Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey

November 2012. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation **increased 0.3%** in November, as compared with the same month of 2011

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 4.7 million in November, **0.3% more** than in the same month of 2011. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased **1.7%**, whilst by non-residents decreased **0.1%**. The average stay **decreased 0.3%**, standing at 6.5 overnights per traveller.

In the first eleven months of the year, overnight stays decreased 1.3% as compared with the same period the previous year.

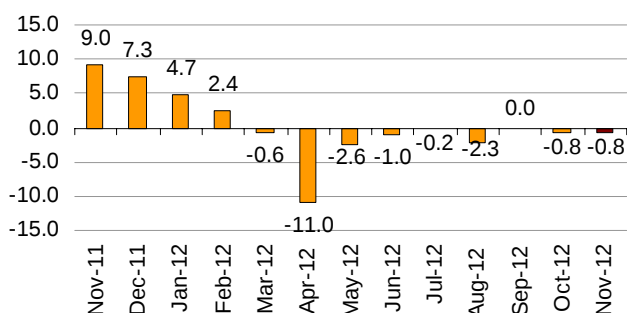
Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 0.8% in November. Overnight stays of residents decreased 6.8%, whilst of non-residents increased 0.1%.

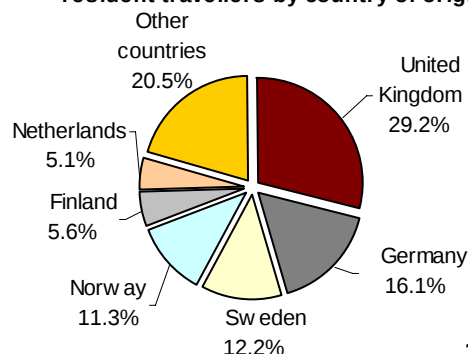
The average stay decreased 1.4%, standing at 7.9 overnights stays per traveller.

In November, 33.6% of the total available bedplaces for holiday dwellings were occupied, 2.5% less than in November 2011. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 35.6%, with an annual decrease of 1.7%.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings of non-resident travellers by country of origin in %



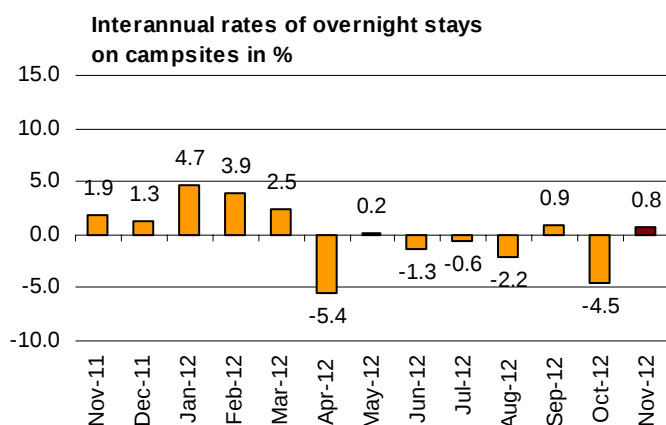
Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 87.0% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 917,509 overnight stays, 1.5% less than in November last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 505,030 overnight stays, 11.2% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with a decrease of 3.9% and Andalucía, with 10.1% more. Canarias presented the highest occupancy rate with 75.3% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in holiday dwellings, with more than one million of overnight stays and an occupancy of 83.6%.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

Tourist Campsites



The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 0.8%, in November. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 6.5%, whilst non-resident travellers decreased 1.7%.

31.9% of the offered lots were occupied, 1.3% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 33.6%, with an annual decrease of 2.0%.

68.5% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 34.6% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 5.3% less than in November 2011.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 346,406 overnight stays, 5.5% more. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 63.7% of the lots offered.

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 201,347 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 60.5% of the lots offered.

