#### Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/IPHS) August 2023. Provisional data

# Overnight stays in hotel establishments increased by 1.2% in August with respect to the same month in 2022


# Hotels invoice an average of 136.5 euros per occupied room, representing an increase of 6.7% compared to the previous year

During the month of August, overnight stays in hotel establishments exceeded 46.6 million. This represents an increase of 1.2% compared to the same month in 2022, when there were 46.1 million.

Based on place of origin, overnight stays by travellers residing in Spain exceeded 17.5 million, representing 37.6% of the total. In turn, overnight stays by non-residents stood at over 29.1 million.

On the other hand, the average stay decreased 1.2% compared to August 2022, standing at 3.5 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first seven months of 2023, overnight stays increased by 8.8% compared to the same period in the previous year. Moreover, they surpass those of the first eights months of 2019.




#### Annual variation rate for overnight stays Percentage

#### Destinations

Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations in August for travellers who are residents in Spain, with 23.6%, 14.9% and 12.8% of total overnight stays, respectively.


#### Distribution of overnight stays: residents

The main destination chosen by non-residents was Illes Balears, with 34.2% of total overnight stays. Following that, the main destinations were Cataluña and Canarias, with 21.5% and 17.7% of the total, respectively.

Distribution of overnight stays: non-residents Percentage




#### Hotel occupancy

In August, 74.8% of the available bed-places were covered, with an annual decrease of 0.3%. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places fell by 0.6%, and stood at 77.5%.


#### **Occupancy rate**

Illes Balears recorded the highest occupancy rate by bed-places in August (89.5%). It is followed by País Vasco, with 80.9%.

By tourist areas, Palma-Calvià reached the greatest occupancy rate by bed-places (90.1%) as well as the greatest weekend occupancy rate (90.3%). The island of Mallorca recorded the highest number of overnight stays in August, with 8,278,041.

The tourist places with most overnight stays are Barcelona, Madrid and Calvià. Santa Margalida had the highest occupancy rate by bed places (97.6%), while Ibiza had the highest weekend occupancy rate (95.3%).

#### Overnight stays according to the country of origin of travellers



Travellers from the United Kingdom and Germany accounted for 25.5% and 15.7%, respectively, of total overnight stays of non-residents in hotel establishments in August.

Overnight stays by travellers from France, Italy and the Netherlands (the following source markets) accounted for 12.1%, 6.6% and 5.6% of the total, respectively.

#### Distribution of non-residents overnight stays. Main country of residence Percentage




## **Hotel Prices**

The annual rate of the Hotel Prices Index (HPI) stood at 6.3%, which was 7.0 points above that registered in the same month of 2022 and 0.1 of a point more than that registered last month.

By Autonomous Community, the greatest increases of hotel prices compared to August 2022 was in the Illes Balears (9.6%). The only decrease was recorded in Extremadura, with an annual rate of -0.2%.

By categories, the greatest price increase was registered in three-gold star establishments (11.2%).

# Hotel Sector Profitability

The average daily rate of hotels per occupied room (ADR) was 136.5 euros in August, which is an increase of 6.7% compared to the same month in 2022.

On the other hand, the average daily revenue per available room (RevPAR), which is determined by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 108.2 euros, increasing by 6.8%.


By category, the average rate was 303.3 euros for five-star hotels, 143.7 euros for four-star hotels and 120.1 euros for three-star hotels. Revenue per available room for these same categories was 222.5, 122.3 and 99.4 euros, respectively.

The tourist spot with the highest ADR is Estepona, with an average daily rate per occupied room of 302.9 euros. Furthermore, it had the highest RevPar, with revenue per available room of 254.8 euros.



Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/IPHS) - August 2023. Provisional data (6/7)

#### Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data corresponding to the month of August 2022 of the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and of the Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector (IPHS).

#### Methodological note

The main objective of the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the fundamental characteristics of the hotel sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand, thus meeting the needs of national institutions and the requirements of international organisations for knowledge regarding the sector.

The Hotel Price Index (HPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of prices applied to clients by hotel entrepreneurs.

The main objective of the Indicators of Profitability of the Hotel Sector (IRSH) is to facilitate decision-making in the hotel sector. These are the *Average Daily Rate* (ADR), which collects the average daily income per occupied room; and the *Revenue per Available Room* (RevPAR), which collects the average daily revenue per available room.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: all hotel establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such a way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample design:** stratified sampling by province and establishment category, with 4 and 5-gold star categories being exhaustive.

**Sample size:** approximately 9,250 establishments in winter and 11,200 in summer.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the hotel establishment.
