

Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey

December 2017 and year 2017. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 4.2% in December, as compared with the same month of 2016

For 2017 as a whole, overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation reached 131.0 million, 5.8% more than in the previous year

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 6.4 million in December, 4.2% more than in the same month of 2016. Resident overnight stays increased 16.1% while non-resident overnight stays decreased 1.1%.

The average stay stood at 5.1 overnight stays per traveller.


Holiday dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased by 0.4% in December. Overnight stays by residents increased 6.2%, while those by non-residents decreased 2.1%.

The average stay decreased by 2.1% as compared with December 2016, standing at 6.0 overnight stays per traveller.


In December, 33.4% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 3.4% less than in the same month of 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 35.9%, with a decrease of 2.6%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 77.7% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 988,449 overnight stays, 5.2% less than in December 2016. The following country of origin was Germany, with 468,659 overnight stays, 6.5% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, 2.8% less than in December 2016. This Autonomous Community also presented the highest occupancy rate, with 80.5% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 982,640 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 86.1% of holiday dwellings offered.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in December were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Mogán and Arona.

Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 9.0% in December as compared to the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 23.3% and non-residents 2.7%.

During the month of December, 37.0% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 3.9% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 37.7%, with an annual increase of 3.9%.

65.6% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents travellers. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 35.6% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 3.7% more than in December 2016.



Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 555,504 overnight stays, 9.5% more than in December 2016.

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate, with 63.5% of the pitches offered.


By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 312,832 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 75.9% of the pitches offered.

The tourist places with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Rural tourism accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 21.4% in December. Resident overnight stays grew by 24.1%, and those of non-residents did so by 0.4%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 18.9% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, a 17.3% increase as compared to December 2016. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 32.4%, with an 7.6% increase.



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 169,776 overnight stays, 16.8% more than in December 2016. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 37.6% of the bedplaces offered.


By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 49,014 overnight stays. The Corona Forestal Natural Park reached the highest occupancy rate, with 45.1% of the bedplaces offered.



Youth Hostels


Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 30.7% in December. Resident overnight stays grew by 39.4%, and those of non-residents did so by 11.8%.

19.6% of the bedplaces were occupied, 18.1% more than in December 2016. The weekend occupancy rate reached 24.9%, with a 26.2% increase.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 37,098 overnight stays, 13.1% less than in December 2016. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 64.3% of the bedplaces offered.


Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 8.6%, as compared with December 2016. The rate for *tour operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (56.6%), increased by 10.6%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) decreased by 1.2% in the annual rate. The *bungalow* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weightings structure in December (37.2%), decreased by 3.4% as compared with the same month of 2016.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 3.3% increase in December. The *weekend rate*, which accounted for 66.7% of the total weight, increased by 3.0% in the annual rate.

Evolution of arrivals and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In December, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 1.9% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents increased 8.4%, while those by non-residents decreased 2.1%.


The average stay decreased 2.8%, and stood at 3.2 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total number of overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 72% corresponded to hotels and 28% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin for regulated tourist accommodation as a whole were The United Kingdom (with 25.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (17.9%) and France (5.2%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with 8.2 million overnight stays (2.5% less than in December 2016). It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.1 million overnight stays (and an annual increase of 6.1%) and Cataluña, with over 2.5 million, (and a decrease of 7.5%).



Results for the whole year 2017

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) reached 131.0 million in 2017, 5.8% more than in 2016. The overnight stays by residents increased by 7.5% and those of non-residents did so by 4.8%.

60% of overnight stays were made in holiday dwellings, 30% in campsites, 8% in rural tourism accommodation and the remaining 2% in hostels.

Overnight annual growth rate in non-hotel accomodation. Annual serie




Holiday dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 4.6% in 2017. Resident overnight stays grew by 6.9% and those of non-residents 3.9%.

Non-resident travellers, who represented 64.1% of the total, made 75.0% of the total overnight stays in holiday dwellings.


Overnight annual growth rate in holiday dwellings. Annual serie



In the year 2017, on average 40.8% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 3.2% less than in 2016. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 43.8%, with a decrease of 2.9%.

The United Kingdom became the main country of origin for holiday dwellings, with more than 21.3 million overnight stays, that is, 5.7% more than in 2016. The following country of origin was Germany, with more than 7.9 million overnight stays and an annual decrease of 5.7%.

Distribution of overnight stays of residents abroad of the main countries by origin




Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 32.7 million overnight stays, 1.0% more than in 2016. The second destination was Comunitat Valenciana, with 11.8 million overnight stays, 10.8% more. Canarias and Illes Balears registered the highest average occupancy rates per dwelling, with 80.8% and 78.0%, respectively.

Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites increased by 6.7% in 2017. Resident overnight stays grew by 7.3% and those of non-residents 6.0%.

Overnight annual growth rate in campsites. Annual serie




On average, the number of bedplaces offered by tourist campsites was 493,058, which is 1.7% less than in 2016. 40.2% of the offered pitches were occupied, 4.2% more. The average weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 42.8%, 3.4% more than in 2016.

48.3% of overnight stays at tourist campsites were by non-resident travellers. The Netherlands is the main country of origin with 23.0% of the total overnight stays, 6.2% more than in 2016.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 17.0 million overnight stays, 8.0% higher than in 2016. On the other hand, La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on average, with 64.8% of the pitches offered.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays at rural tourism accommodation increased by 10.7% in 2017. Resident overnight stays grew by 8.9% and non-residents 15.9%.




On average, the number of bedplaces offered by rural tourism accommodation was 154,904, which is 4.2% more than in 2016. The average occupancy rate was 19.2%, with an increase of 6.6%. The weekend occupancy rate increased by 5.2%, standing at 33.5%.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with over 1.6 million overnight stays, 4.6% more than in 2016.

Illes Balears reached, on average, the highest occupancy rate, with 50.0% of the bedplaces offered.


Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in %



Youth Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels increased by 10.2% in 2017 as a whole. Resident overnight stays grew by 11.1% and non-residents 8.1%.

On average, the number of bedplaces offered by youth hostels was 24,194, which is 3.8% more than in 2016. The average occupancy rate was 30.0%, with an increase of 6.2%. The weekend occupancy rate increased by 1.6%, standing at 36.3%.


By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 956,520 overnight stays, 1.1% less than in 2016.

On average, Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 45.7% of the bedplaces offered.


In 2017, the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) registered an average increase of 6.1%.

Holiday dwelling price index. Annual growth rate




On the other hand, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 2.9%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in the different types of Spanish collective tourist accommodation in 2017

Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels², holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 471.0 million for 2017 as a whole, with an increase of 3.5% as compared with the previous year.


The overnight stays by residents increased by 2.7% and those by non-residents did so by 4.0%. The average stay decreased by 1.0%, standing at 3.7 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total number of overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 72% corresponded to hotels and 28% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin were the United Kingdom (with 27.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (20.4%) and France (8.2%).

By Autonomous Community, Canarias was the preferred destination, with 104.3 million overnight stays, 1.6% more than in 2016. It was followed by Cataluña, (with over 82.9 million overnight stays and an increase of 3.9%) and Illes Balears (with 71.0 million and an annual increase of 1.6%).
