Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
November 2011. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 8.5%¹ in November, as compared with the same month of 2010

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 4.7 million in November, 8.5% more than in the same month of 2010. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 7.7% and by non-residents 8.7%.

The average stay decreased 1.0%, as compared with November 2010, standing at 6.4 overnights per traveller.

In the first eleven months of the year, overnight stays increased 5.3% as compared with the same period the previous year.



Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.6 million in November, with an interannual increase of 8.8%¹, as compared with the same period the previous year. Overnight stays of residents increased 4.3%, those of non-residents 9.5%.

The average stay increased 1.7%, as compared with November 2010, standing at 8.0 overnights per traveller.

¹ Due to the update made in the tourist accommodation directory in Comunidad Foral de Navarra, the data published cannot be directly compared to that published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Holiday dwellings offered 342,213 bedplaces, 1.4% more than in November 2010. This month, 35.2% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 7.3% more. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 37.1%, with an increase of 7.2% in the interannual rate. In turn, 58.6% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual increase of 8.6%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 86.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 922,821 overnight stays, 3.8% more than in November last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 572,233 overnight stays, 7.8% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.7 million overnight stays, 11.0% more than in November 2010. The second destination of choice was Andalucía, with 249,781 overnight stays, 4.7% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucia.

Canarias showed the highest occupancy rate, with 80.1% of the available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (64.2%) and Illes Balears (61.0%).

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canarias was the preferred destination in holiday dwellings, with more than one million overnight stays, and an occupancy of 87.8% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.


Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 1.6% in November, the same rate than that recorded the previous month.


The *Tour-operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (60.9%), registered an increase of 2.6%, as compared with the same month the previous year.

By modality, 2/4-bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 75.3%, increased their prices 1.9%.

Tourist Campsites



Tourist campsites reached 768,930 overnight stays in November, indicating an interannual increase of 5.2%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 9.6%, and non-resident travellers 3.3%.

Tourist campsites offered 292,232 bedplaces, 0.3% less than in November 2010. 33.2% of the available lots were occupied, 2.2% more. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 35.0%, with an interannual increase of 0.4%.

69.4% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 35.8% of the overnight stays by non-residents (8.8% more than in November 2010). The following country of origin was Germany.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 344,169 overnight stays, 6.7% more. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with 134,478 overnight stays, indicating an interannual decrease of 2.0%.


Among residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 58.1% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (47.1%) and Comunitat Valencina (45.1%).

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 211,070 overnight stays, with an occupancy of 61.2% of the lots offered.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays in November were Benidorm, Cartagena and Mazarrón.

Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 2.1% in November. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (44.3%), presented an increase of 2.1%.


Regarding category, *second class*, with a weighting of 50.0% this month, registered an interannual increase of 1.0%.

Rural Tourism Accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 375,077 in November, indicating an interannual decrease of 12.8%¹. Resident overnight stays grew 12.2%, by non-residents 15.8%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 137,738 bedplaces, 4.9% more than in November 2010. 9.1% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 7.5% increase. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 20.3%, 7.4% more.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 80,218 overnight stays, 8.8% more than in November 2010. It was followed by Cataluña, with 46,965 overnight stays, 7.9% more.


Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha.

Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 28.7% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by La Rioja (15.9%) and Illes Balears (14.3%).

By tourist area, Pirineus-PrePirineus was the main destination, with 17,770 overnight stays. The island of Gran Canarias reached the highest occupancy with 28.5% of the available bedplaces.

Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.3% in November. The weekend rate, which accounted for 73.4% of the total weight, increased 0.7%. By rent modality, *complete use*, whose weighting was 65.9%, increased 0.9%.

By Autonomous Community Castilla y León, Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha, which accounted for 47.4% of the total weight in the month of November, registered interannual rates of -0.2%, 3.1% and -0.4%, respectively.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 3.3%¹ in November**. Overnight stays by residents decreased 2.3%, and non-resident stays increased 7.0%.


The average stay increased 3.5%, standing at 3.4 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of November, 75% were accounted for at hotels, and 25% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 25.0% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (22.0%) and France (4.7%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.7 million overnight stays (9.9% more than in November 2010). It was followed by Andalucía, with 2.4 million overnight stays (2.8% less) and Cataluña, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays (1.7% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña, and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
