

## Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey

November 2019. Provisional data

### Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations decreased by 1.4% in December compared with the same month in 2018

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 5.8 million in November, 1.4% less than in the same month for 2018. Resident overnight stays increased 1.6% while non-resident overnight stays decreased 2.6%.

The average stay stood at 4.7 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first 11 months of 2019, overnight stays decreased by 0.4% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

### Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased by 4.0% in November. Overnight stays by residents increased 0.9%, while those by non-residents decreased by 5.1%.


It should be noted that the annual variation rates of overnight stays in tourist apartments show negative growth over the last months (with the exception of April and August 2019, when Easter and Summer vacations took place, respectively). This is mainly due to holiday apartments that are being reclassified as holiday dwellings for tourist use; therefore leaving the observational scope of the Holiday Dwellings Occupancy Survey (EOAP).

The average stay decreased 7.9% as compared with November 2018, standing at 5.7 overnight stays per traveller.

In November, 30.8% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 8.0% less than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 34.3%, with a decrease of 8.1%.

### Annual variation rates for Overnight stays


Percentage



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 81.0% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.0 million overnight stays, that is, 5.5% less than in November 2018. The following country of origin was Germany, with 461,545 overnight stays, 9.1% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.3 million overnight stays, and a decrease of 6.8% as compared with November 2018. It also showed the highest occupancy rate, at 78.4% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 839,268 overnight stays. It also had the highest occupancy rate, at 84.8% of the holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in November were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

## Tourist Campsites


Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 5.5% in November as compared with the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 1.9%, and those of non-residents by 7.3%.

In November, 36.4% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 1.0% more than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 38.9%, with an increase of 2.0%.

Non-residents accounted for 67.8% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 33.3% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 2.1% more than in November 2018.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 592,455 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 8.0%. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 60.7% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca recorded the highest number of overnight stays (333,535) and the highest occupancy rate (79.5% of the pitches offered).

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.


## Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodations showed an annual increase of 2.6% in November. Resident overnight stays rose by 2.0% and those of non-residents by 6.1%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 13.3% of the bed-places were occupied in November, 0.3% less than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 29.3%, with a decrease of 1.2%.

Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 121,999 overnight stays, 4.4% less than in November 2018. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 31.3% of bed-places offered.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 29,176 overnight stays. The Parque Nacional del Teide reached the highest occupancy rate with 39.5% of the bedplaces offered.

## Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 0.8% in November. Overnight stays by residents increased 3.2%, while those by non-residents decreased by 3.1%.

### Annual variation rates for overnight stays



22.1% of the available bed-places were occupied, 3.1% less than in November 2018. The weekend occupancy rate reached 28.2%, with a 8.0% decrease.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 56,019 overnight stays, 12.3% more than in November 2018. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 54.2% of the bed-places offered.


## Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) dropped 1.9% in November as compared to the same month in 2018.

For its part, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 2.9% and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) increased by 1.6%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) remained unchanged in November compared with the same month in 2018. Those of residents recorded an annual increase of 0.9%, whilst those by non-residents dropped by 0.5%.

The average stay decreased 3.5% in November, and stood at 3.0 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays made in collective tourist accommodation, 76% corresponded to hotels and 24% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were the United Kingdom (with 24.3% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (17.6%) and France (5.5%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with 7.7 million overnight stays (3.6% less than in November 2018). It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.5 million overnight stays (and an increase of 1.2%) and Cataluña, with 3.0 million (and an annual increase of 3.9%).

## **Revision and updating of data**

In conjunction with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for the month of November in the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

## **Methodological note**

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday dwelling establishments and/or companies operating holiday dwellings.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period for the results:** monthly.

**Reference period of the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** on-going monthly survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period for the results:** monthly.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that all the establishments cover the whole month.

**Sample size:** approximately 1200 establishments.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Type of operation:** on-going monthly survey.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period for the results:** monthly.

**Reference period of the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
