**Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/ADR/REVPAR)
May 2010. Provisional data**

Overnight stays at hotel establishments increase 5.7*% in May, as compared with the same month in 2009

Hotels earn 33.8 euros per available room and invoice an average of 64.0 euros per occupied room

During the month of May, 24.0 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 5.7% increase as compared with the same month in 2009. This increase in overnight stays took place for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at 5.1%, and non-residents, with an interannual variation of 6.1%.

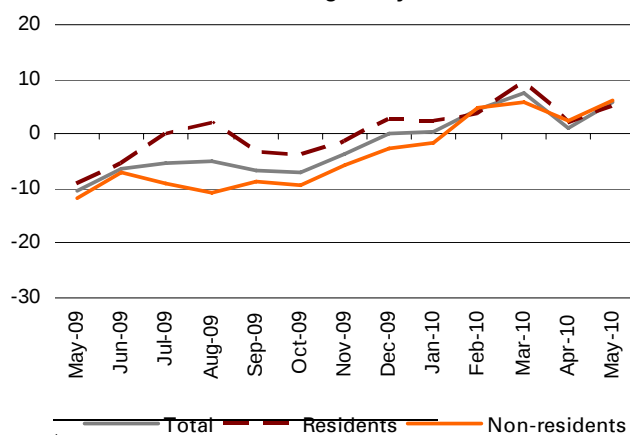
The average stay decreased 0.1% as compared with May 2009, standing at 3.1 nights per guest.

During the first five months of the year, overnight stays increased 4.0% with regard to the same period the previous year.

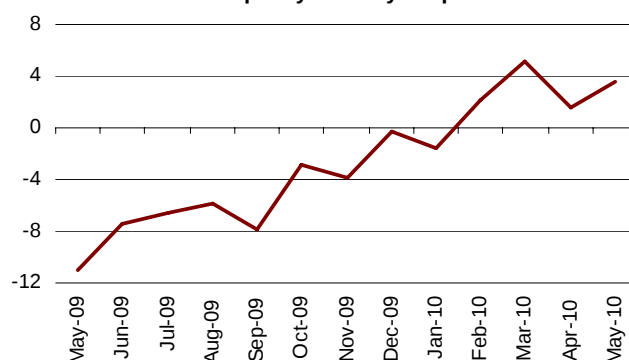
In turn, **the Hotel Price Index (HPI) registered a 2.6% decrease in May**, this rate being 2.7 points higher than that registered in the same month of 2009. Regarding the indicators on the profitability of the hotel sector, invoicing per occupied room reached an average value of 64.0 euros (0.3 euros more than in May 2009), and income per available room stood at 33.8 euros (1.4 euros more than one year ago).

In terms of occupancy, 48.7% of the available bedplaces were filled in May, indicating a 3.5% increase as compared with the same month the previous year. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 55.9%, with an interannual growth of 1.1%.

Interannual occupancy rates by bedplaces in %



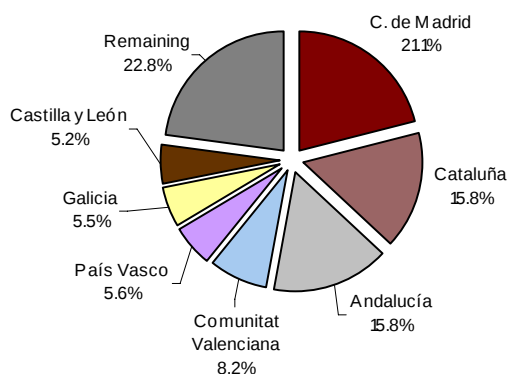
Due to the update made in the directory of hotel establishments in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to that published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, some linking coefficients have been calculated to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Overnight stays of guests resident abroad

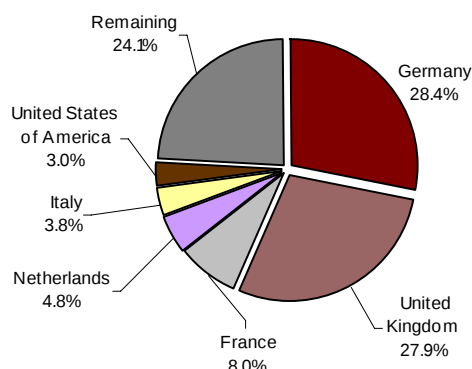
Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made more than 8.3 million overnight stays in May. The German market experienced an interannual increase of 6.7% in overnight stays, while the British market grew 2.5%.

