Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey¹
December 2012. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation), increase 1.1% in December, as compared with the same month of 2011

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded 5 million in December, 1.1% more than in the same month of 2011. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 5.4%, whilst by non-residents increased 3.6%. The average stay increased 0.3%, standing at 6.1 overnights per traveller.

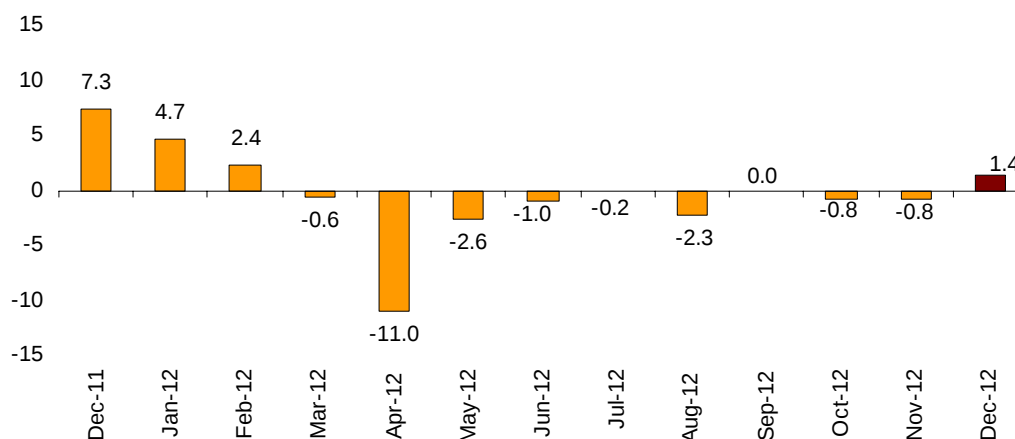

Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 1.4% in December. Overnight stays of residents decreased 9.0%, whilst of non-residents increased 3.6%.

The average stay did not show any variation as compared with December 2011, standing at 7.4 overnights stays per traveller.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in holiday dwellings

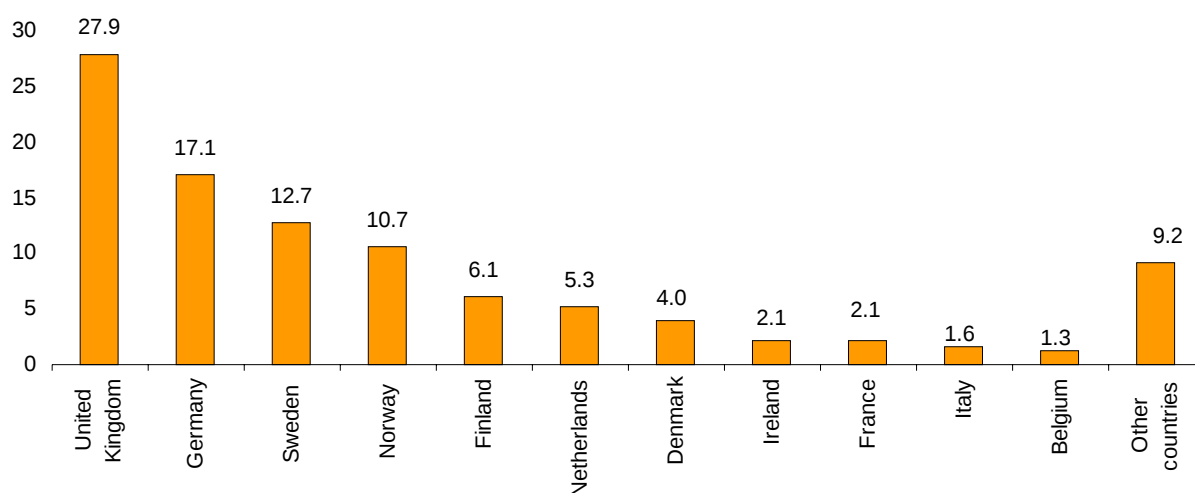

In December, 32.6% of the total available bedplaces for holiday dwellings were occupied, 1.3% less than in December 2011. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 34.6%, with an annual decrease of 0.1%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 84.6% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 862,721 overnight stays, 4.0% more than in December last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 527,669 overnight stays, 1.9% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 0.3% more overnight stays and Comunitat Valenciana, with 20.0% more. Canarias presented the highest occupancy rate with 72.9% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with almost 1.1 million of overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 80.1%.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Mogán and Arona.

Campsites

The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an annual decrease of 1.4%, in December. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 11.3%, whilst non-resident travellers increased 3.5%.

