Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/HII)
February 2008. Provisional data

Overnight stays in hotel establishments increase 9.3% in February, as compared with the same month of 2007


The interannual rate of hotel prices increases 1.3%

During the month of February, 14.8 million overnight stays were registered in hotel establishments, indicating an increase of 9.3% with regard to the same month in 2007. The increase in overnight stays occurred both in residents, whose interannual rate was 9.1%, and in non-residents (with an interannual variation of 9.4%).

The average stay increased 1.4% as compared with February 2007, standing at 2.8 nights per guest.

On the other hand, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI)** registered an increase of 1.3% in the month of February, a rate 0.5 points lower than that recorded the same month in 2007.

During the month of February, 46.9% of the available bedplaces were filled, which implied a increase of 2.0% as compared with the same month of the previous year. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 51.6%**, with an interannual increase of 0.3%.




Overnight stays of German and British citizens increase


Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom registered 4.2 million overnight stays in February, accounting for 53.8% of the total for non-residents. Both the German market and the British market experienced an interannual increase in overnight stays of 6.6% and 7.6%, respectively.

The overnight stays of French, Italian, and Dutch guests (the following markets) presented interannual rates of 9.2%, 8.9% and 17.6%, respectively.

Overnight stays of foreign guests by country of origin in %




Canarias is the preferred destination of foreign guests


Most non-residents chose to go to Canarias. Within this Community, overnight stays by foreign nationals, which accounted for 44.8% of the national total, increased 13.4% in comparison with February 2007. It was followed by Andalucía, with an interannual rate of 10.0% and Cataluña, with a rate of 5.3%.

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the main destinations for Spaniards, with interannual rates for overnight stays of 6.5%, 2.8% and 13.2%, respectively.

Canarias reaches the highest occupancy rate in the month of February


Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces during the month of February (70.0%). It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (52.8%) and Illes Balears (49.4%).

The **holiday areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates appeared on islands and coasts, and some areas of the Pyrenees. The island of Gran Canaria obtained the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (75.9%), and the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (74.9%). The island of Tenerife registered over 1.8 million overnight stays in February.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. Arona had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (80.4%) and Sallent de Gállego had the highest weekend occupancy rate (88.2%).

Hotel prices increase 1.3% in the interannual rate in February

The interannual increase of the HPI stood at 1.3% in February, at a rate 0.3 points higher than the previous month, and 0.5 points below the interannual rate recorded one year ago.



Hotel prices decrease in Andalucía


The four communities (Canarias, Andalucía, Comunidad de Madrid and Cataluña) which accounted for 69.6% of the total weight of the Hotel Price Index in the month of February, recorded positive interannual rates, with the exception of Andalucía.

Canarias, which carried the largest load in the weight structure this month (23.4%), showed an interannual rate of 1.6%, that is, 0.3 points higher than the rate estimated in January. Hotel prices experienced a 1% decrease in Andalucía, as compared with the -1.1% registered the previous month. In Comunidad de Madrid, the interannual rate was 2.2%, representing 0.3 points lower than in January. Cataluña presented an interannual rate of 1.5%, 0.8 points higher than the previous month.

The interannual rate of the HII increases 1.5% in February

The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI also considers the variation in the tariff structure, reflected an interannual rate of income per occupied room of 1.5% in February, 1.4 points lower than the rate recorded one year ago.

In the analysis of the five most important Communities in this indicator, during the month of February, the interannual increases of hotel income were worth noting in Comunidad de Madrid (2.5%), Cataluña (2.1%), Comunitat Valenciana (1.6%) and Canarias (1.3%). In Andalucía, on the other hand, the rate was -0.4%.



Methodological note 2008

Hotel Price Index - Hotel Income Index

As of the year 2000, the INE publishes the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Hotel Income Index (HII), compiled with the information that hotel businesspersons include in a specific section of the Hotel Occupancy Survey questionnaire.

This part of the questionnaire has not been modified since it was incorporated in said year 2000. Nevertheless, the changes that have taken place in the sector over these past eight years have encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in the said section of the questionnaire. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to collect the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as the data available in the business management systems themselves.

This improvement will make it possible, **beginning in the year 2009, for the INE to disseminate the whole of the new variables demanded by the sector, these variables being considered ideal for measuring profitability**: the ADR (Average Daily Rate) and the RevPar (Average income per available room).

Throughout the year 2008, the HPI and the HII will continue to be disseminated, on a national level and by Autonomous Community. However, due to the aforementioned updating of the questionnaires, we will not provide the information on prices and income broken down by tariff and by establishment category, granted that in the current format, information is collected referring to the type of client rather than to the tariffs applied. Thus, for example, the "weekend" and "normal" tariffs will disappear, to form a joint "individuals" grouping; conversely, in the 2008 questionnaire, information will be collected on the different types of commercialisation, such as "direct online hiring", which was not previously requested.

Beginning in the year 2009, linked series will be offered on the different establishment categories, once sufficient information is available referring to the whole of the year 2008, allowing us to carry out said links with the utmost quality required.
