**Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
Year 2011. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 5.2%<sup>1</sup> in 2011**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) reached 102.8 million in 2011, 5.2% more than in 2010. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 1.6% and by non-residents 7.5%.

The average stay decreased 0.7%, standing at 5.8 overnights per traveller.




### Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 7.1%<sup>1</sup> in 2011. Overnight stays of residents increased 2.3%, and of non-residents 8.8%. Of the total overnight stays during the year, 51.0% were accounted for in the months between June and September.

Holiday dwellings offered 434,049 bedplaces, 0.3% less than in 2010. The occupancy rate by bedplace increased 7.3%, and the weekend occupancy rate increased 6.7% in the interannual rate. Regarding the total available holiday dwellings, an average of 57.4% were occupied, 10.1% more.

<sup>1</sup> Due to the update made in the tourist accommodation directory in Comunidad Foral de Navarra, the data published cannot be directly compared to that published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

The British market consolidated its position as the main country of origin in holiday dwellings. Travellers from the United Kingdom made more than 17.1 million overnight stays, 9.8% more than in 2010. The following country of origin was Germany, with 8.3 million overnight stays and an interannual rate of 1.1%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 30.8 million overnight stays, 7.9% more than in 2010. The second destination of choice was Illes Balears, with more than 9.6 million overnight stays, 5.9% more.

Canarias showed the highest average occupancy rate (69.3%). It was followed by Illes Balears (68.7%) and Comunidad de Madrid (63.8%).

### Tourist Campsites

Tourist campsites overnight stays increased 2.8% in 2011. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 2.9%, and by non-resident travellers 2.6%. Of the total overnight stays during the year, 71.3% were accounted for in the months between June and September.

Tourist campsites offered an average of 478,391 bedplaces, 1.5% less than in 2010. The occupancy rate by lots increased 2.7% and the weekend rate by lots 1.2%.



The Dutch market, which once again was the main country of origin. Of the total overnight stays, 24.7% were accounted by the Dutch market and registered an increase of 2.2% in overnight stays. It was followed by British and French, with a 19.7% and 19.4% of the total, respectively.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 14.1 million of overnight stays, 5.3% more than in 2010. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 5.6 million of overnight stays, 1.5% more.

La Rioja reached the highest average occupancy rate on campsites (62.9%). It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (50.8%) and Comunitat Valenciana (49.5%).

### Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation registered an increase of 0.3%<sup>1</sup> in 2011. Meanwhile resident overnight stays decreased 3.5%, by non-residents increased 19.3%. Of the total overnight stays during the year, 51.8% were accounted for in the months between June and September.



Rural tourism accommodation offered an average of 137,727 bedplaces during the year, 4.6% more than in 2010. The occupancy rate by bedplaces decreased 4.1% and the weekend occupancy decreased 6.0%.


Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 1.4 million overnight stays, 0.6% less than in 2010. It was followed by Cataluña, with 925,664 overnight stays, 2.8% more.

Illes Balears reached the highest average occupancy rate (45.2%). It was followed by Canarias (23.8%) and País Vasco (21.0%).

### Price Index Evolution

In 2011, the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (IPAP) registered an average increase<sup>2</sup> of 1.4%.

In turn, Tourist Campsite Price Index (IPAC) experienced an average growth<sup>2</sup> of 1.8% and Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (IPTR) registered an average increase<sup>2</sup> of 0.6%.



### December results

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) registered 4.9 million in December, 3.0%<sup>1</sup> more than in the same month of 2010.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 7.7%<sup>1</sup>, and the average stay grew 3.1%, as compared with the same month of 2010. In turn, the holiday dwelling price index increased 2.4%.

Overnight stays in tourist campsite increased 0.4% in December, and the average stay grew 0.5%. The tourist campsite price index increased 0.3%.

In turn, overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation decreased 17.4%<sup>1</sup> in December. Its prices drop 0.4%.

<sup>2</sup> The average annual percentage changes in the IPAP year, IPAC and IPTR are calculated as the average of the rates of change of the IPAP, IPAC and IPTR, weighted by the apartments occupied lots occupied and rooms occupied, respectively, of each month.

## Annex

### Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 6.1%<sup>1</sup> in 2011**. Overnight stays by residents decreased 1.2%, whereas non-resident stays increased 7.0%.


The average stay increased 2.1%, standing at 3.8 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in 2011, 74% were accounted for at hotels, and 26% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main market of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were British (with 25.0% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), German (24.5%) and French (7.5%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 89.6 million overnight stays (10.6% more than in 2010). It was followed by Cataluña, with 68.9 million overnight stays (6.0% more) and Illes Balears, with more than 64.5 million overnight stays (10.9% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña, and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
