Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/ADR/REVPAR)
January 2010. Provisional data

Overnight stays at hotel establishments increase 0.3%* in January, as compared with the same month in 2009

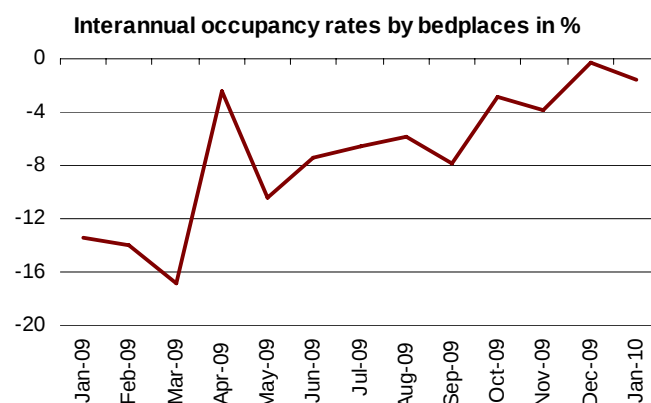
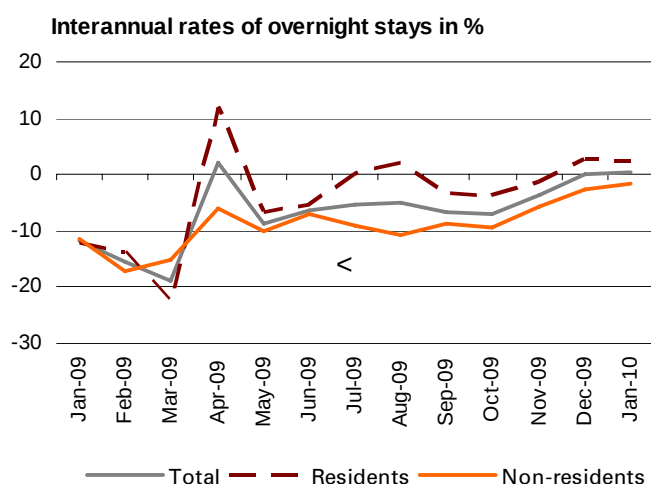
Hotels earn 26.2 euros per available room and invoice an average of 67.2 euros per occupied room

During the month of January, 11.3 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 0.3% increase as compared with the same month in 2009. A 2.5% increase in overnight stays was recorded for residents in Spain, while the rate for non-residents presented a decrease of 1.5%. The average stay decreased 1.0% as compared with January 2009, standing at 3.0 nights per guest.

In turn, the Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a 6.0% decrease, this rate being 3.4 points lower than that registered in the same month of 2009.

This month, for the first time, the INE is publishing two indicators on the profitability of the hotel sector. They are the **invoicing per occupied room** (which reached an average value of 67.2 euros, that is 2.7 euros less than in January 2009), and the **earnings per available room** (which stood at 26.2 euros, 1.2 euros less than one year ago).

34.4% of the available bedplaces were filled, indicating a decrease of 1.6% as compared with the same month the previous year. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 39.1%, with an interannual decrease of 4.3%.



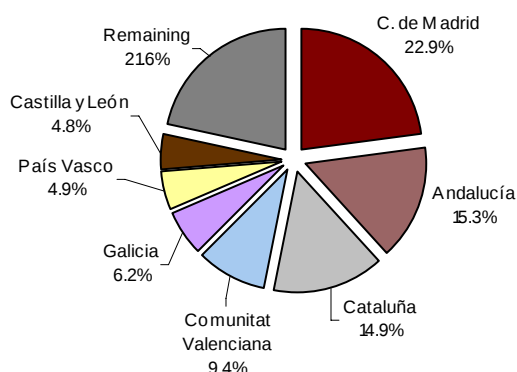
* Due to the update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to those published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, some linking coefficients have been calculated to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Overnight stays of German and British citizens decrease

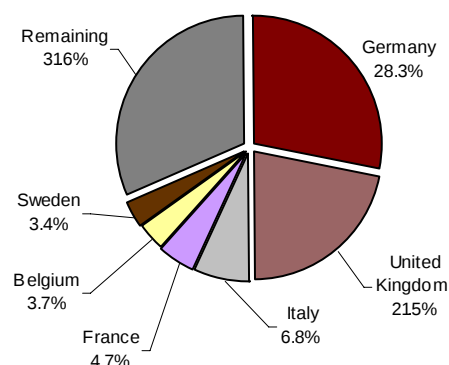
Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made 3.1 million overnight stays in January. The German market experienced a 0.8% interannual decrease in its overnight stays, whereas the British market experienced a 13.8% decrease.

