Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/ADR/REVPAR)
March 2010. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays at hotel establishments increase 7.5%* in March, as compared with the same month in 2009

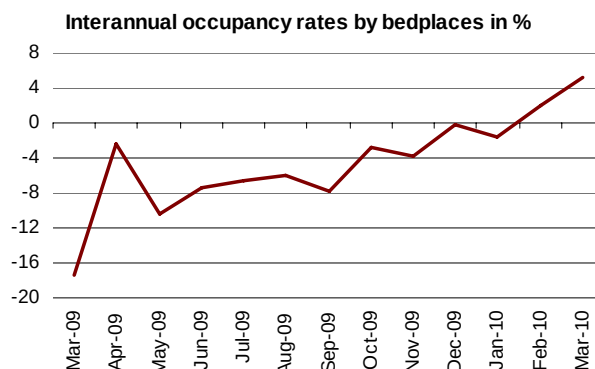
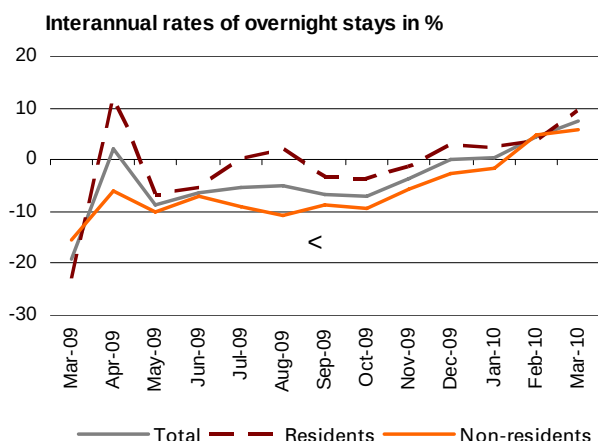
Hotels earn 33.5 euros per available room and invoice an average of 67.2 euros per occupied room

During the month of March, 16.8 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 7.5% increase as compared with the same month in 2009. A 9.4% increase in overnight stays was recorded for residents in Spain, while the rate for non-residents presented an increase of 5.9%. The average stay rose 0.1% as compared with March 2009, standing at 2.9 nights per guest. **The average stay increased 4.4% during the first quarter of 2010** as compared with the same period the previous year.

Given that this year, Easter Week was celebrated between the months of March and April, and that in 2009, it took place in the middle of April, it is advisable to wait to have the results of this survey from the coming month, so as to analyse the two months together.

In turn, **the Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a 3.3% decrease in March**, this rate being 4.3 points higher than that registered the same month of 2009. Regarding the indicators on the profitability of the hotel sector, invoicing per occupied room reached an average value of 67.2 euros (0.5 euros less than in March 2009) and the income per available room stood at 33.5 euros (1.1 euros more than one year ago).

44.2% of the available bedplaces were filled in terms of occupancy, indicating an increase of 5.2% as compared with the same month the previous year. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 50.8%, with an interannual increase of 4.0%.



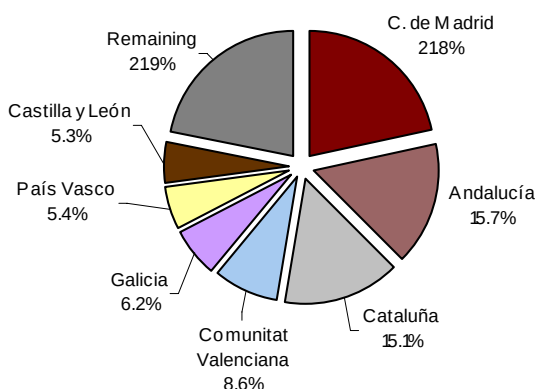
* Due to the update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to that published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, some linking coefficients have been calculated to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Overnight stays of non-resident guests by country

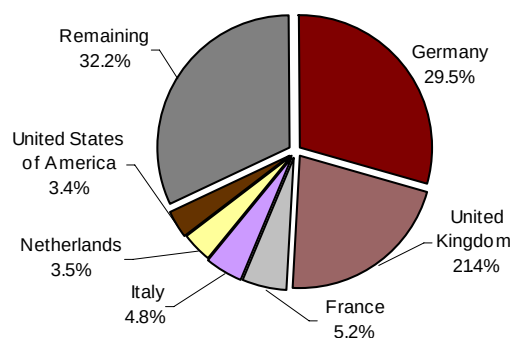
Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made more than 4.4 million overnight stays in March. The German market experienced a 2.2% interannual increase in its overnight stays, whereas the British market experienced a 5.8% decrease.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and the Netherlands (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of 4.2%, 6.9% and 6.4%, respectively.

