**Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/ADR/REVPAR)**  
**February 2010. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays at hotel establishments increase 4.3%\* in February, as compared with the same month in 2009**



**Hotels earn 32.2 euros per available room and invoice an average of 68.5 euros per occupied room**

During the month of February, 13.2 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 4.3% increase as compared with the same month in 2009. A 3.8% increase in overnight stays was recorded for residents in Spain, while the rate for non-residents presented an increase of 4.8%. The average stay increased 0.4% as compared with February 2009, standing at 2.8 nights per guest.

During the first two months of this year, the overnight stays increase 2.4% compared with the same month in 2009.

In turn, the Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a 4.8% decrease, this rate being 0.8 points higher than that registered in the same month of 2009. Regarding the indicators on the profitability of the hotel sector, turnover per occupied room reached an average value of 68.5 euros, that is, 1.9 euros less than in February 2009, and the revenue per available room stood at 32.2 euros, 0.2 euros more than one year ago.

41.1% of the available bedplaces were filled in terms of occupancy, indicating an increase of 2.1% as compared with the same month the previous year. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 48.5%, with an interannual increase of 4.1%.




\* Due to the update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to that published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, some linking coefficients have been calculated to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

## Overnight stays of non-resident guests by country


Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made 3.3 million overnight stays in February. The German market experienced a 4.3% interannual increase in its overnight stays, whereas the British market experienced a 4.5% decrease.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and Netherlands (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of 7.8%, 6.7% and 11.3%, respectively.

**Overnight stays of guests resident abroad by country of origin in %**




## Main destinations


The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias. In this Autonomous Community, the overnight stays by foreign nationals increased 5.9% as compared with February 2009. The following destinations were Cataluña, with an interannual rate of 22.8%, and Andalucía, with a rate of -6.3%.

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the main destinations chosen by guests resident in Spain, with interannual rates for overnight stays of -0.7%, 6.4% and 12.5%, respectively.

## Results by Autonomous Community, tourist area and tourist site


During the month of February, Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (65.7%), ahead of Comunidad de Madrid (46.3%) and Illes Balears (43.8%).

The tourist areas with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts, and some areas of the Pyrenees. The island of Gran Canaria reached both the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (74.8%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (75.3%). The island of Tenerife registered 1.6 million overnight stays in February.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. Mogán had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (80.4%), whereas Sallent de Gállego had the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (87.4%).

## Hotel Price Index Evolution

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at -4.8% in February, this rate being 1.2 points higher than that obtained last month, and 0.8 points higher than that registered one year ago.



## HPI by Autonomous Community

The four Autonomous Communities (Canarias, Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunidad de Madrid) with a combined weight of 69.4% of the index, the most relevant within the HPI in February, registered negative interannual rates.

Canarias, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month, showed an interannual rate of -4.9%, that is, 0.1 points lower than the rate estimated in January. Hotel prices experienced a decrease of 5.9% in Cataluña, as compared with the -9.1% registered the previous month. Andalucía showed an interannual rate of -1.7%, as compared with -3.4% the previous month. In Comunidad de Madrid, the interannual rate was -9.3%, that is, 0.2 points higher than that obtained in the month of January.

## HPI by category

The hotel prices decrease in all categories in February. The most significant decreases were recorded in four-, five- and three-gold-star hotels (with interannual rates of -5.7%, -4.6% and -4.6%, respectively).

The remaining categories showed more moderate negative rates: one-silver-star (-2.3%), two-gold-star (-1.5%), one-gold-star (-1.3%) and three- and two-silver-star (-1.1%) establishments.


## Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector

The average turnover of hotels per occupied room (ADR) in February was 68.5 euros, that is, 1.9 euros less than the same month of 2009.


In turn, revenue per available room (RevPAR), conditioned the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 32.2 euros, with a 0.2 euro increase as compared with February 2009.

By category, the average invoicing was 143.1 euros for five-star hotels, 75.0 euros for four-star hotels and 54.5 euros for three-star hotels. Revenue per available room for these same categories were 73.4, 41.3 and 28.3 euros, respectively.

By Autonomous Community, those presenting the highest ADRs were Cataluña (87.3 euros) Comunidad de Madrid (81.3 euros), and Canarias (73.4 euros).

Those that registered the highest RevPARs were Canarias (52.8 euros), Comunidad de Madrid (46.7 euros) and Cataluña (41.5 euros).

## Methodological note 2010

### Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector Base change 2008

In the year 2010, the INE began to publish two new variables pertaining to the **Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector**: the **ADR** (*Average Daily Rate*) and the **RevPAR** (*Revenue Per Available Room*), both compiled with information that hotel establishments provide in the questionnaire of the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS).

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to include the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

The calculation and dissemination of the two new indicators broadens the information demanded by the hotel sector, thus increasing the great utility of the HOS. They do not respond, therefore, to a regulatory demand on behalf of the European Union, but rather, to the needs for information expressed by the sector itself.

These two variables, together with the occupancy rate by room, constitute an important source of information for hotel establishments, which allows them to evaluate their price policy or *revenue management*.

On the other hand, so as to avoid saturating users with indicators that hinder the interpretation of the results, the Hotel Income Index (HII) has ceased to be published, with the last data available corresponding to December 2009.