Overnight stays of guests from Italy, France and Belgium (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of 9.5%, 10.6% and 5.6%, respectively.

Overnight stays of guests resident abroad by country of origin in %

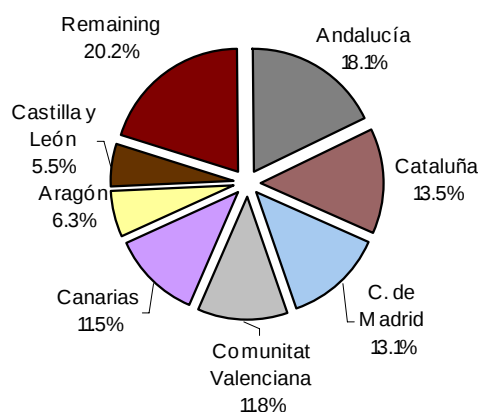


Canarias is the preferred destination for non-resident guests

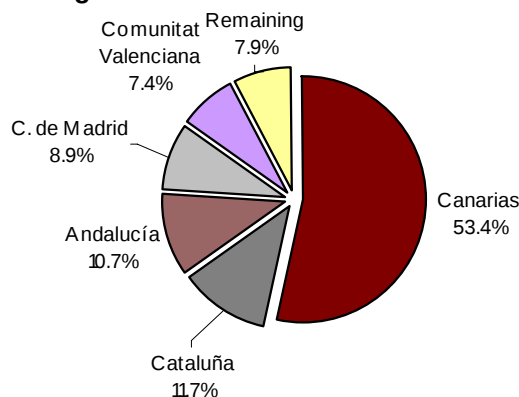
The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias. In this Autonomous Community, the overnight stays by foreign nationals decreased 0.4% as compared with January 2009. The following destinations were Cataluña, with an interannual rate of 15.6%, and Andalucía, with a rate of -9.3%.

Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid were the **main destinations chosen by guests resident** in Spain, with interannual rates for overnight stays of -7.5%, 14.2% and 2.6%, respectively.

Canarias reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of January

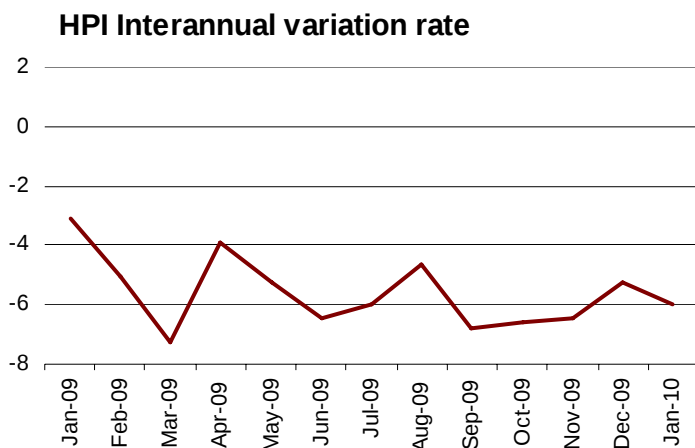
During the month of January, Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (62.6%), ahead of Comunidad de Madrid (38.9%) and Illes Balears (32.8%).

The **tourist areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts, and some areas of the Pyrenees. The island of Gran Canaria reached both the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (70.1%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (74.0%). The island of Tenerife registered more than 1.7 million overnight stays in January.

The **tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, San Bartolomé de Tirajana and Barcelona. Mogán had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (76.2%), and recorded the highest weekend occupancy rate (78.0%).

Hotel prices register an interannual rate of –6.0% in January

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at –6.0% in January, this rate being 0.8 points lower than that obtained last month, and 3.4 points lower than that registered one year ago.



Generalised decrease in prices in all of the Autonomous Communities

Canarias, Comunidad de Madrid, Cataluña and Andalucía were the four most relevant Autonomous Communities within the HPI in January, with a combined weight of 73.4% of the index. All of them registered negative interannual rates in January.

Canarias, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month, showed an interannual rate of –4.8%, that is, 0.1 points higher than the rate estimated in December. Hotel prices experienced a decrease of 9.5% in Comunidad de Madrid, as compared with the –9.3% registered the previous month. Cataluña showed an interannual rate of –9.1%, as compared with –7.2% the previous month. In Andalucía, the interannual rate was –3.4%, that is, 1.9 points lower than that obtained in the month of December.

