

Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
November 2022. Provisional Data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased by 11.9%, as compared with the same month of 2021

During the first 11 months of 2022, overnight stays increased 53.2%, as compared to the same period of the previous year.

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 5.9 million in November, compared to 5.3 million for same month of 2021; this supposed an increase of 11.9%. Overnight stays by residents grew by 3.5%, and those of non-residents by 16.3%.

The average stay stood at 4.5 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first 11 months of 2022, overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations increased 53.2%, as compared to the same period of the previous year. In terms of campsites, the accumulated overnight stays until November were above 2019 levels.

Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in tourist apartments: increased 12.9% in November, as compared with the same month of 2021 Resident overnight stays increased by 2.9% and non-resident overnight stays by 16.1%.

The average stay decreased 2.0%, standing at 5.6 overnight stays per traveller.

In November, 32.3% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 11.5% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 36.3%, with an increase of 11.7%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 77.8% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 946,622 overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 393,882.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays, and an increase of 13.8% as compared with November of 2021. It also had the highest occupancy rate, at 82.3% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Tenerife was the preferred destination, with 721,422 overnight stays. Isla de Lanzarote had the highest occupancy rate, with 84.5% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in November were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Campgrounds


Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 8.1% in November as compared with the same month in 2021. Those by residents grew by 6.2% and those by non-residents did so by 9.2%.

During November, 38.3% of the pitches offered were occupied, 1.0% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 40.4%, with a 3.1% annual increase.

Non-residents accounted for 65.9% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 34.6% of overnight stays by non-residents, 17.1% more than in November of 2021.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 579,838 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 6.8%. It also achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 59.0% of campsites offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca (Alicante) was the preferred destination, with 302,390 overnight stays. This area also had the highest occupancy rate, with 76.4% of the campsites offered.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Cabanes.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation had an annual decrease of 2.8% in November. Resident overnight stays decreased by 2.2% and non-resident overnight stays did so by 5.6%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay



In rural tourism accommodations, 12.2% of bed-places were occupied, 3.4% less than in November 2021. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 29.2%, with an annual decrease of 2.9%.

Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 102,976 overnight stays, 4.3% more than in November 2021. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 35.1% of bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 24,729 overnight stays. The Corona Forestal Natural Park reached the highest occupancy rate, with 41.0% of the bedplaces offered.

Percentage




Hostels

In November, there were 333,449 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 58.5%. Resident overnight stays increased by 20.4% and non-resident overnight stays by 113.5%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay



19.1% of the available bed-places were occupied, 40.2% more than in November 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 25.7%, with a 26.1% increase.

Percentage




Comunidad de Madrid was the main destination, with 79,299 overnight stays. It likewise reached the highest occupancy rate, with 62.7% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 6.7% in November compared to the same month of 2021, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 4.4%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 3.8%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In November, overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased by 16.3% in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays increased by 12.5% and non-resident overnight stays by 18.7%.

The average stay grew by 0.4%, to 3.1 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 74.8% corresponded to hotels, and 25.2% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were the United Kingdom (with 24.3% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (16.9%) and France (6.5%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 7.7 million overnight stays (11.1% more than in November 2021). It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.4 million overnight stays (and an increase of 14.5%) and Cataluña, with over 2.9 million, (and an annual increase of 29.5%).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for November 2021 in the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Population scope: rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
