

**Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
December 2022 and year 2022. Provisional data

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 14.4% in December, as compared with the same month of 2021**

**In the whole of 2022, non-hotel overnight stays increased by 50.7% and reached 2019 figures**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 6.3 million in December, compared to 5.5 million for same month of 2021; this supposed an increase of 14.4%. Overnight stays by residents grew by 2.1%, and those of non-residents by 23.5%.

The average stay stood at 4.6 overnight stays per traveller.

### **Holiday Dwellings**


Overnight stays in tourist apartments: increased 17.8% in December, as compared with the same month of 2021. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 1.5% while those by non-residents increased by 27.6%.

The average stay increased by 2.0%, standing at 5.4 overnight stays per traveller.

In December, 32.4% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 17.0% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 34.7%, with an increase of 17.7%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 72.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 873,817 overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 380,085.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays, and an increase of 23.3% as compared with December of 2021. It also had the highest occupancy rate, at 78.0% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the Island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 722,141 overnight stays. Isla de Lanzarote had the highest occupancy rate, with 79.7% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in December were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

## Campgrounds


Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 6.5% in December as compared with the same month in 2021. Those by residents grew by 3.4% and those by non-residents did so by 8.2%.

During December, 41.2% of the pitches offered were occupied, 2.3% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 41.1%, with a 5.6% annual increase.

Non-residents accounted for 66.2% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 38.9% of overnight stays by non-residents, 11.1% more than in December of 2021.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 631,498 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 3.8%. It also achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 61.9% of campsites offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca (Alicante) was the preferred destination, with 329,948 overnight stays. This area also had the highest occupancy rate, with 78.5% of the campsites offered.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Cabanes.

## Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 3.9% in December. Resident overnight stays grew by 3.0% and non-resident overnight stays by 10.8%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



In rural tourism accommodation, 17.3% of the bed-places were occupied, 2.8% more than December 2021. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 30.0%, with an annual increase of 5.6%.

Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 152,910 overnight stays, 10.7% more than in December 2021. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 36.4% of bed-places offered.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 47,422 overnight stays. In Isla de Tenerife, the highest occupancy rate was reached, with 41.8% of the bed-places offered.

Percentage




### Hostels

In December, there were 297,782 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 48.3%. Resident overnight stays increased by 26.3% and non-resident overnight stays by 79.0%.


### Annual variation rate for overnight stay

Percentage




Comunidad de Madrid was the main destination, with 81,427 overnight stays. It likewise reached the highest occupancy rate, with 62.3% of the bed-places offered.

## Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 6.5% in December compared to the same month of 2021, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 5.9%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 5.6%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In December, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) registered a 22.3% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays increased by 9.9% and non-resident overnight stays by 32.9%.

The average stay grew by 0.5%, to 3.1 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 72.3% corresponded to hotels, and 27.7% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 24.9% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (16.5%) and France (6.7%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with 7.8 million overnight stays (26.4% more than in December 2021). It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.1 million overnight stays (and an increase of 17.5%) and Cataluña, with 2.9 million (and an annual increase of 29.9%).

## Results for the whole of year 2022


Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) reached 130.7 million in 2022, 50.7% more than in 2021. Overnight stays by residents grew by 9.7%, and those of non-residents by 119.9%.

If the data is compared with that of 2019, prior to the pandemic, overnight stays in 2022 reached the same levels. By traveller origin, overnight stays by residents in Spain increased by 12.2% compared to 2019, while those of non-residents decreased by 8.8%.

In 2022, 51.3% of overnight stays were made in holiday dwellings, 34.3% in campsites, 9.1% in rural tourism accommodation and the remaining 5.3% in hostels.

Percentage




### Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 70.7% in 2022. Resident overnight stays grew by 6.4% and those of non-residents 141.0%.

Non-resident travellers, who represented 56.5% of the total, made 67.4% of the total overnight stays in holiday dwellings.

Percentage




In the year 2022, on average 37.5% of the bedplaces available for holiday apartments were occupied, 44.2% more than in 2021. The average weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 40.9%, with an increase of 40.1%.

The United Kingdom became the main country of origin for holiday apartments, with 15.0 million overnight stays, 262.2% more than in 2021. The following country of origin was Germany, with 5.4 million overnight stays and an annual increase of 85.6%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 24.2 million overnight stays, 112.0% more than in 2021. The second destination was Comunitat Valenciana, with over 11.0 million overnight stays, or 40.3% more.


Comunidad de Madrid and Canarias registered the highest average occupancy rates per dwelling, with 72.7% and 70.8%, respectively.

## Campgrounds

Overnight stays at tourist campsites increased by 29.4% in 2022. Resident overnight stays grew by 6.4% and those of non-residents 80.3%.

On average, the number of bedplaces offered by campsites was 497,698, which is 7.4% more than in 2021. 43.6% of the offered pitches were occupied, 11.2% more. The average weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 46.5%, 9.9% more than in 2021.

43.4% of overnight stays at tourist campsites were by non-resident travellers. The Netherlands is the main country of origin with 22.5% of the total overnight stays, 77.0% more than in 2021.


Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with over 18.6 million overnight stays, 36.1% more than in 2021. On the other hand, Comunitat Valenciana reached the highest occupancy rate on average, with 59.7% of the pitches offered.

## Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays at rural tourism accommodations increased by 22.2% in 2022. Resident overnight stays grew by 12.1% and non-resident overnight stays by 67.2%.

Percentage




On average, the number of bedplaces offered by rural tourism accommodation was 158,547, which is 10.7% more than in 2021. The average occupancy rate was 20.4%, with a decrease of 10.8%. The weekend occupancy rate grew by 17.0%, standing at 34.8%.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 1.7 million overnight stays, 25.1% more than in 2021.

Illes Balears reached, on average, the highest occupancy rate, with 56.0% of the bedplaces offered.

Percentage




## Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels increased by 129.2% in 2022 as a whole. Resident overnight stays grew by 72.5% and those of non-residents 256.6%.

On average, the number of bedplaces offered by youth hostels was 64,165, which is 36.7% more than in 2021. The occupancy rate was 29.2%, with a decrease of 68.4%. The weekend occupancy rate increased by 62.0%, standing at 33.4%.

By communities, Galicia was the main destination, with 1.3 million overnight stays.


Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 63.0% of the bed-places offered.

In 2022, the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) registered an average increase of 10.5%.

### Holiday dwelling Price index


Annual variation rate. Percentage

#### Tourist campsite Price index


Annual variation rate. Percentage

#### Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in the different types of Spanish collective tourist accommodation in 2022

Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>2</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 451.5 million in the year 2022, with an increase of 73.9% compared to 2021.

Overnight stays by residents grew by 23.7%, and those of non-residents by 137.7%. The average stay increased by 5.9%, to 3.4 overnight stays per traveller.



In 2022, the main countries of origin were the United Kingdom (with 26.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (17.5%) and France (9.8%).

By Autonomous Community, Canarias was the preferred destination, with 89.4 million overnight stays, 112.9% more than in 2021. It was followed by Cataluña (with 79.9 million and an increase of 78.7%) and Andalucía (with 67.7 million and an increase of 60.1%).

### Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for December 2021 in the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

## Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.
