
# Overnight stays in hotel establishments register an increase of 1.5% in December, as compared with the same month in 2018

# Hotels invoice an average of 86.0 euros per occupied room, representing an annual increase of 3.8%

# Overnight hotel stays increased by 0.9% for the year 2019 as a whole.

In December, overnight stays in hotel establishments exceeded 16.9 million, 1.5% more than in the same month in 2018. Overnight stays by residents in Spain increased by 1.5% and those of non-residents did so by 1.6%.

The average stay decreased 1.3% as compared to December 2018, standing at 2.7 overnight stays per traveller.




#### Annual variation rate for overnight stays

#### Destinations


Andalucía, Comunidad de Madrid and Cataluña were the main destinations of residents in Spain in December, with annual variation rates in the number of overnight stays of 2.0%, - 0.4% and -1.6% respectively.

#### Distribution of overnight stays: residents



The main destination chosen by non-residents was Canarias, with 49.2% of total overnight stays. In this Autonomous Community, overnight stays by foreigners increased by 1.6% as compared to December 2018. The next most popular destinations of non-residents were Cataluña (with 15.5% of the total overnight stays and an increase of 2.4%) and Andalucía (with 11.4% of the total and an increase of 1.4%).

#### Distribution of overnight stays: non-residents




#### Hotel occupancy

In December, 47.4% of the available bed-places were occupied, representing an annual increase of 0.5%. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places increased 2.9%, standing at 56.5%.


#### **Occupancy rate**

Canarias showed the highest occupancy rate by bed-places in December (67.8%). It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (56.1%) and the autonomous city of Ceuta (51.7%).

By tourist areas, the South of Gran Canaria reached both the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (73.7%), and the highest weekend occupancy rate (75.4%). The island of Tenerife registered the highest number of overnight stays, with 2.0 million.

The tourist spots with the most overnight stays were Barcelona, Madrid and Benidorm. Adeje had the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (74.4%) and Vigo registered the greatest weekend occupancy rate (76.4%).


#### Overnight stays according to the country of origin of the travellers

In December, travellers from the United Kingdom and Germany accounted for 22.6% and 17.1% of total overnight stays of non-residents in hotel establishments, respectively. The British market increased by 1.1%, while the German decreased by 2.0%.

Overnight stays of travellers from France, Italy and Sweden (the following countries of origin) registered annual rates of 4.5%, 0.9% and -5.3% respectively.




#### **Distribution of non-residents overnight stays. Main country of residence** Percentage

#### **Hotel Prices**

The annual rate of the Hotel Price Index (HPI) stood at 2.5% in December, which is 1.2 points more than that registered last month and 1.9 points above that registered one year ago.

By Autonomous Community, the greatest increases in hotel prices were recorded in Illes Balears (7.3% in annual rate).

By categories, the greatest price increase was registered in one-silver star establishments (6.4%).


#### **Profitability of the Hotel Sector**

The average daily rate per occupied room (ADR) of hotels was 86.0 euros in December, representing an increase of 3.8% as compared with the same month of 2018.


On the other hand, the average daily revenue per available room (RevPAR), which is conditioned by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 46.3 euros, with a 5.3% increase.

By category, the average rate was 175.7 euros for five-star hotels, 92.2 euros for four-star hotels and 66.3 euros for three-star hotels. Revenues per available room for these same categories were 101.4, 56.9 and 37.2 euros respectively.

#### **Revenue per available room by hotel category** Euros




# Results for the whole of year 2019

Overnight stays in hotel establishments reached 343.1 million in the year 2019 as a whole, an increase of 0.9% compared to 2018. This rate was 1.1 points higher than that registered in 2018, which was -0.2%.

The overnight stays by residents increased by 2.6% and those of non-residents did so by 0.1%.

57.4% of overnight stays occurred between May and September, with a variation of 1.0% compared to the same period in 2018.




#### Annual variation rate for overnight stays

Resident travellers, who represented 48.5% of the total, made 34.8% of the total overnight stays during 2019.

