**Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**

December 2019 and year 2019. Provisional data

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decreased by 0.9% in December compared to the same month of 2018**

**In 2019, non-hotel overnight stays decreased by 0.4% to 126.4 million**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 6.2 million in December, 0.9% less than in the same month of 2018. Overnight stays by residents dropped 2.8%, whilst those by non-residents grew 0.2%.

The average stay stood at 4.9 overnight stays per traveller.

**Holiday Dwellings**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased by 2.2% in December. Resident overnight stays decreased by 3.8% and non-resident overnight stays did so by 1.7%.


It should be noted that the annual variation rates of overnight stays in tourist apartments show negative growth over the last months (with the exception of April and August 2019, when Easter and summer vacations took place, respectively). This is mainly due to holiday apartments that are being reclassified as holiday dwellings for tourist use; therefore leaving the observational scope of the Holiday Dwellings Occupancy Survey (EOAP).

The average stay decreased by 4.1% as compared with December 2018, standing at 5.6 overnight stays per traveller.

In December, 31.0% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 5.2% less than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places was 34.6%, with a decrease of 3.1%.

**Annual variation rate for overnight stay**


Percentage



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 77.0% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 997,695 overnight stays, 1.1% more than in December 2018. The following country of origin was Germany, with 437,439 overnight stays, 1.3% less.

Canarias was the preferred destination for holiday dwellings, with more than 2.3 million overnight stays and a decrease of 4.5% compared to December 2018. This Autonomous Community reached the highest occupancy rate, with 75.4% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 842,142 overnight stays and an occupancy of 81.1% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in December were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

## Tourist Campsites


Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 3.8% in December as compared with the same month in 2018. Resident overnight stays grew by 0.5%, and those of non-residents by 5.4%.

During December, 38.1% of the pitches offered were occupied, 2.3% more than in the same month of 2018. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 39.2%, with an annual increase of 3.8%.

69.2% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were made by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 32.2% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 3.7% less than in December 2018.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 625,839 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 4.2%. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 72.2% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 346,160 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 80.5% of the pitches offered.

The tourist places with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.


## Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation had an annual decrease of 0.2% in December. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 2.0%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 15.2%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 17.9% of bedplaces were occupied, 2.8% less than in December 2018. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 31.7%, with an annual increase of 0.4%.

Percentage




By Autonomous Communities, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 171,720 overnight stays, 5.0% less than in December 2018. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 33.0% of bed-places offered.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 45,953 overnight stays. The Parque Nacional Teide reached the highest occupancy rate with 38.0% of the bedplaces offered.

Percentage




## Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual decrease of 4.8% in December. Overnight stays by residents dropped by 12.9%, whilst those by non-residents increased by 12.6%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stays


Percentage



22.0% of the available bed-places were occupied, 0.5% less than in December 2018. The weekend occupancy rate reached 31.9%, with a 9.2% increase.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 44,427 overnight stays, 0.5% more than in January 2018. Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 57.9% of the bed-places offered.


## Price indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) rose 0.7% in November as compared to the same month in 2018.

For its part, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCSPI) rose by 2.7% and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) increased by 1.4%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In December, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) registered a 0.8% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 0.4%, and non-resident overnight stays by 1.1% as compared with December 2018.


The average stay decreased 1.8%, and stood at 3.1 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 73% corresponded to hotels, and 27% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 25.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (17.2%) and France (5.7%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with 7.8 million overnight stays (0.1% less than in December 2018). It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.2 million overnight stays (and an increase of 1.5%) and Cataluña, with over 2.8 million, (and an annual increase of 0.3%).


## Results for the whole year 2019

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) reached 126.4 million in 2019, 0.4% less than in 2018. Overnight stays by residents increased by 2.1% while those by non-residents decreased by 2.0%.

57% of overnight stays were made in holiday dwellings, 32% in campsites, 9% in rural tourism accommodation and the remaining 2% in hostels.

