**Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros**  
Diciembre 2015 y año 2015. *Datos provisionales*

**Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros aumentan un 8,3% en diciembre respecto al mismo mes de 2014**

**En el conjunto de 2015 las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros alcanzaron la cifra de 113,8 millones, un 4,7% más que en el año anterior**

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superan los 5,7 millones en diciembre, un 8,3% más que en el mismo mes de 2014. Las pernoctaciones de residentes aumentan un 16,6% y las de no residentes un 5,0%.

La estancia media es de 5,4 pernoctaciones por viajero.


**Apartamentos turísticos**

Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 7,7% en diciembre. Las de residentes suben un 26,0% y las de no residentes un 4,0%.

La estancia media baja un 6,0% respecto a diciembre de 2014, situándose en 6,6 pernoctaciones por viajero.


En diciembre se ocupan el 35,2% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 5,9% más que en el mismo mes de 2014. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 36,1%, con un incremento del 2,9%.

Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos turísticos representan el 80,0% del total. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con 975.048 pernoctaciones, un 9,5% más que en diciembre de 2014. El siguiente mercado emisor es Alemania, con 474.085 pernoctaciones, un 8,2% menos.

Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 2,6 millones de pernoctaciones, un 2,7% más que en diciembre de 2014. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 79,5% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Gran Canaria es el destino preferido, con 945.314 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 85,0% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones en diciembre son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Mogán y Arona.


## Campings

Las pernoctaciones en campings registran en diciembre un incremento anual del 7,9% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior. Las de residentes aumentan un 4,2% y las de no residentes un 9,5%.

Durante el mes de diciembre se ocupan el 35,2% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 5,8% más. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 34,7%, con un aumento anual del 3,2%.

El 70,9% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizan viajeros no residentes. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con el 37,3% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes, un 24,5% más que en diciembre de 2014.

Comunitat Valenciana es el destino preferido en campings, con 490.871 pernoctaciones, un 12,1% más que en diciembre de 2014.

La Rioja es la comunidad con el mayor grado de ocupación, el 64,7% de las parcelas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Blanca es el destino preferido, con 296.542 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 74,7% de las parcelas ofertadas.


Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones son Benidorm, Cartagena y Marbella.

## Alojamientos de turismo rural

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural presentan un aumento anual del 12,4% en diciembre. Las de residentes suben un 12,4% y las de no residentes un 12,6%.

En los alojamientos de turismo rural se ocupan el 15,8% de las plazas, con un crecimiento del 10,1% respecto a diciembre de 2014. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 28,1%, con un incremento del 2,0%.


Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



Por comunidades, Castilla y León es el destino preferido, con 142.855 pernoctaciones, un 10,7% más que en diciembre de 2014. Canarias alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 33,8% de las plazas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, Pirineus es el principal destino, con 37.407 pernoctaciones. El Parque Nacional del Teide alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 36,6% de las plazas ofertadas.

## Albergues

Las pernoctaciones en albergues registran en diciembre un aumento anual del 5,0%. Las de residentes suben un 10,5%, mientras que las pernoctaciones de no residentes bajan un 5,9%.

Se ocupan el 16,5% de las plazas, un 11,2% más que en diciembre de 2014. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana alcanza el 24,3%, con un descenso del 17,6%.

Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 38.743 pernoctaciones, un 10,2% más que en diciembre de 2014. Comunidad de Madrid alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 29,2% de las plazas ofertadas.


## Índices de precios

El Índice de Precios de Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) aumenta un 4,8% respecto a diciembre de 2014. La tarifa *tour-operadores y agencias de viajes*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (57,2%), sube un 6,8%.

El Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) permanece invariable respecto a diciembre de 2014. La tarifa *bungalow*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones en diciembre (39,7%), baja un 1,3% respecto al mismo mes de 2014.

El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) registra un aumento del 1,5% en diciembre. La tarifa *fin de semana*, que supone el 56,2% del peso total, sube un 1,7% en tasa anual.

## Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles

Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles<sup>1</sup>, apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) aumentan un 7,3% en diciembre en tasa anual. Tanto las de residentes como las de no residentes crecen un 7,3%.


La estancia media sube un 0,3%, situándose en 3,3 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 72% corresponde a hoteles y un 28% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.

Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 26,7% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (19,2%) y el francés (5,8%).

Canarias es el destino preferido, con más de 7,9 millones de pernoctaciones (un 4,7% más que en diciembre de 2014). Le siguen Andalucía, con más de 2,7 millones (y un aumento anual del 12,3%) y Cataluña, con más de 2,4 millones (y un incremento del 3,3%).