In turn, non-residents represented 51.5% of total travellers and they made 65.2% of the hotel overnight stays.


Annual overnight stays by origin



## Destinations

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the main destinations of Spanish residents in 2019, with variation rates in the number of overnight stays of 4.5%, 4.3% and - 0.1% respectively.


#### Distribution of overnight stays: residents. Year 2018.



The main destination chosen by non-residents in 2019 was Canarias, with 26.0% of total overnight stays. In this Autonomous Community, overnight stays by foreign nationals


decreased by 4.2% compared to 2018. The following destinations were Illes Balears (with 24.0% of the total and an decrease of 1.1%) and Cataluña (with 19.0% and an increase of 3.7%).

#### Hotel occupancy


In 2019, on average, 60.2% of the bedplaces were occupied, a percentage similar to 2018. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places increased 0.4%, standing at 66.1%.

Illes Balears showed the highest occupancy rate by bed-places during 2019 (with an average of 75.5%). It was followed by Canarias (72.2%) and Cataluña (61.2%).

The main tourist areas by number of overnight stays in 2019 were the island of Mallorca (with 45.1 million overnight stays), the island of Tenerife (with 25.2 million) and the tourist area of Barcelona (with 22.3 million).


On the other hand, the tourist spots with the most overnight stays were Barcelona, Madrid and San Bartolomé de Tirajana. Arona had the greatest average occupancy rate by bed-places (79.1%) and also the greatest average weekend occupancy rate (79.6%).

#### Overnight stays according to the country of residence of the travellers

Travellers from the United Kingdom and Germany made 98.6 million hotel overnight stays in 2019, 44.1% of the total made by non-resident travellers. Overnight stays by travellers from the United Kingdom rose by 0.3%, while those by Germans fell by 9.0%.


Overnight stays of travellers from France, Italy, and the Netherlands (the following countries of origin) registered annual rates of 0.2%, 7.1% and -4.8% respectively.

Amongst the main countries of origin, the greatest increases in overnight stays in 2019 were in travellers from Japan (24.5%), United States (16.2%) and Ireland (13.8%).





#### **Hotel Prices**

The annual rate of the Hotel Price Index (HPI) stood at 1.9% on average in 2019, which is 0.3 points lower than in 2018.

The autonomous communities with the highest average rates were Cataluña (3.6%), Comunidad de Madrid (3.5%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (3.3%). The only territory showing a negative rate was the autonomous city of Ceuta (-0,3%).


#### **Profitability of the Hotel Sector**

The average daily rate per occupied room (ADR) of hotels was 91.0 euros in 2019. On the other hand, the average daily revenue per available room (RevPAR), which is conditioned by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 61.2 euros on average.



By category, the average rate was 190.4 euros for five-star hotels, 97.6 euros for four-star hotels and 74.6 euros for three-star hotels. Revenue per available room for these same categories were 131.3, 73.1 and 52.8 euros, respectively.

#### Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data corresponding to the month of December 2018 of the Hotel Price Index (HPI) and of the Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector (IPHS).

# Methodological note

The main objective of the Hotel Occupancy Survey (HOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the fundamental characteristics of the hotel sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand, and thus meet the need for knowledge of the sector by national institutions and the requirements of international organisations.

The Hotel Price Index (HPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that hotel entrepreneurs apply to their clients.

The main objective of the Indicators of Profitability of the Hotel Sector (IRSH) is to facilitate decision making in the hotel sector. These are the *Average Daily Rate* (ADR), which collects the average daily income per occupied room; and the *Revenue per Available Room* (RevPAR), which collects the average daily revenue per available room.

Type of operation: on-going monthly survey.

Population scope: all hotel establishments.

**Geographical scope**: the entire national territory.

Reference period for the results: monthly.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that all the establishments cover the whole month.

**Sample design:** stratified sampling by province and category of the establishment, being comprehensive those strata of 4 and 5 gold star categories.

Sample size: approximately 9,250 establishments in winter and 11,200 in summer.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the hotel establishment.