Overnight stays of guests resident abroad by country of origin in %

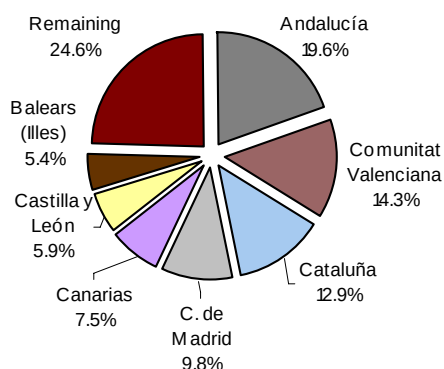


Main destinations

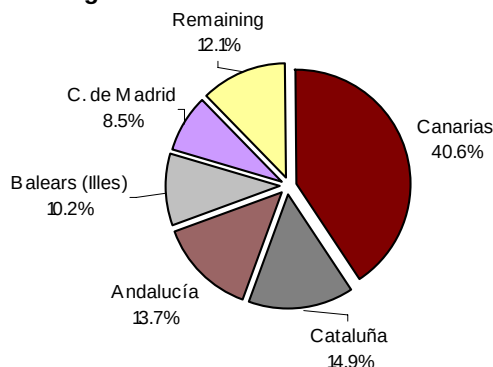
The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias. In this Autonomous Community, the overnight stays by foreign nationals increased 5.6% as compared with March 2009. The following destinations were Cataluña, with an interannual rate of 26.6%, and Andalucía, with a rate of – 2.0%.

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the main destinations chosen by guests resident in Spain, with interannual rates for overnight stays of 7.3%, 12.0% and 20.4%, respectively.

Results by Autonomous Community, tourist area and tourist site

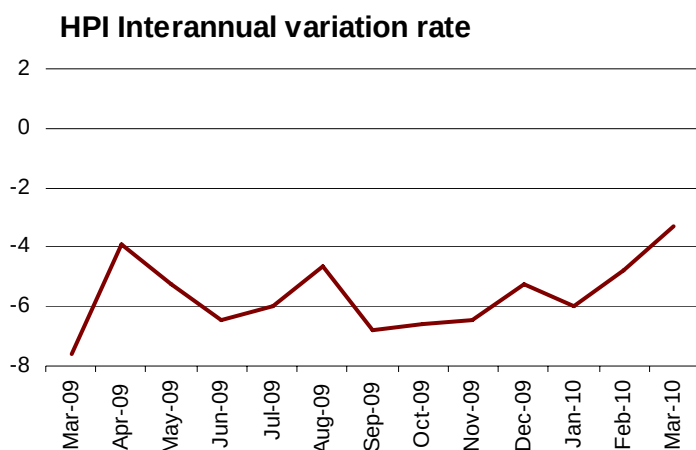
During the month of March, Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (65.3%), ahead of Illes Balears (53.6%) and Comunidad de Madrid (48.9%).

The tourist areas with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. The island of Gran Canaria reached both the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (73.8%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (74.9%). The island of Tenerife registered more than 1.6 million overnight stays in March.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. Mogán had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (80.5%), whereas Sallent de Gállego had the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (83.3%).

Hotel Price Index Evolution

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at –3.3% in March, this rate being 1.5 points higher than that obtained last month, and 4.3 points higher than that registered one year ago.



HPI by Autonomous Community

The four Autonomous Communities (Canarias, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid) with a combined weight of 66.4% of the HPI in March, registered negative interannual rates.

