Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
November 2010. Provisional data

Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation decrease 3.2% in November, as compared with the same month of 2009

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) practically reached 4.4 million in November, 3.2% less than in the same month of 2009. This decrease is produced by resident travellers whose interannual rate stood at -9.5%, and also by non-resident travellers with a variation of -1.2%.

The average stay increased 2.4%, as compared with November 2009, standing at 6.5 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first 11 months of the year, overnight stays increased 1.2%, as compared with the same period the previous year.

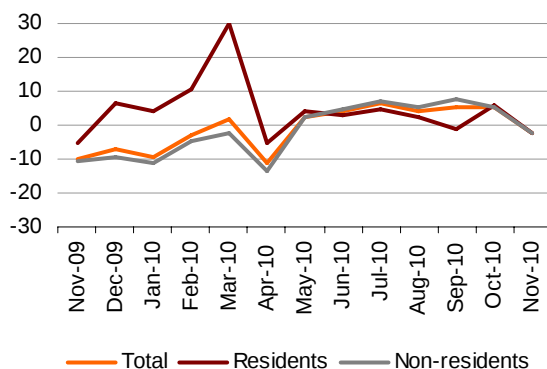

Holiday Dwellings

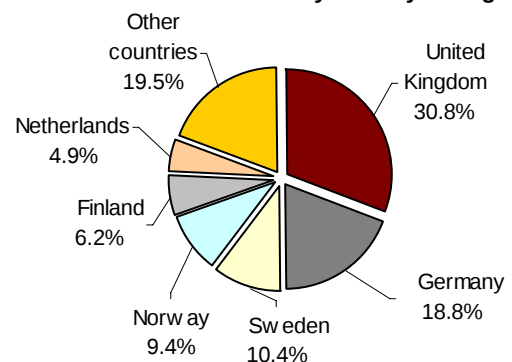
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.3 million in November, representing a decrease of 2.3% over the same month the previous year. This decrease of overnight stays was produced because of both resident travellers, whose interannual rate stood at -2.5%, and non-resident travellers, with an interannual variation of -2.3%.

The average stay decreased 2.8%, as compared with November 2009, standing at 7.9 nights per traveller.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings of non-resident travellers by country of origin in %



Holiday dwellings offered 337,454 bedplaces, 8.2% less than in November 2009. This month, 32.7% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 6.3% more in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 34.4%, with an increase of 6.7%. In turn, 54.3% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual increase of 8.6%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 85.9% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 878,815 overnight stays, 5.0% less than in November last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 537,140 overnight stays, 9.8% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 2.5 million overnight stays, 5.2% less than in November 2009. The second destination of choice was Andalucía, with 262,090 overnight stays, 10.6% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias showed the highest occupancy rate, with 71.7% of the available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (64.5%) and Illes Balears (59.9%).

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 918,077 overnight stays and an occupancy of 75.3% of the available holiday dwellings.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

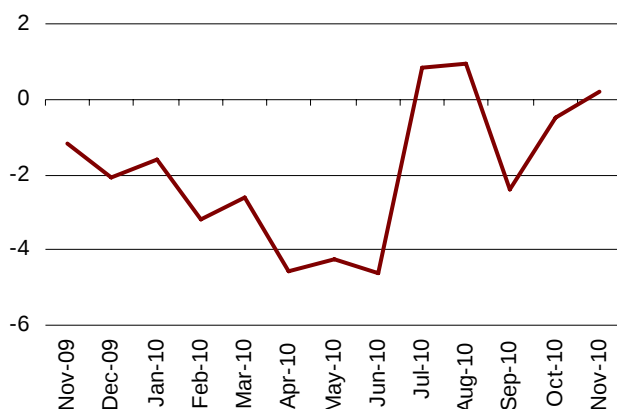
Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 0.2% in November, a rate 0.7 points higher than that recorded the previous month.

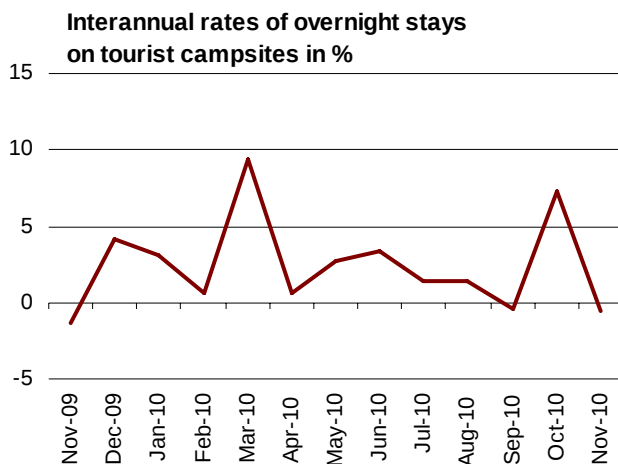
The rate for *Tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (67.1%), registered an increase of 0.1% as compared with the same month the previous year.

By modality, 2/4-bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 75.1%, decreased their prices by 0.1%.

Tourist Campsites



Tourist campsites reached 736,868 overnight stays in the month of November, indicating an interannual decrease of 0.5%. Overnight stays of resident travellers decreased 9.4%, and those of non-resident travellers increased 3.6%.

Tourist campsites offered 293,154 bedplaces, 1.8% less than in November 2009. 33.3% of the available lots were occupied, 6.2% more. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 34.8%, with an interannual increase of 3.4%.

71.1% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 33.1% of the overnight stays by non-residents (14.3% less than in November 2009). The following country of origin was Germany.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 327,595 overnight stays, 1.8% more. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with 137,513 overnight stays, indicating an interannual decrease of 6.2%.

