**Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/ADR/REVPAR)
April 2010. Provisional data**

Overnight stays at hotel establishments increase 1.0%* in April, as compared with the same month in 2009

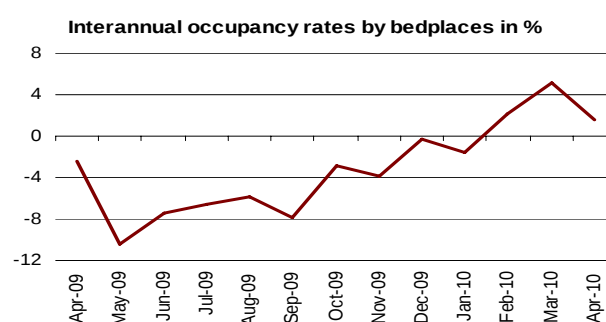
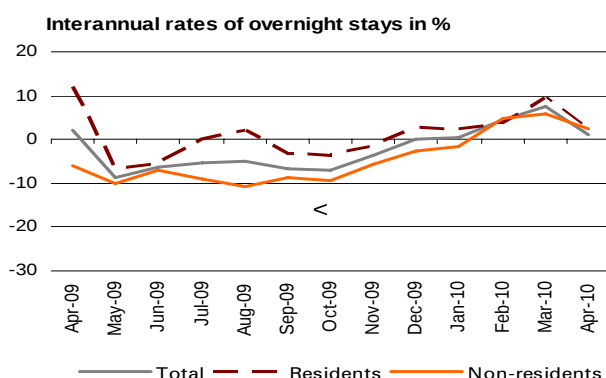
Hotels earn 33.9 euros per available room and invoice an average of 66.2 euros per occupied room

During the month of April, 19.9 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 1.0% increase as compared with the same month in 2009. A 2.0% increase in overnight stays was recorded for residents in Spain, while the rate for non-residents presented an increase of 0.1%. **Overnight stays increased 3.3% during the first quarter of 2010**, as compared with the same period the previous year.

On analysis of the **March-April** aggregate period, given that this year, Easter Week was celebrated between the months of March and April, and that in 2009, it took place in the middle of April, a 3.9% increase in overnight stays was recorded, as compared with the same period in 2009. Overnight stays by residents increased 5.2%, and those by non-residents increased 2.7%.

In turn, **the Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a 3.1% decrease in April**, this rate being 0.8 points higher than that registered the same month of 2009. Regarding the indicators on the profitability of the hotel sector, invoicing per occupied room reached an average value of 66.2 euros (1.1 euros less than in March 2009), while the income per available room stood at 33.9 euros (0.1 euros more).

48.0% of the available bedplaces were filled in terms of occupancy, as similar percentage as compared with the same month the previous year. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 55.8%, with an interannual increase of 4.4%.



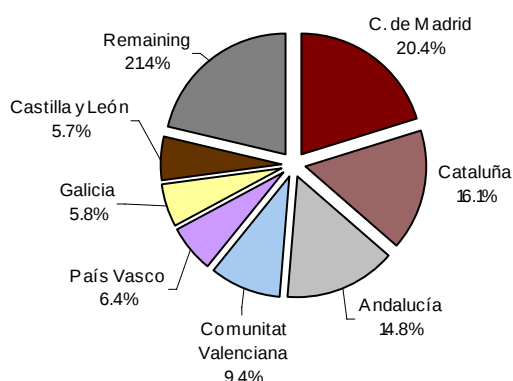
* Due to the update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to that published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, some linking coefficients have been calculated to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Overnight stays of non-resident guests by country

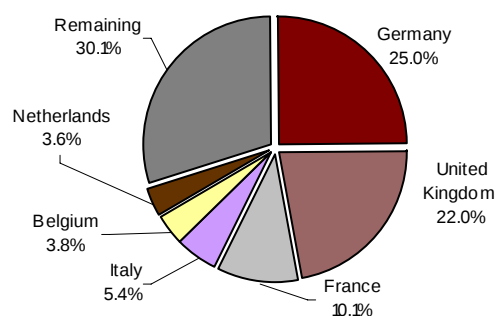
Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made more than 4.8 million overnight stays in April. The German market experienced a 15.0% interannual decrease in its overnight stays, whereas the British market experienced a 2.7% decrease.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and Belgium (the following countries of origin) registered interannual rates of 7.9%, 11.2% and –1.5%, respectively.