Canarias, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month, showed an interannual rate of –4.4%, that is, 0.5 points higher than the rate estimated in February. Hotel prices experienced a decrease of 0.6% in Andalucía, as compared with the –1.7% registered the previous month. Cataluña showed an interannual rate of –1.6%, as compared with –5.9% the previous month. In Comunidad de Madrid, the interannual rate was –6.9%, that is, 2.4 points higher than that obtained in the month of February.

HPI by category

Hotel prices decreased in all categories in March. The most significant decreases were recorded in four-, five- and three-gold-star hotels, with interannual rates of -4.1%, -3.1% and -2.8%, respectively.

The remaining categories showed more moderate negative rates: one-silver-star (-2.3%), two-gold-star (-1.7%), one-gold-star (-1.6%) and three- and two-silver-star (-1.1%) establishments.

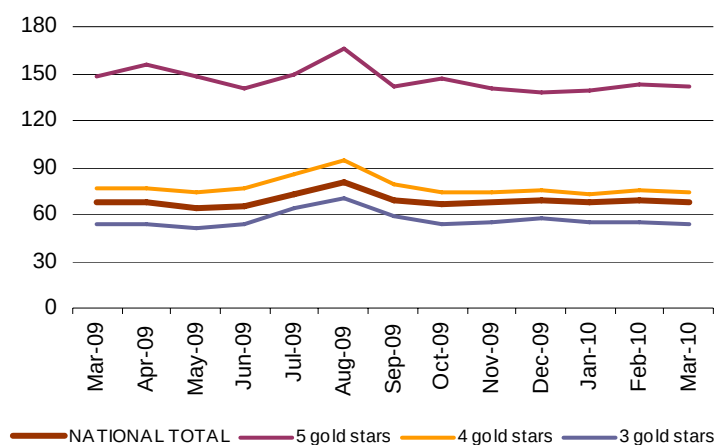
Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector

The average invoicing of hotels per occupied room (ADR) in March was 67.2 euros, that is, 0.5 euros less than the same month of 2009.

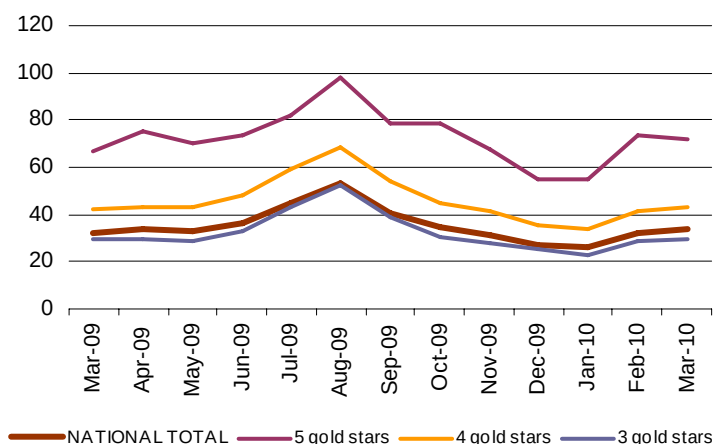
In turn, income per available room (RevPAR), conditioned by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 33.5 euros, with a 1.1 euro increase as compared with March 2009.

By category, the average invoicing was 141.1 euros for five-star hotels, 74.2 euros for four-star hotels and 53.6 euros for three-star hotels. Income per available room for these same categories was 72.2, 43.1 and 29.8 euros, respectively.

Methodological note 2010

Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector

Base change 2008

In the year 2010, the INE began to publish two new variables pertaining to the **Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector**: the **ADR** (*Average Daily Rate*) and the **RevPAR** (*Revenue Per Available Room or Income per Available Room*), both compiled with information that hotel establishments provide in the questionnaire of the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS).

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to include the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

The calculation and dissemination of the two new indicators broadens the information demanded by the hotel sector, thus increasing the great utility of the HOS. They do not respond, therefore, to a regulatory demand on behalf of the European Union, but rather, to the needs for information expressed by the sector itself.

These two variables, together with the occupancy rate by room, constitute an important source of information for hotel establishments, which allows them to evaluate their price policy or *revenue management*.

On the other hand, so as to avoid saturating users with indicators that hinder the interpretation of the results, the Hotel Income Index (HII) has ceased to be published, with the last data available corresponding to December 2009.
