**Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey  
Year 2009. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decreases  
9.1%\* in the year 2009 as compared with 2008**

The overnight stays recorded in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) reached the figure of 97.5 million in 2009, that is, 9.1% less than in 2008. The decrease in overnight stays took place for both residents (with an interannual rate of -1.9%) and non-residents (-13.3%).

**The average stay dropped 5.9% in 2009, standing at 5.9 nights per traveller.**


In turn, during the month of **December**, 4.9 million overnight stays were registered, 5.0% less than in the same month of 2008.

**Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 13.8% in 2009**


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 58.9 million in 2009, that is, 13.8% less than in 2008. This decrease was produced among both residents (with an interannual rate of -6.7%) and non-residents (-15.9%).

Of the total overnight stays during the year, **49.1% were accounted for in the months between June and September**. 74.9% of overnight stays were made by non-resident travellers, who represented 65.3% of the total travellers. During the year 2009, negative interannual variations were registered in overnight stays every month.

\* Due to the updating of the rural tourism accommodation directory of Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) is not directly comparable with the data published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published every month on the INE website, in the area dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled "linking coefficients".

Holiday dwellings offered an average of 442,550 bedplaces throughout the year 2009, that is, 0.2% more than in 2008. The **occupancy rate by bedplaces** reached an average of **36.2%**, that is, 13.3% lower than the previous year. The **weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood, on average, at 37.8%**, with an interannual decrease of 12.0%. In turn, an average of 51.1% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, 11.8% less.

**The British market consolidated its position as the main country of origin in holiday dwellings.** Travellers from the United Kingdom made more than 15.4 million overnight stays, 21.5% less than in 2008. The following country of origin was Germany, with more than 8.5 million overnight stays and an interannual rate of -15.0%.

**Canarias was the preferred** holiday dwelling destination, with more than 29.1 million overnight stays, 16.9% less than in 2008. The second destination of choice was Illes Balears, with more than 8.8 million overnight stays, 14.8% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Comunitat Valenciana were the preferred destinations. In turn, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.

**Illes Balears** presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with an average of 58.7% of the available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Canarias (57.6%) and Comunidad de Madrid (55.4%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with more than 10.9 million overnight stays. The island of Tenerife reached the highest average occupancy rate (62.0%) of the available holiday dwellings. The **tourist sites** with the most overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

### **Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 7.9% in the month of December**

During the past month of December, more than 3.5 million overnight stays were registered, 7.9% less than in the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents experienced an interannual drop of 5.3%, and those of non-residents decreased 10.3%. The average stay decreased 8.6% as compared with December 2008.


### **Holiday dwelling prices decrease an average of 1.7%<sup>1</sup>**

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an average decrease of 1.7% during the year 2009. The *tour-operator and travel agency* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for all of the months, presented an average decrease of 1.4%. By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weight exceeded 59% every month, decreased their prices an average of 2.1%.


In 2009, the interannual rate of the Holiday Dwelling Price Index remained between -3.5% and 1.6% (the only positive rate of the year, registered in the month of April).

**Holiday dwelling prices decreased 2.1% in December**, 1.5 points lower than the rate from the previous month.

## Overnight stays at tourist campsites decrease 1.3% in 2009



Overnight stays at tourist campsites exceeded the figure of 30.6 million in 2009, for an interannual decrease of 1.3%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 1.2%, while those by non-resident travellers decreased 4.1%. **70.0% of overnight stays were between June and September.**

Tourist campsites offered an average of 482,967 lots, 0.7% less than in 2008. An average of 36.5% of the available lots were occupied, 3.2% less. The average weekend occupancy rate by lots reached 39.4%, that is, 3.1% lower than in 2008.

Dutch, British, French and German citizens accounted for 24.4%, 21.7%, 18.0% and 16.6% of the total overnight stays by non-residents at tourist campsites in 2009, respectively. **The Dutch market, which once again was the main country of origin**, registered an increase of 3.4% in overnight stays, as compared with 2008.

**Cataluña** was the preferred destination in tourist campsites, with 13.3 million overnight stays, 3.7% less than in 2008. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with more 5.3 million overnight stays, 2.3% less.