Overnight stays of guests resident abroad by country of origin in %

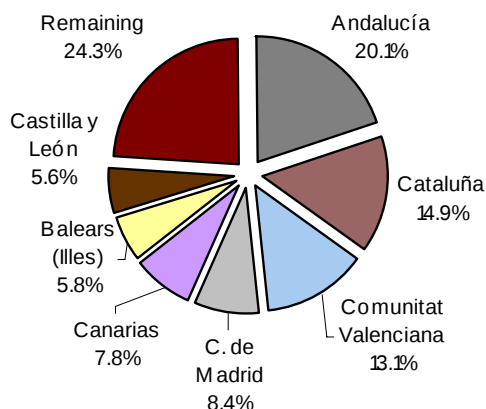


Main destinations

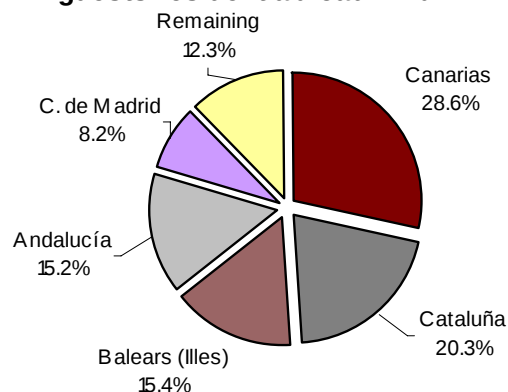
The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias. In this Autonomous Community, the overnight stays by foreign nationals decreased 2.0% as compared with April 2009. The following destinations were Cataluña, with an interannual rate of 10.8%, and Illes Balears, with a rate of –19.2%.

Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations chosen by guests resident in Spain, with interannual rates for overnight stays of –2.9%, 4.9% and 1.0%, respectively.

Results by Autonomous Community, tourist area and tourist site

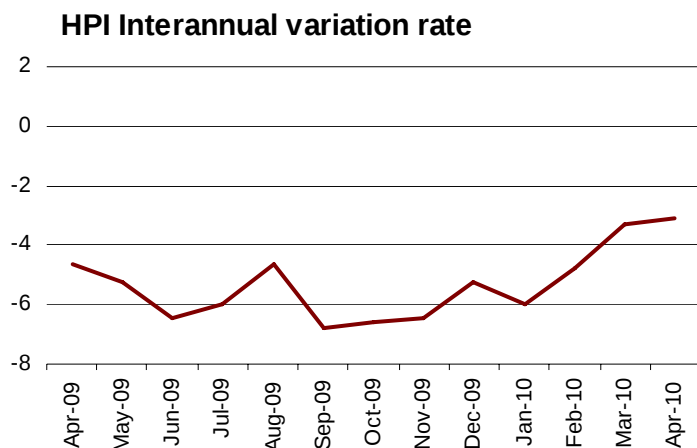
During the month of April, Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (60.5%), ahead of Illes Balears (54.5%) and Comunidad de Madrid (54.3%).

The tourist areas with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. The coast of Barcelona reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (66.8%) while Menorca reached the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (74.3%). Mallorca registered 2 million overnight stays in April.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and Benidorm. Cartagena had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (71.2%), whereas Granada had the highest weekend occupancy rate (80.5%).

Hotel Price Index Evolution

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at -3.1% in April, this rate being 0.2 points higher than that obtained last month, and 0.8 points higher than that registered one year ago.



HPI by Autonomous Community

The four Autonomous Communities (Andalucía, Canarias, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid) with a combined weight of 64.5% of the total weight of the HPI in April, registered negative interannual rates.

Andalucía, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month, showed an interannual rate of -1.7% , that is, 1.1 points lower than the rate estimated in March. Hotel prices experienced a decrease of 5.7% in Canarias, as compared with the -4.4% registered the previous month. Cataluña showed an interannual rate of -1.7% , as compared with -1.6% in March. In Comunidad de Madrid, the interannual variation was -3.7% , that is, 3.2 points higher than that obtained the previous month.