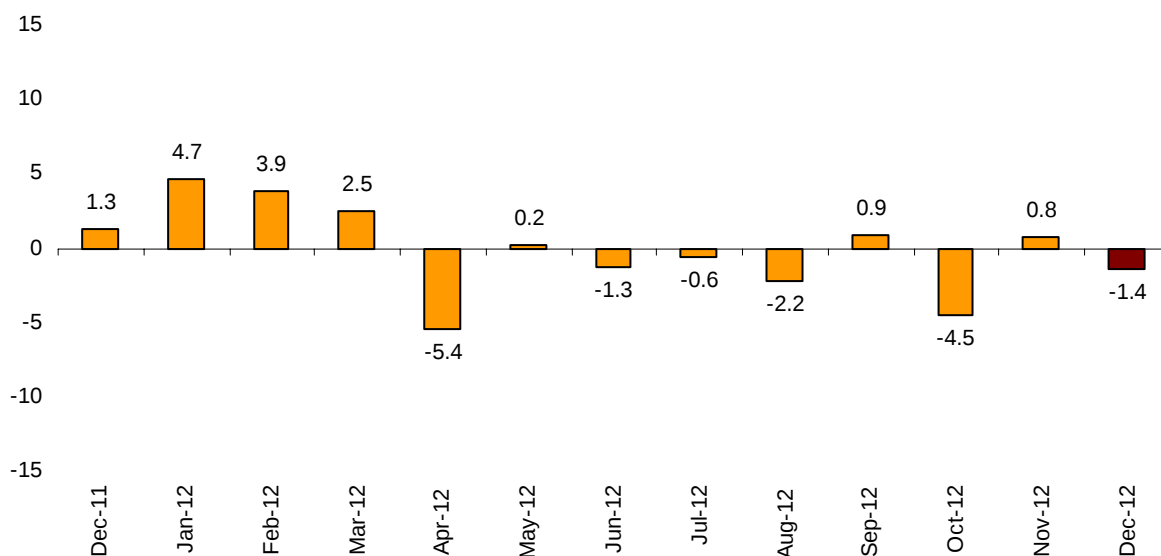
32.0% of the offered lots were occupied, 3.0% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 33.0%, with an annual increase of 0.9%.

70.3% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 35.9% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 1.9% more than in December 2011.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 372,717 overnight stays, 6.2% more. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 66.6% of the lots offered.

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 224.104 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 61.8% of the lots offered.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in campsites

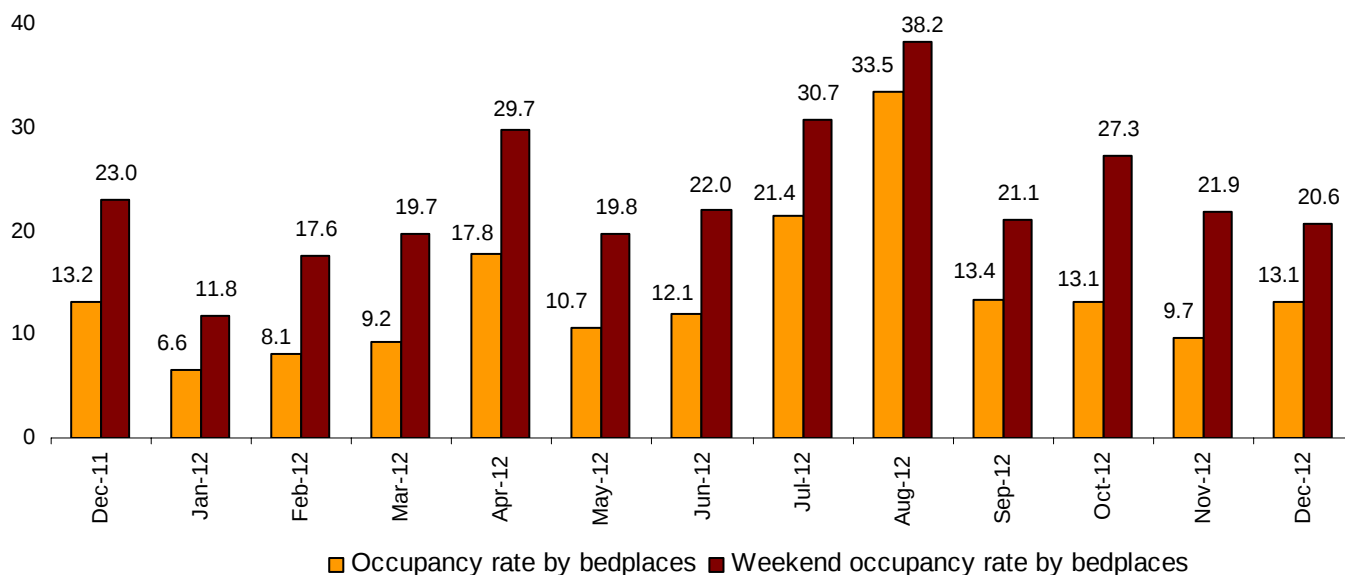


Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 2.3%, in December. Resident overnight stays increased 2.0%, and those of non-residents grew 4.5%.

