by residents decreased 20.2%, whereas non-resident stays decreased 13.3%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 116,707 bedplaces, 10.1% more than in November 2007. 11.3% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 26.7% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 26.1%, that is, 22.9% less than the previous year.



Distribution on rural tourist accommodation of overnight stays of Spanish travellers in %




Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 87,384 overnight stays, 21.9% less than in November 2007. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with 54,908 overnight stays, 0.6% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha.

Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 25.0% of the available bedplaces occupied. It was followed by Illes Balears (19.0%) and Comunidad de Madrid (17.3%).

By tourist area, Pirineo Catalán was the preferred destination, with 28,691 overnight stays in November. Pirineo Navarro reached the highest occupancy rate (47.6%).

Rural tourism accommodation prices increase 2.8% in the interannual rate



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered an interannual growth of 2.8% in November.

Normal rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (78.4%), rose 2.6%. By rent modality, complete use, whose weighting was 73.7%, recorded an interannual increase of 2.9%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) **registered a 9.2% interannual decrease in November**. This decrease was produced among both residents, with an interannual rate of –13.1%, and non-residents, with a –6.3% variation.


The average stay increased 2.1% and stood at 3.3 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of November, 73% accounted for hotels and 27% for non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 26.0% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (25.5%) and the Netherlands (4.4%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7 million overnight stays, 2.8% less than in November 2007. It was followed by Andalucía, with 2.6 million overnight stays (11.1% less) and Comunitat Valenciana, with 2.1 million overnight stays (14.8% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. On the other hand, Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
