

**Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/ADR/REVPAR)**  
February 2011. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in hotel establishments increase 5.4%<sup>1</sup> in February, as compared with the same month in 2010**



**Hotels earn 34.3 euros per available room and invoice an average of 68.9 euros per occupied room**

During the month of February, 14.2 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 5.4% increase as compared with the same month in 2010. Overnight stays increased 0.7% for residents, whereas non-residents experienced an increase of 9.6%.

The average stay increased 2.3% as compared with February 2010, standing at 3.0 nights per guest.

In turn, **the Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a 0.6% decrease in February**, this rate being 4.4 points higher than that registered in the same month of 2010. Regarding the indicators on the profitability of the hotel sector, invoicing per occupied room reached an average value of 68.9 euros (0.7 euros more than in February 2010), and income per available room stood at 34.3 euros (1.9 euros more than one year ago).

In terms of occupancy, 43.5% of the available bedplaces were filled in February, indicating a 5.0% increase as compared with the same month the previous year. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 51.2%, with an interannual increase of 4.9%.




<sup>1</sup>Due to the extraordinary update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias and Comunidad Foral de Navarra, the data published for those Communities and the national total cannot be directly compared to those published in previous years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to each statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

## Overnight stays of guests resident abroad


Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made more than 3.7 million overnight stays in February. The German market experienced a 6.2% interannual increase in overnight stays, while the British market registered a 5.1% increase.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and Sweden (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of 24.0%, 13.9% and 41.7%, respectively.

**Overnight stays of guests resident abroad by country of origin in %**




## Main destinations


The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias. In this Autonomous Community, overnight stays by foreign nationals increased 19.2% as compared with February 2010. It was followed by Cataluña, with an interannual rate of 7.0%, and Andalucía, with an increase of 6.0%.

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the main destinations of guests resident in Spain, with interannual rates for overnight stays of 5.0%, 1.9% and -2.1%, respectively.

## **Results by Autonomous Community, tourist area and tourist site**


During the month of February, Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (74.5%), followed by Comunidad de Madrid (46.6%) and Illes Balears (43.7%).

The tourist areas with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts, as well as in parts of the Pyrenees. Gran Canaria recorded both the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (80.2%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (82.6%). Tenerife registered more than 1.8 million overnight stays in February.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. Mogán reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (84.5%) and Arona the highest weekend occupancy (84.9%).

## **Evolution of the Hotel Price Index**

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at -0.6% in February, this rate being 0.2 points higher than that obtained last month, and 4.4 points higher than that registered one year ago.



## **HPI by Autonomous Community**

The four Communities (Canarias, Comunidad de Madrid, Cataluña and Andalucía) that carried 71.2% of the total weight of the HPI in the month of February, showed uneven behaviour, as compared with January 2011.

Canarias, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month, presented an interannual rate of 1.7%, that is, 1.9 points higher than that estimated in January. Hotel prices experienced an increase of 0.8% in Cataluña, as compared with the 0.1 % registered the previous month. Comunidad de Madrid showed an interannual rate of -2.7%, as compared with the -1.8% observed last month. In Andalucía, the interannual variation was -1.5%, that is, 0.5 points more than that obtained in the month of January.

## HPI by category

Hotel prices decreased in three- and two-silver-star hotels (4.0%), in two-gold-star hotels (2.6%), in one-gold-star hotels (2.2%), in four and three-gold-star hotels (both with 0.7% in the interannual rate) and in one-silver-star hotels (0.2%) in February.


In turn, five-gold-star hotels recorded an interannual increase of 1.3% in prices.

## Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector

The average invoicing by hotels per occupied room (ADR) in February was 68.9 euros, indicating an increase of 0.7 euros as compared with the same month in 2010.

In turn, income per available room (RevPAR), conditioned by the occupancy registered in the hotel establishments, reached 34.3 euros, with an increase of 1.9 euros as compared with February 2010.

By category, the average invoicing was 143.4 euros for five-star hotels, 74.5 euros for four-star hotels and 53.9 euros for three-star hotels. Income per available room for these same categories was 79.8, 44.2 and 29.2 euros, respectively.