Percentage




### Holiday Apartments:

Overnight stays in holiday apartments decreased by 2.5% in 2019. Overnight stays by residents rose by 0.7% while those by non-residents decreased by 3.6%.

Non-resident travellers, who represented 61.9% of the total, made 73.2% of the total overnight stays in holiday dwellings.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stays



In the year 2019, on average 38.3% of the bedplaces available for holiday apartments were occupied, 2.0% less than in 2018. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 41.5%, with a decrease of 1.4%.

The United Kingdom became the main country of origin for holiday apartments, with 19.0 million overnight stays, 1.8% less than in 2018. The following country of origin was Germany, with more than 6.2 million overnight stays and an annual decrease of 16.3%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday apartment destination, with more than 28.2 million overnight stays, 6.6% less than in 2018. The second destination was Andalucía, with over 10.7 million overnight stays, 4.4% more.


Illes Balears and Comunidad de Madrid registered the highest average occupancy rates for apartments, with 75.5% and 74.5%, respectively.

#### Tourist Campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites increased by 2.6% in 2019. Resident overnight stays grew by 3.5% and those of non-residents 1.6%.

On average, the number of bedplaces offered by tourist campsites was 500,052, which is 0.5% less than in 2018. 40.7% of the offered pitches were occupied, 1.8% more. The average weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 43.1%, 1.8% more than in 2018.

48.4% of overnight stays at tourist campsites were by non-resident travellers. The Netherlands is the main country of origin with 21.6% of the total overnight stays, 0.9% more than in 2018.


Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with over 17.1 million overnight stays, 2.1% more than in 2018. On the other hand, La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on average, with 66.6% of the pitches offered.

### Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays at rural tourism accommodation increased by **1.4%** in 2019. Overnight stays by residents increased by **2.3%** while those by non-residents decreased by 1.0%.

Percentage




On average, the number of bedplaces offered by rural tourism accommodation was 165,128, which is **2.3%** more than in 2018. The average occupancy rate was 19.2%, with a decrease of 0.8%. The weekend occupancy rate decreased by 1.2% to 32.7%.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with over 1.8 million overnight stays, 0.5% more than in 2018.

Illes Balears reached, on average, the highest occupancy rate, with 46.6% of the bedplaces offered.

Percentage




## Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels increased by 2.5% in 2019 as a whole. Overnight stays by residents fell by 0.9%, while those by non-residents rose by 10.5%.

On average, the number of bedplaces offered by youth hostels was 25,440, which is 1.6% more than in 2018. The average occupancy rate was 32.0%, with an increase of 1.0%. The weekend occupancy rate decreased by 3.1%, standing at 35.3%.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 982,072 overnight stays, 3.9% more than in 2018.


On average, the Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 55.3% of bedplaces offered.

### Holiday dwelling Price index


Annual variation rate. Percentage

### Tourist campsite Price index


Annual variation rate. Percentage

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in the different types of Spanish collective tourist accommodation in 2019

Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>2</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 469.5 million for 2019 as a whole, with an increase of 0.6% as compared with the previous year.

Resident overnight stays increased 2.4% while non-resident overnight stays decreased 0.5%. The average stay decreased by 2.4%, to 3.5 overnight stays per traveller.



The main countries of origin were the United Kingdom (with 26.8% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (17.6%) and France (8.8%).

By Autonomous Community, Canarias was the preferred destination, with more than 96 million overnight stays, 3.9% less than in 2018. It was followed by Cataluña, with 84 million overnight

stays (and an increase of 2.8%) and Andalucía, with over 72 million, (and an annual increase of 3.5%).

### **Revision and updating of data**

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for December 2018 in the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI). Meanwhile, the occupancy survey data published today is provisional and will be reviewed in the third quarter of the year.

### **Methodological note**

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** on-going monthly survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period for the results:** monthly.

**Reference period of the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** on-going monthly survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period for the results:** monthly.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that all the establishments cover the whole month.

**Sample size:** approximately 1200 establishments.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period for the results:** monthly.

**Reference period of the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