Overnight stays of guests from France, the Netherlands and Italy (the following markets) registered interannual rates of 3.0%, 8.0% and 6.1%, respectively.

Overnight stays of guests resident abroad by country of origin in %

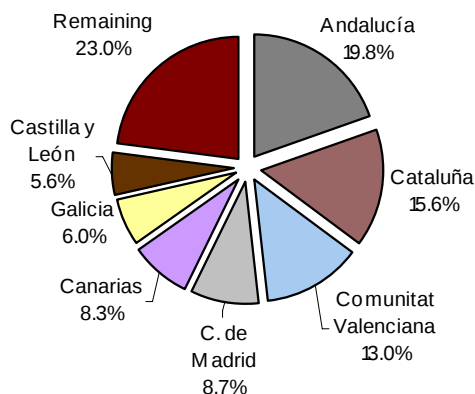


Main destinations

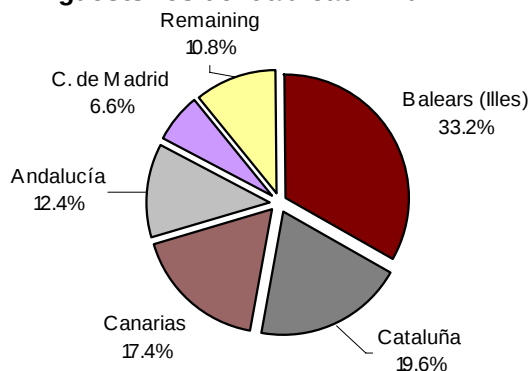
The main destination chosen by non-residents was Illes Balears. In this Autonomous Community, the overnight stays by foreign nationals grew 5.6% as compared with May 2009. It was followed by Cataluña, with an interannual rate of 9.0%, and Canarias, with a rate of 3.5%.

Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of guests resident in Spain, with interannual rates for overnight stays of 5.5%, 9.7% and 2.0%, respectively.

Results by Autonomous Community, tourist area and tourist site

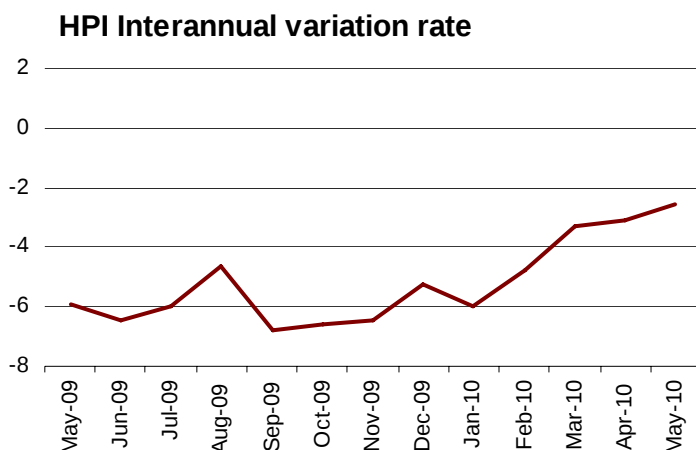
Illes Balears was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces during the month of May (58.3%), ahead of Comunidad de Madrid (56.8%) and Canarias (53.5%).

The tourist areas with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. The coast of Barcelona recorded both the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (67.8%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (75.3%). Mallorca registered more than 4.3 million overnight stays in May.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and Benidorm. This last site reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (72.4%), while Córdoba reached the highest weekend occupancy rate (82.7%).

Evolution of the Hotel Price Index

The interannual rate of the HPI stood at -2.6% in May, this rate being 0.5 points higher than that obtained last month, and 2.7 points higher than that registered one year ago.



HPI by Autonomous Community

The four Autonomous Communities (Cataluña, Andalucía, Illes Balears and Canarias) with a combined weight of 65.8% of the total weight of the HPI in the month of May, registered negative interannual rates.

Cataluña, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month, presented an interannual rate of -0.1%, that is, 1.6 points higher than that estimated in April. Hotel prices experienced a decrease of 3.5% in Andalucía, as compared with the -1.7% registered the previous month. Illes Balears showed an interannual rate of -4.1%, as compared with the -4.2% observed last month. In Canarias, the interannual rate was -4.7%, that is, 1.0 points more than that obtained in the month of April.