## Resultados del conjunto del año 2015

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) alcanzaron la cifra de 113,8 millones en el conjunto de 2015, un 4,7% más que en el año anterior. Las pernoctaciones de residentes aumentaron un 7,7% y las de no residentes un 3,0%.

El 60% de las pernoctaciones se realizaron en apartamentos turísticos, el 30% en campings, el 8% en alojamientos de turismo rural y el 2% restante en albergues.

Overnight annual growth rate in non-hotel accommodation. Annual serie




### Apartamentos turísticos

Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentaron un 2,9% en 2015. Las de residentes crecieron un 8,2% y las de los no residentes un 1,3%.

Los viajeros no residentes, que representaron un 64,2% del total, realizaron el 75,8% de las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos.


Overnight annual growth rate in holiday dwellings. Annual serie



En el año 2015 se cubrieron de media el 40,6% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 1,4% más que en 2014. El grado de ocupación medio por plazas en fin de semana se situó en el 43,3%, con un aumento del 2,1%.

Reino Unido se consolidó como primer mercado emisor en apartamentos turísticos, con 18,3 millones de pernoctaciones, un 0,2% más que en 2014. El siguiente mercado fue Alemania, con más de 8,1 millones de pernoctaciones, un 1,3% menos.

**Distribution of overnight stays of residents abroad of the 11 main countries by origin**




Canarias fue el destino preferido en apartamentos, con 29,7 millones de pernoctaciones, un 2,0% menos que en 2014. El segundo destino fue Illes Balears, con más de 9,5 millones de pernoctaciones, un 0,1% más. Estas dos comunidades presentaron el mayor grado de ocupación medio, con el 74,4% y el 71,8%, respectivamente.

## Campings

Las pernoctaciones en campings aumentaron un 6,7% en el año 2015. Las de residentes crecieron un 6,0% y las de no residentes un 7,6%.

**Overnight annual growth rate in campsites. Annual serie**




Los campings ofrecieron, de media, 492.409 plazas, un 0,9% más que en 2014. Se ocuparon el 38,2% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 3,7% más. El grado de ocupación medio por parcelas en fin de semana alcanzó el 40,5%, un 2,9% más que en 2014.

El 48,0% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizaron no residentes. El mercado holandés fue el principal mercado emisor, con el 23,9% del total de pernoctaciones, un 7,9% más que en 2014.

Cataluña fue el destino preferido en campings, con más de 15,2 millones pernoctaciones, un 4,3% más que en 2014. Por su parte, La Rioja alcanzó, en media, el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 62,0% de las parcelas ofertadas.

## Alojamientos de turismo rural

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural crecieron un 12,9% en 2015 hasta 8,7 millones. Las de no residentes aumentaron un 13,8% y las de residentes un 10,0%.



Los alojamientos de turismo rural ofrecieron, de media, 142.994 plazas, un 1,1% más que en 2014. El grado de ocupación medio fue del 16,6%, con un incremento del 11,6%. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana subió un 13,1% y se situó en el 29,5%.

Castilla y León fue el destino preferido, con 1,4 millones de pernoctaciones, un 4,6% más que en 2014.

## Albergues


Las pernoctaciones en albergues crecieron un 0,8% en 2015 y alcanzaron los 2,2 millones. Las de residentes bajaron un 1,9%, mientras que las de no residentes aumentaron un 6,9%.

Los albergues ofrecieron, de media, 23.517 plazas, un 0,4% menos que en 2014. El grado de ocupación medio en fin de semana bajó un 1,6% y se situó en el 33,5%.


Por comunidades, Cataluña fue el destino preferido, con 891.731 pernoctaciones, un 0,9% más que en 2014.

En el año 2015 el Índice de Precios en Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) registró una subida media del 4,2%.



Por su parte, el Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) sufrió un aumento medio del 0,5%.



El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) presentó un aumento medio del 0,9% en 2015.



## Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en los diferentes tipos de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles en 2015


Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles<sup>2</sup>, apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superaron los 422,0 millones de pernoctaciones en el conjunto de 2015, con un aumento del 4,5% respecto al año anterior.

Las pernoctaciones de residentes crecieron un 5,9% y las de no residentes un 3,6%. La estancia media bajó un 1,6% y se situó en 3,7 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 73% correspondió a hoteles y un 27% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.



Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados fueron el británico (con el 27,5% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (21,6%) y el francés (9,0%).

Por comunidades autónomas, Canarias fue el destino preferido, con más de 94,1 millones de pernoctaciones (un 0,1% menos que en 2014). Le siguieron Cataluña, con más de 75,3 millones (y un incremento del 3,6%) e Illes Balears, con más de 64,8 millones (y un crecimiento del 3,0%).