13.1% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 0.5% of annual decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 20.6%, with a decrease of 10.4%.

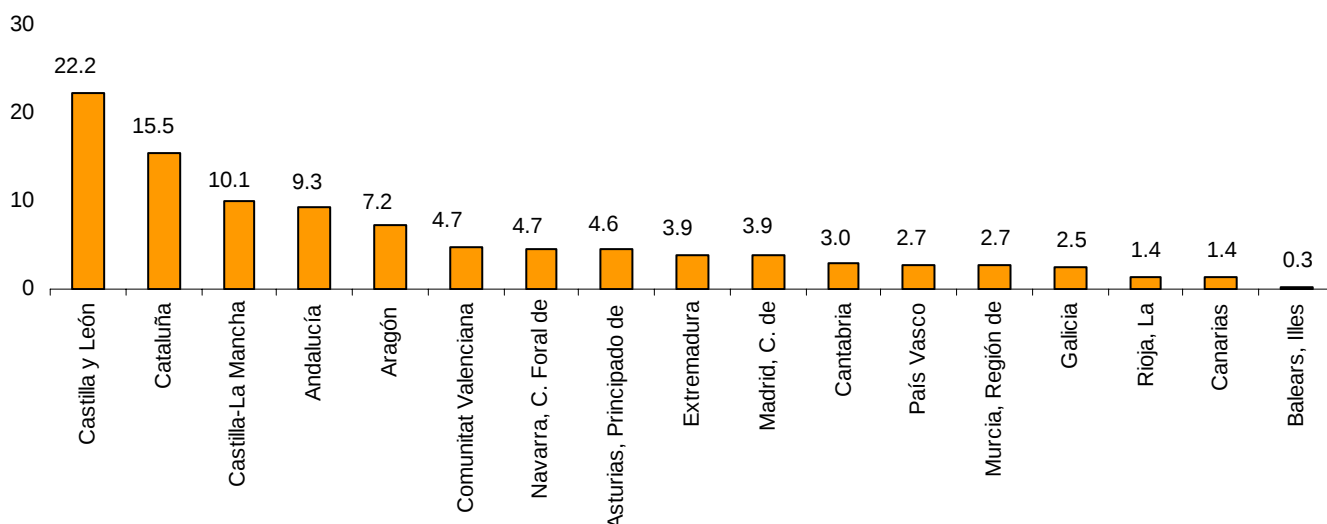
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 115,109 overnight stays, 0.2% less than in December 2011. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 29.0% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, the Pirineus was the main destination, with 35,211 overnight stays. The Teide National Park reached the greatest occupancy rate, 39.8% of the offered bedplaces.