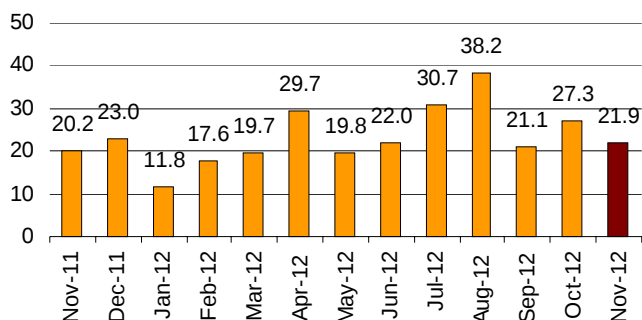
The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Mazarrón.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

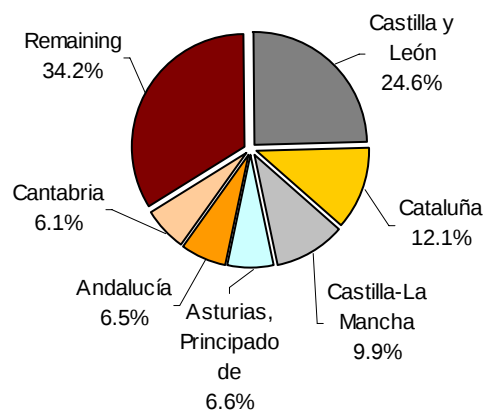
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 10.6%, in November. Resident overnight stays increased 11.8%, and those of non-residents growth 4.0%.

9.7% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 7.5% of annual decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 21.9%, with an increase of 8.6%.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 88,848 overnight stays, 12.1% more than in November 2011. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 25.1% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, the Pirineus was the main destination, with 19,157 overnight stays. The Teide National Park reached an occupancy rate of 34.6% of the offered bedplaces.

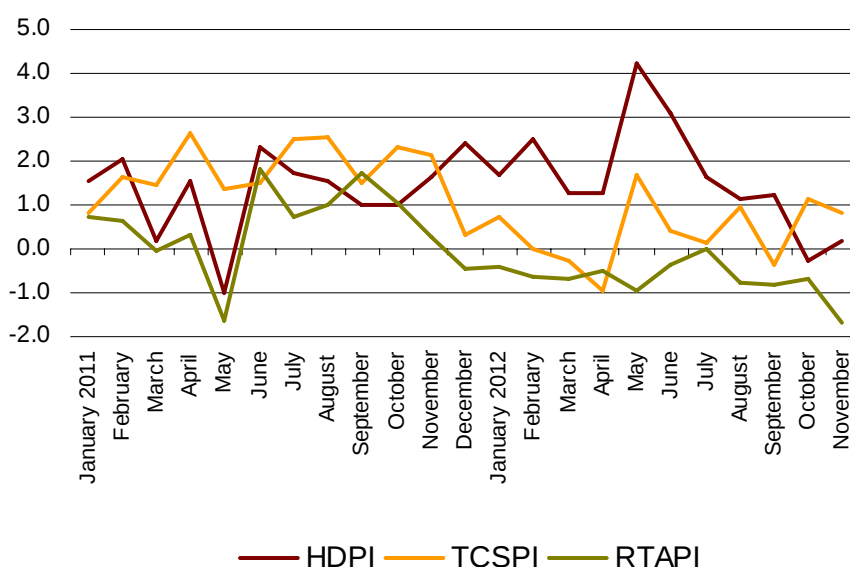
Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an annual rise of 0.2% in November, rate 0.5 points higher than that registered the previous month. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (62.1%), registered an increase of 0.7%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index registered an increase of 0.8%, as compared with November 2011. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (50.0%), increased 0.9%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered a decrease of 1.7% in November. The *week end* rate, which accounted for 73.6% of the total weight, decreased 1.9%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In November, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an annual decrease of **3.8%**.

Overnight stays by residents decreased **10.5%**, whereas non-resident stays increased **0.3%**.

The average stay decreased 1.5%, standing at 3.4 nights per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of November, 74% were accounted for at hotels, and 26% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were United Kingdom (with 24.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (22.3%) and France (5.6%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.4 million overnight stays (**4.0%** less than in November 2011). It was followed by Andalucía, with more than 2.2 million overnight stays (8.0% less) and Cataluña, with more than 2.2 million overnight stays (**2.3%** more).