HPI by category

Hotel prices decreased in all categories in May, except in one-gold-star hotels, which presented an interannual rate of 0.1%. The most significant decreases were recorded in five- and four-gold-star hotels and one-silver-star hotels, with interannual rates of –5.1%, –3.1% and –2.4%, respectively.

The remaining categories presented more moderate negative rates: three- and two-silver-star hotels (–1.9%), three-gold-star hotels (–1.5%) and two-gold-star hotels (–0.5%).

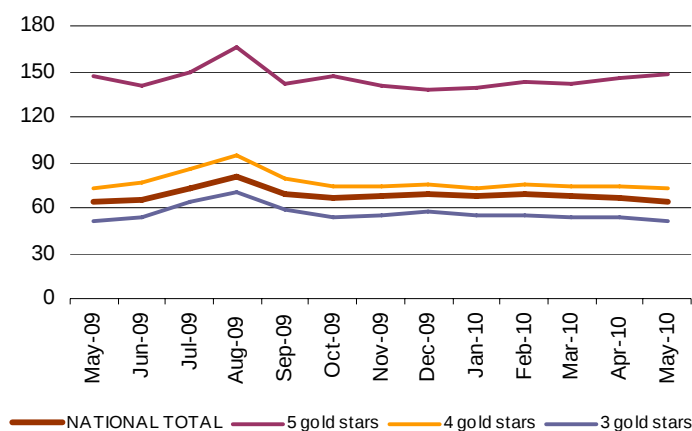
Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector

The average invoicing by hotels per occupied room (ADR) in May was 64.0 euros, indicating an increase of 0.3 euros as compared with the same month in 2009.

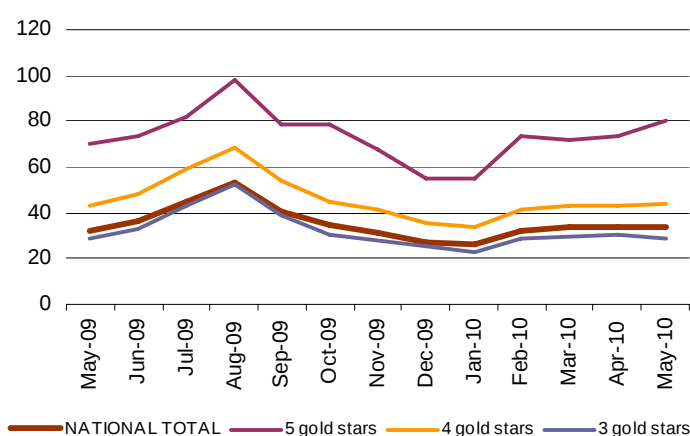
In turn, income per available room (RevPAR), conditioned by the occupancy registered in the hotel establishments, reached 33.8 euros, with an increase of 1.4 euros as compared with May 2009.

By category, the average invoicing was 147.5 euros for five-star hotels, 72.2 euros for four-star hotels and 50.5 euros for three-star hotels. Income per available room for these same categories was 79.9, 44.1 and 28.4 euros, respectively.

Methodological note 2010

Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector Base change 2008

In the year 2010, the INE began to publish two new variables pertaining to the **Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector**: the **ADR** (*Average Daily Rate* or *Average Invoicing per Occupied Room*) and the **RevPAR** (*Revenue Per Available Room* or *Income per Available Room*), both compiled with information that hotel establishments provide in the questionnaire of the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS).

The changes occurring in the sector in recent years encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire, from January 2008 onwards. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to include the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as to the data available in the business management systems themselves.

The calculation and dissemination of the two new indicators broadens the information demanded by the hotel sector, thus increasing the great utility of the HOS. They do not respond, therefore, to a regulatory demand on behalf of the European Union, but rather, to the needs for information expressed by the sector itself.

These two variables, together with the occupancy rate by room, constitute an important source of information for hotel establishments, which allows them to evaluate their price policy or *revenue management*.

On the other hand, so as to avoid saturating users with indicators that hinder the interpretation of the results, the Hotel Income Index (HII) has ceased to be published, with the last data available corresponding to December 2009.

Available on the INE website, www.ine.es, are the ADR and RevPAR series, since January 2008, with data on a national level, by category and by Autonomous Community.