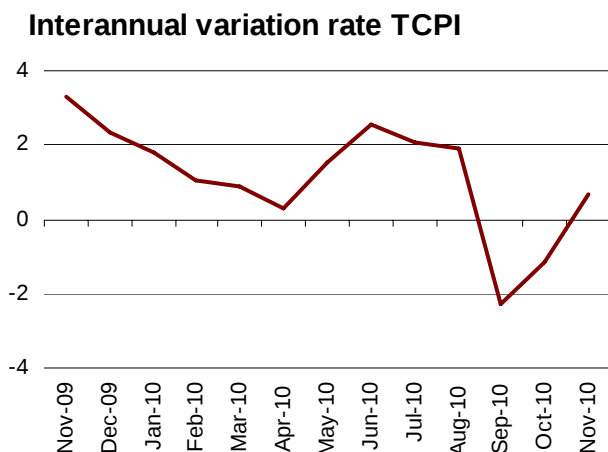
Among residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 60.9% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (48.8%) and Comunidad de Madrid (44.6%).

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 214,852 overnight stays and an occupancy of 63.5% of the available holiday dwellings.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays in November were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.7% in November. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (45.9%), presented a decrease of 0.1%.

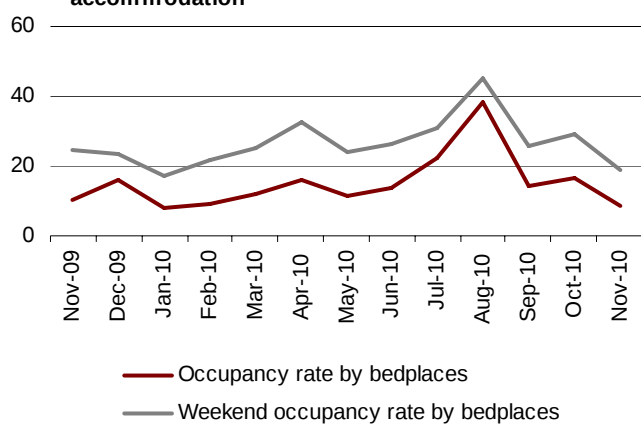
Regarding category, *second class*, with a weighting of 53.7% this month, registered an interannual increase of 0.1%.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

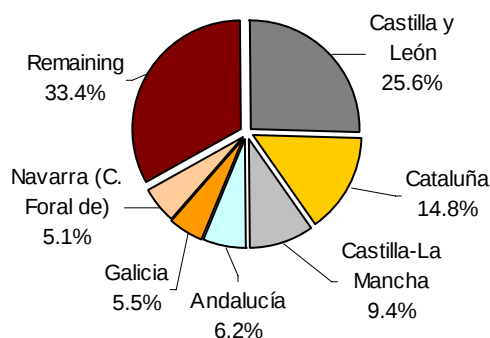
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 355,059 in November, indicating an interannual decrease of 15.1%. Resident overnight stays decreased 19.2%, whereas those by non-residents grew 18.6%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 130,614 bedplaces, 3.1% more than in November 2009. 8.5% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 17.5% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 19.1%, that is, 21.7% less in the interannual rate.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 74,357 overnight stays, 26.2% less than in November 2009. It was followed by Cataluña, with 43,401 overnight stays, 13.1% less.

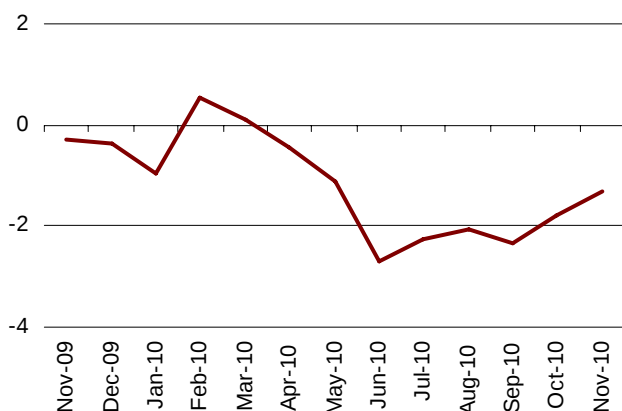
Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha.

Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 20.5% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by Illes Balears (18.1%) and La Rioja (14.7%).

By tourist area, the Pirineo Catalán was the main destination, with 22,588 overnight stays. The island of Tenerife reached the highest occupancy (25.5%).

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 1.3% in November.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (74.5%), fell 1.8%. By rent modality, *complete use*, whose weighting was 71.8%, registered an interannual decrease of 1.4% in November.

Annex

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 4.6% in November**. Overnight stays by residents decreased 2.4%, and non-resident stays increased 9.7%.

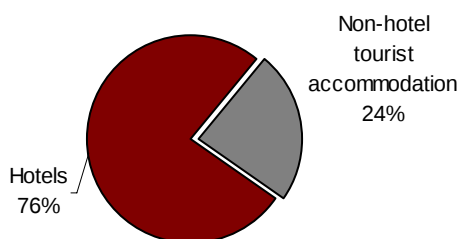
In November the average stay increased 0.7%, standing at 3.3 nights per traveller.

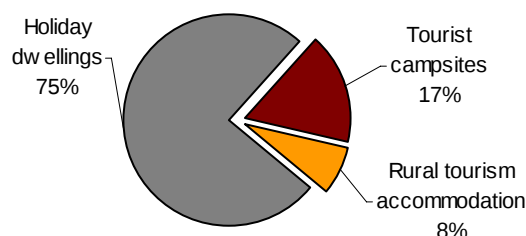

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of November, 76% were accounted for at hotels, and 24% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 24.6% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (23.0%) and France (4.7%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 6.8 million overnight stays (6.8% more than in November 2009). It was followed by Andalucía, with more than 2.4 million overnight stays (0.4% more) and Cataluña, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays (11.1% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía. In turn, Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