HPI by category

Hotel prices decreased in all categories in April. The most significant decreases were recorded in five- and four-gold-star hotels, with interannual rates of -4.2% and -3.8% , respectively, and in the grouping of three- and two-silver-star hotels, with an interannual rate of -3.5% .

The remaining categories showed more moderate negative rates: one-gold-star (-3.0%), three-gold-star (-2.1%), two-gold-star (-1.1%) and one-silver-star (-1.0%) establishments.

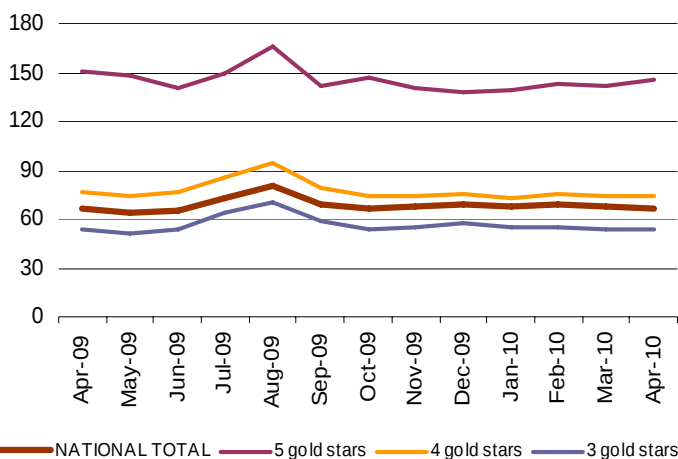
Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector

The average invoicing by hotels per occupied room (ADR) in April was 66.2 euros, that is, 1.1 euros less than the same month of 2009.

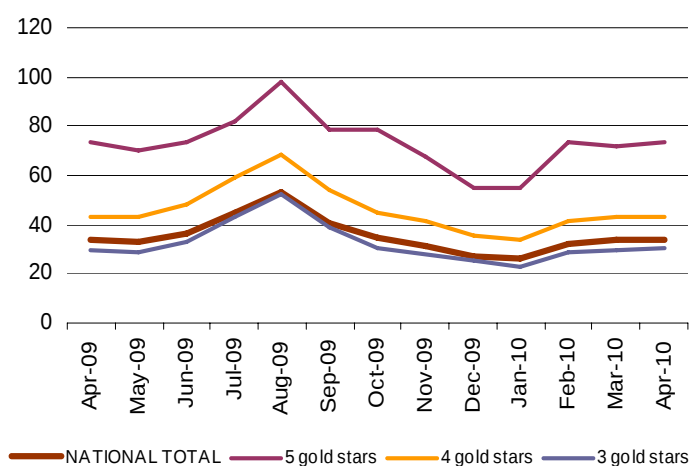
In turn, income per available room (RevPAR), conditioned by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 33.9 euros, with a 0.1 euro increase as compared with April 2009.

By category, the average invoicing was 145.1 euros for five-star hotels, 73.8 euros for four-star hotels and 53.2 euros for three-star hotels. Income per available room for these same categories was 73.9, 42.8 and 30.3 euros, respectively.

Methodological note 2010

Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector

Base change 2008

In the year 2010, the INE began to publish two new variables pertaining to the **Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector**: the **ADR** (*Average Daily Rate*) and the **RevPAR** (*Revenue Per Available Room or Income per Available Room*), both compiled with information that hotel establishments provide in the questionnaire of the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS).

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to include the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

The calculation and dissemination of the two new indicators broadens the information demanded by the hotel sector, thus increasing the great utility of the HOS. They do not respond, therefore, to a regulatory demand on behalf of the European Union, but rather, to the needs for information expressed by the sector itself.

These two variables, together with the occupancy rate by room, constitute an important source of information for hotel establishments, which allows them to evaluate their price policy or *revenue management*.

On the other hand, so as to avoid saturating users with indicators that hinder the interpretation of the results, the Hotel Income Index (HII) has ceased to be published, with the last data available corresponding to December 2009.