Hotel prices decrease in all of the categories, as compared with the previous year

The most important decreases were recorded in five-gold-star, four-gold-star and three-gold-star hotels (with rates of -7.9%, -6.7% and -5.6%, respectively).

The remaining categories showed more moderate negative interannual rates: one-gold-star (-3.1%), three- and two-silver-star (-2.2%), one-silver-star (-1.9%) and two-gold-star (-1.7%) establishments.

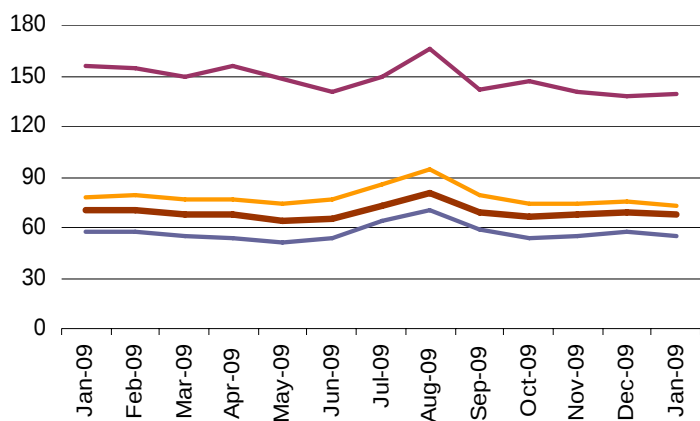
Hotels invoice an average of 67.2 euros per occupied room and earn 26.2 euros per available room

The average invoicing of hotels per occupied room (ADR) in January was 67.2 euros, that is, 2.7 euros less than the amount invoiced in the same month of 2009.

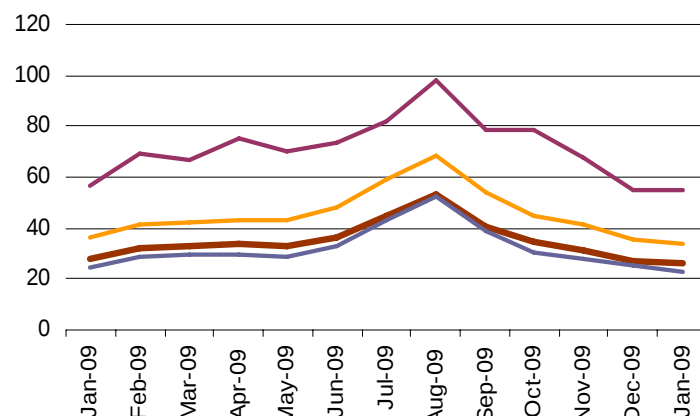
In turn, earnings per available room (RevPAR), conditioned by the occupancy achieved in hotel establishments, reached 26.2 euros, with a 1.2 euro decrease as compared with January 2009.

By category, the average invoicing was 138.9 euros for five-star hotels, 73.1 euros for four-star hotels and 54.7 euros for three-star hotels. Earnings per available room for these same categories were 55.3, 34.0 and 23.1 euros, respectively.

By Autonomous Community, those presenting the highest ADRs were Comunidad de Madrid (82.2 euros), Cataluña (77.3 euros) and Canarias (72.4 euros). Those that registered the highest RevPARs were Canarias (50.8 euros), Comunidad de Madrid (39.8 euros) and Cataluña (27.2 euros).

Methodological note 2010

Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector

Base change to 2008

In the year 2010, the INE has begun to publish two new variables pertaining to the **Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector**: the **ADR** (*Average Daily Rate or Average Invoicing per Occupied Room*) and the **RevPAR** (*Revenue Per Available Room or Earnings per Available Room*), both compiled with information that hotel establishments declare in the questionnaire of the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS).

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to include the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

The calculation and dissemination of the two new indicators broadens the information demanded by the hotel sector, thus increasing the great utility of the HOS. They do not respond, therefore, to a regulatory demand on behalf of the European Union, but rather, to the needs for information expressed by the sector itself.

These two variables, together with the occupancy rate by room, constitute an important source of information for hotel establishments, which allows them to evaluate their price policy or *revenue management*.

On the other hand, so as to avoid saturating users with indicators that hinder the interpretation of the results, the Hotel Income Index (HII) has ceased to be published, with the last data available corresponding to December 2009.
