

**Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/HII)**  
**November 2008. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays in hotel establishments decrease 10.6% in November as compared with the same month in 2007**

**The interannual rate of hotel prices decreases 2.0%**

During the month of November, 13.7 million overnight stays were recorded in hotel establishments, indicating a 10.6% decrease as compared with the same month in 2007. Overnight stays by guests resident in Spain decreased 12.5%, while those by non-residents decreased 8.7%.


**The average stay grew 1.4%, in interannual terms, standing at 2.8 nights per guest.**

**During the first eleven months of the year, 256.5 million overnight stays were registered**, 0.7% less than the same period of 2007, with a decrease of 2.7% for residents and an increase of 0.7% for non-residents. The **average stay** stood at 3.3 nights per guest, 0.6% more than in the same period in 2007.


On the other hand, the **Hotel Price Index (HPI)** registered a decrease of 2.0% in the month of November, with a rate 3.9 points lower than that recorded the same month of 2007.

**During the month of November, 41.6% of the available bedplaces were filled**, 13.4% less than the same month of the previous year. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 45.8%, with an interannual decrease of 18.2%.

Interannual occupancy rates by bedplaces in %




## Overnight stays of German and British citizens decrease


Guests from Germany and the United Kingdom made 3.8 million overnight stays in November, accounting for 53.0% of the total for non-residents. Both markets experienced interannual decreases in overnight stays, 8.8% for the German market and 12.1% for the British market.

Conversely, overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and Sweden (the following countries of origin) presented uneven behaviour. In this way, guests from France presented an interannual decrease of 11.8% and guests from Italy, 8.2%; however, guests from Sweden recorded an interannual increase of 1.8% in overnight stays.

**Overnight stays of foreign guests by country of origin in %**




## Canarias is the preferred destination for non-resident guests in Spain


The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias, the Autonomous Community in which overnight stays by foreign nationals, representing 47.3% of the national total, decreased 2.9% as compared with November 2007. The following main destinations chosen by non-resident guests were Andalucía and Cataluña, whose interannual evolution rates were -6.9% and -7.4%, respectively.

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Comunidad de Madrid were the main destinations chosen by residents, with interannual rates for overnight stays of -15.1%, -13.7% and -9.8%, respectively.

## Canarias reaches the highest occupancy rate


During the month of November, Canarias was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (65.6%), ahead of Comunidad de Madrid (45.1%) and Comunitat Valenciana (44.2%).

The **tourist areas** with the highest occupancy and overnight stay rates were located on the islands and the coasts. The island of Gran Canaria reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (72.8%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces (70.9%). The tourist area with the highest number of overnight stays in November was the island of Tenerife, with more than 1.6 million.

The **tourist sites** with the highest number of overnight stays were Madrid, Barcelona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. In turn, Mogán had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (78.9%) and the highest weekend occupancy rate (76.7%).

## Hotel prices record an interannual increase of 2.0% in November

The interannual decrease in the HPI stood at 2.0% in November, 2.3 points lower than the rate from the previous month, and 3.9 points below the rate registered one year ago.



## Widespread decrease of prices in the Autonomous Communities

The four Autonomous Communities (Canarias, Andalucía, Comunidad de Madrid and Cataluña), which accounted for 68.2% of the total weight of the Hotel Price Index in the month of November, recorded interannual decreases in their hotel prices.

Canarias, which carried the greatest load in the weighting structure this month (23.2%), showed an interannual rate of -1.9%, that is, 1.7 points lower than the rate estimated in October (-0.2%). In Andalucía, hotel prices experienced a decrease of 4.2%, as compared with the -2.5% recorded the previous month. Comunidad de Madrid showed an interannual rate of -2.4%, as compared with the 0.8% recorded the previous month. In Cataluña, the interannual rate was -1.8%, that is, 2.7 points lower than that obtained in October (0.9%).

## The interannual rate of the Hotel Income Index decreases 0.7% in November

The Hotel Income Index (HII), which unlike the HPI, also considers the variation in the tariff structure, reflected an interannual evolution of income per occupied room of -0.7% in November, 3.2 points lower than the rate recorded the same month the previous year.

The four most important Autonomous Communities in this indicator during this month displayed uneven behaviour in hotel income as compared with November 2007: Canarias (-2.0%), Andalucía (-1.5%), Cataluña (-0.6%) and Comunitat Valenciana (1.4%).



## **Methodological note 2008**

### **Hotel Price Index - Hotel Income Index**

As of the year 2000, the INE has published the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and the Hotel Income Index (HII), compiled with the information that hotel businesspersons include in a specific section of the Hotel Occupancy Survey questionnaire.

This part of the questionnaire has not been modified since it was incorporated in said year 2000. Nevertheless, the changes that have taken place in the sector over these past eight years have encouraged the introduction of certain modifications in said section of the questionnaire. With these changes, we hope, on the one hand, **to collect the new distribution channels favoured by generalised Internet use**, and on the other hand, **to adapt the questionnaire to the terms and concepts that are most frequently used within the sector**, as well as the data available in the business management systems themselves.

This improvement will make it possible, **beginning in the year 2009, for the INE to disseminate the whole of the new variables required by the sector, these variables being considered ideal for measuring profitability**: the ADR (Average Daily Rate) and the RevPar (Average income per available room).

Throughout the year 2008, the HPI and the HII will continue to be disseminated, on a national level and by Autonomous Community. However, due to the aforementioned updating of the questionnaires, we will not provide the information on prices and income broken down by rate and by establishment category, granted that in the current format, information is collected referring to the type of client rather than to the rates applied. Thus, for example, the "weekend" and "normal" rates will disappear, to form a joint "individuals" grouping; conversely, in the 2008 questionnaire, information will be collected on the different types of commercialisation, such as "direct online hiring", which was not previously requested.

Beginning in the year 2009, linked series will be offered on the different establishment categories, once sufficient information is available referring to the whole of the year 2008, allowing us to carry out said links with the utmost quality required.