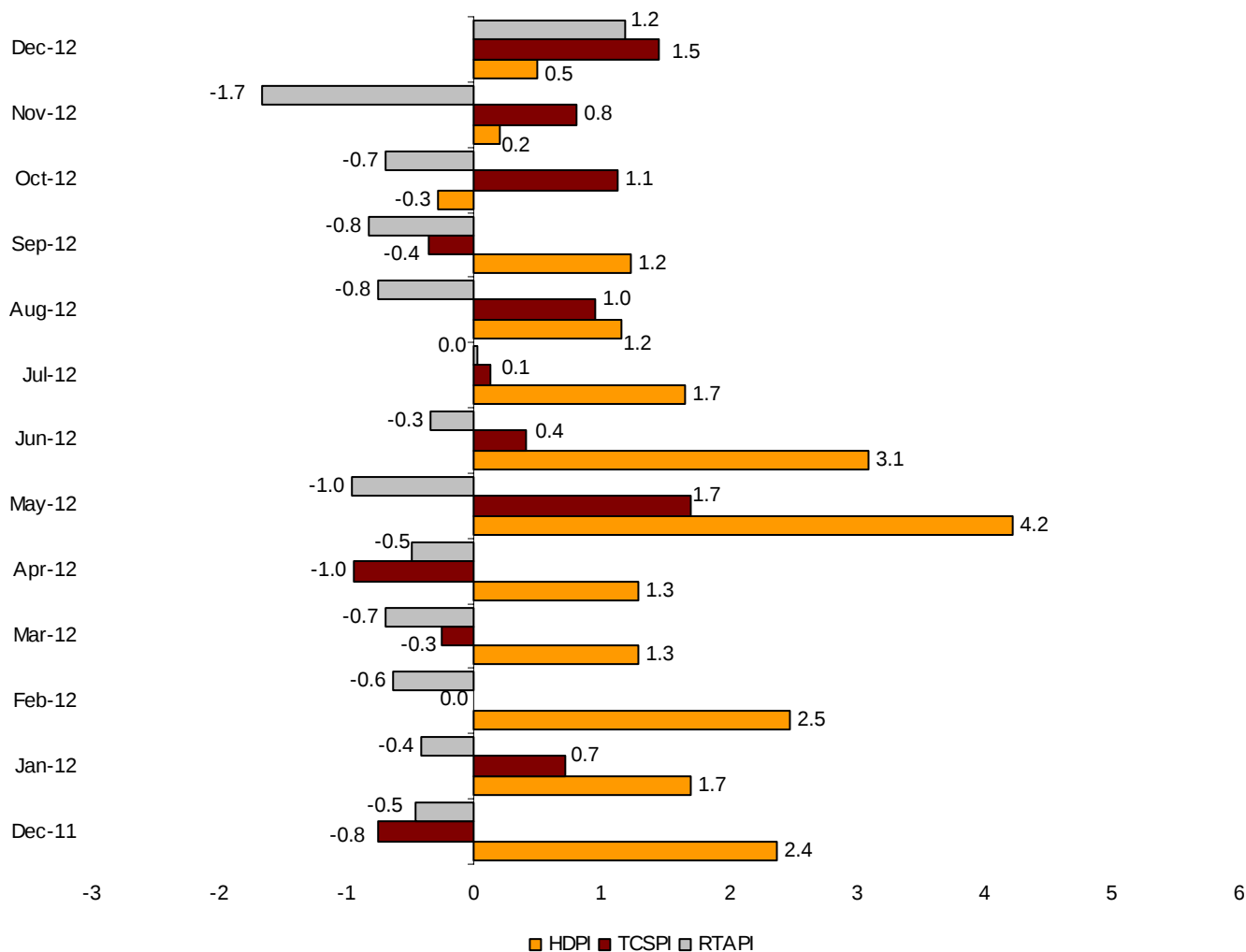
Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an annual rise of 0.5% in December, rate 0.3 points higher than that registered the previous month. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (58.0%), registered a decrease of 0.1%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index registered an increase of 1.5%, as compared with December 2011. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (47.9%), increased 1.5%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered a decrease of 1.2% in December. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 67.9% of the total weight, decreased 1.1%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation in December

In December, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an annual decrease of 3.4%.

Overnight stays by residents decreased 11.6%, whereas non-resident stays increased 2.4%.

The average stay increased 1.4%, standing at 3.4 nights per traveller.

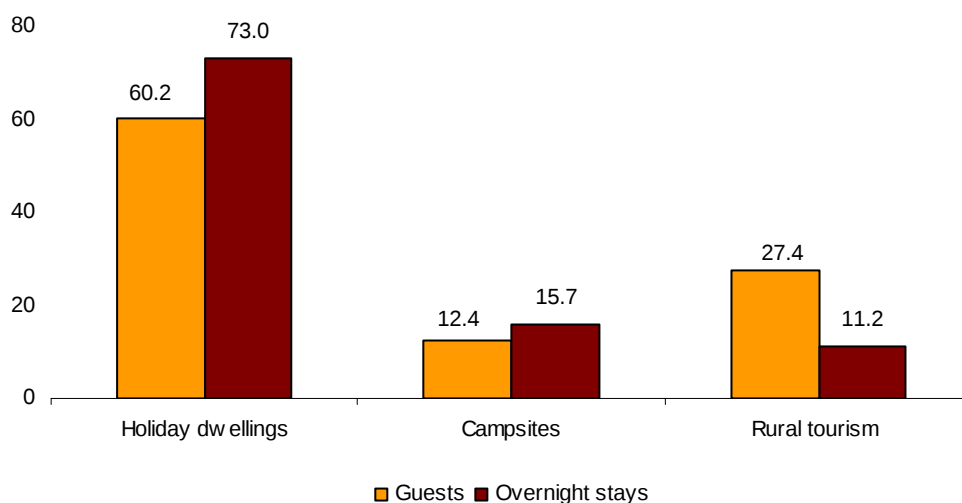

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of December, 71% were accounted for at hotels, and 29% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were United Kingdom (with 24.8% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (22.2%) and Holland (4.9%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.3 million overnight stays (0.8% more than in December 2011). It was followed by Andalucía, with almost than 2.2 million overnight stays (9.5% less) and Cataluña, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays (3.3% less).
