Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/IPHS)

June 2018 *Provisional data*


Overnight stays in hotel establishments decrease 1.2% in June as compared with the same month of 2017

Hotels invoice an average of 88.7 euros per occupied room, representing an annual increase of 1.6%

During the month of June overnight stays in hotel establishments exceeded 36.1 million, 1.2% less than in the same month of 2017. Overnight stays by residents in Spain increased by 0.1%, while those of non-residents decreased by 1.8%.

The average stay decreased 3.2% as compared with June 2017, standing at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.


During the first six months of 2018, overnight stays decreased by 0.2% as compared with the same period of the previous year.



Destinations


Andalucía, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Comunidad de Madrid were the main destinations of travellers resident in Spain in June, with annual variation rates in the number of overnight stays of 3.0%, -10.2%, 0.3% and 6.6%, respectively.

The main destination chosen by non-residents was Illes Balears, with 34.3% of total overnight stays. In this Autonomous Community, overnight stays by foreign nationals decreased by 0.2% as compared to June 2017. The following destinations of non-residents were Cataluña (with 19.1% of the total overnight stays and a decrease of 2.3%) and Canarias (with 18.4% of the total and a decrease of 4.8%).


Distribution of overnight stays: non-residents in %



Hotel occupancy


In June, 64.9% of the available bed-places were occupied, indicating an annual decrease of 2.1%. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places decreased by 1.8%, standing at 70.5%.

Illes Balears showed the highest occupancy rate by bed-places in June (82.9%). It was followed by Canarias (74.5%) and Comunitat Valenciana (67.1%).

By tourist areas, Palma-Calvià reached both the greatest occupancy rate by bed-places (83.7%) and the greatest weekend occupancy rate (86.1%). The island of Mallorca registered the highest number of overnight stays, with 6.9 million.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Barcelona, Madrid and Calvià. Pollença reached the highest occupancy rate by bed-places (92.9%) and Palma de Mallorca registered the greatest weekend occupancy rate (90.1%).

Overnight stays according to the country of origin of the travellers

Travellers from the United Kingdom and Germany concentrated 28.4% and 21.8%, respectively, of total overnight stays of non-residents in hotel establishments in June. The British market remained unchanged, while the German market fell by 11.7%.

Overnight stays of travellers from France, the Netherlands and Italy (the following countries of origin) registered annual rates of 7.3%, 4.1% and -1.0%, respectively.


Distribution of non-residents overnight stays by main country of residence in %



Hotel Prices

The annual rate of the Hotel Price Index (HPI) stood at 1.7% in June, which is 0.5 points more than last month and 7.3 points below that registered a year ago.

Illes Balears, Cataluña, Andalucía and Canarias were the most heavily weighted Autonomous Communities in the HPI in June (accounting for 75.0% of the total weight). Hotel prices increased by 5.1% in the annual rate in Illes Balears, 2.5% in Andalucía and 1.8% in Canarias. In turn, they fell by 1.0% in Cataluña.

By category, prices rose in all one-silver-star establishments (6.6%), in two-gold-star establishments (5.6%), in three-gold-star establishments (3.4%), in three and two-silver-star establishments (2.2%), in four-gold-star establishments (1.1%) and in one-gold-star establishments (0.5%).

In turn, prices fell by 1.1% in five-gold-star establishments.


Profitability of the Hotel Sector

The average daily rate per occupied room (ADR) of hotels was 88.7 euros in June, which means an increase of 1.6% as compared with the same month of 2017.


On the other hand, the average daily revenue per available room (RevPAR), which is conditioned by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 63.5 euros, with a 0.1% increase.

By category, the average rate was 197.3 euros for five-star hotels, 94.1 euros for four-star hotels and 75.0 euros for three-star hotels. Revenues per available room for these same categories were 140.4, 75.6 and 56.9 euros, respectively.