Among non-residents, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the preferred destinations. In turn, Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers.

**La Rioja** reached the highest average occupancy rate for tourist campsites (with 64.6% of the available lots). It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (51.3%) and Comunidad de Madrid (47.1%).

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 6.4 million overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest average occupancy rate (58.2%).

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Torroella de Montgrí and Salou.

## Overnight stays increase 4.5% in the month of December

During the month of December, 813,947 overnight stays were registered, 4.5% more than for the same month the previous year. Overnight stays by residents increased 12.0% in the interannual rate, and those by non-residents increased 1.2%.


The average stay increased 3.8%, standing at 7.1 nights per traveller.

## Tourist campsite prices rise by an average of 3.1% <sup>1</sup> in 2009

The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an average growth of 3.1% in 2009. The *normal* rate, with a weighting greater than 43% every month of the year, presented an average increase of 3.5%.

By category, the *second* category, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure every month of the year (except June and July), increased an average of 2.7%.

The interannual rate for the Tourist Campsite Price Index remained between 4.3% and -1% throughout the year. The greatest increase was recorded in August.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index presented a rise of 2.3% in December, 0.9 points lower than the rate from the previous month.

## Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation increase 2.2%\* in the year 2009


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation exceeded 7.9 million in 2009, indicating a 0.3% interannual increase. Overnight stays by residents rose 2.2%, whereas those by non-residents dropped 9.1%.

Of the total overnight stays during the year, **48.8% were accounted for in the months between June and September**. 84.0% of overnight stays were by resident travellers, who represented 90.1% of the total travellers.


Rural tourism accommodation offered an average of 126,234 bedplaces throughout the year, 9.6% more than in 2008.

The occupancy rate by bedplaces reached an average of 16.9%, that is, 8.3% less than in 2008. The average weekend occupancy rate stood at 28.5%, that is, 6.6% less than that registered the previous year. The highest occupancy rates were reached during the months of April, July and August.

**Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation**, with more than 1.5 million overnight stays, 7.7% more than in 2008. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with more than one million overnight stays, this figure being similar to that recorded the previous year.

**Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination.** In turn, Castilla y León, Cataluña and Principado de Asturias were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers.

The **highest average occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation** was registered in **Illes Balears** (with 41.1% of the available bedplaces). It was followed by País Vasco (25.2%) and Cantabria (21.9%).

By **tourist area**, Pirineo Catalán was the preferred destination with 489,210 overnight stays. The island of Mallorca reached the highest average occupancy rate (42.2%).

### Overnight stays increase 0.8% in the month of December


During the month of December, 620,114 overnight stays were registered, 0.8% more than for the same month the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 4.0%, whilst those by non-residents decreased 30.4%.

### Rural tourism accommodation prices rise an average of 0.3%<sup>1</sup>

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered an average growth of 0.3% during the year 2009. The *weekend* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for every month of the year (except July, August and September), presented an average decrease of 0.5%. By rent modality, *complete use*, with a weighting over 51% every month, increased an average of 0.6% in price.

The interannual rates of the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index ranged between the -1.1% reached in the month of May and the 1.7% registered in January.

Rural tourist accommodation prices decreased 0.4% in December, three hundredths of a point higher than the rate from the previous month.



<sup>1</sup>The average interannual variation rates of the year for the HDPI, TCPI and RTAPI have been calculated as the average of the variation rates of the HDPI, TCPI AND RTAPI, weighted by the occupied holiday dwellings, occupied lots and occupied rooms-accommodation, respectively, for each month.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

**Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation** (hotels, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an interannual decrease of **7.4%\*** in 2009. This decrease took place among both residents (whose interannual rate stood at -2.9%) and non-residents (-10.5%).


In 2009, the average stay decreased 1.4% to 3.7 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the year 2009, 72.1% corresponded to hotels and 27.9% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 26.3% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (with 25.5%) and France (with 7.3%).

**Canarias** was the **preferred destination** regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 74.9 million overnight stays, 13.8% less than in 2008. It was followed by Cataluña, with more than 61 million overnight stays (3.4% less) and Illes Balears, with more than 55.4 million overnight stays (8.5% less).

Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the destinations preferred by non-residents. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
