

Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy
November 2021. Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation reached 5.2 million, compared to 1.4 million in the same month of 2020

During the first 11 months of 2021, overnight stays increased 57.6%, as compared to the same period of the previous year.


Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 5.2 million in November, compared to 1.4 million for same month of 2020.

By traveller origin, overnight stays by residents in Spain amounted to 1.8 million, representing 34.0% of total overnight stays. For their part, those of non-residents reached 3.4 million, which represented 66.0% of total overnight stays.


Compared to November 2019, overnight stays in non-hotel establishments showed a decrease of 13.6%. Overnight stays by travellers who reside in Spain decreased by 4.5%, and those of non-residents in Spain, by 18.1%.

During the first ten months of 2021, overnight stays increased 57.6%, as compared to the same period of the previous year.

Open establishments

In November, a total of 120,365 non-hotel accommodations were open in Spain, which represented 84.1% of the total directory of establishments in this month.

Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in rural tourist apartments exceeded 3.3 million in November, compared to 786,320 in the same month of 2020. On the basis of origin, overnight stays by travellers who are residents in Spain represent 24.2% of the total, while those by non-resident travelers account for 75.8%.

By communities, Canarias, Andalucía, and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations for travellers in the month of November, with 1.9 million, 488,420 and 388,695 overnight stays, respectively.

During the first 11 months of 2021, the number of overnight stays rose by 55.8% compared to the same period of 2020.

By tourist areas, the island of Tenerife was the preferred tourist apartment destination, with 638,123 overnight stays in November. It also had the highest occupancy rate, with 77.8% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in November were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Campgrounds

Overnight stays at campgrounds reached 1.1 million, compared to 539,761 in the same month of 2020. By origin, overnight stays by travellers who are residents in Spain represented 35.1% of the total, while those by non-resident travellers account for 64.9%.

During the first 11 months of 2021, total overnight stays at campgrounds rose by 60.9% compared to the same period of 2020.

In November, 37.4% of campsites were occupied. The weekend occupancy rate reached 38.4%.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 547,837 overnight stays. La Rioja showed the highest occupancy rate, with 55.2% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca (Alicante) was the preferred destination in November, with 289,549 overnight stays. It also had the highest occupancy rate, with 74.0% of the campsites offered.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Peñíscola and Cabanes.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation exceeded 567,718 in November, compared to 130,492 in the same month of 2020. By origin, overnight stays by travellers who are residents in Spain represented 81.1% of the total, while those by non-resident travellers account for 18.9%.

During the first 11 months of 2021, the number of overnight stays rose by 46.7% compared to the same period of 2020.

In rural tourism accommodations, 12.6% of bed-places were occupied in November. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 30.1%.

By autonomous communities, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 97,984 overnight stays. Canarias showed the highest occupancy rate, with 35.1% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, the Pirineo Navarro was the main destination, with 28,921 overnight stays. The Corona Forestal Natural Park reached the highest occupancy rate, with 48.2% of the bedplaces offered.

Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels¹ exceeded 203,905 million in November, compared to 26,470 in the same month of 2020. By origin, overnight stays by travellers who are residents in Spain represented 58.9% of the total, while those by non-resident travellers account for 41.1%.

During the first 11 months of 2021, the total of overnight stays fell by 85.2% compared to the same period of 2020.

In November, 13.0% of bed-places were occupied. The weekend occupancy rate reached 20.3%.

By communities, Andalucía was the main destination, with 49,498 overnight stays. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 55.2% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 12.4% in November compared to the same month of 2020, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 0.8%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 7.5%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In November, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels², holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased to 20.1 million. This was compared to 4.3 million for the same month of 2020. Of the total overnight stays, 39.0% corresponded to residents, and 61.0% to non-residents.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodations in November, 73.7% corresponded to hotels, and 26.3% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were the United Kingdom (with 21.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (20.7%) and France (8.3%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with more than 6.9 million overnight stays. It was followed by Andalucía (with 3.0 million) and Cataluña (with more than 2.2 million).

¹ Since January 2021, tourist hostels have been included in the survey, in addition to those belonging to the Spanish Youth Hostels Network. The data published are not comparable with those of August 2020, and [link coefficients](#) are thus published to allow the annual variation rates to be calculated.

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for November 2020 of the Occupancy Survey in: The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
