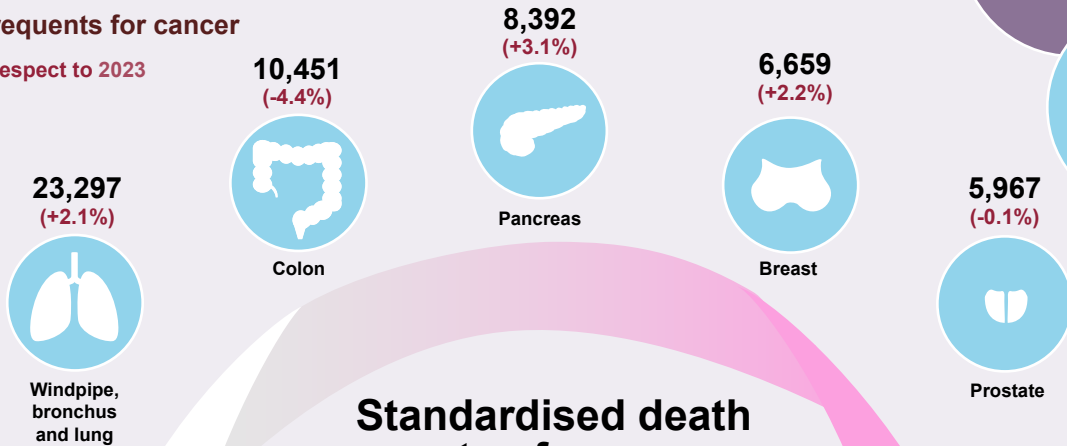

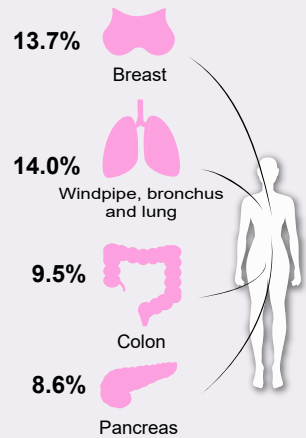
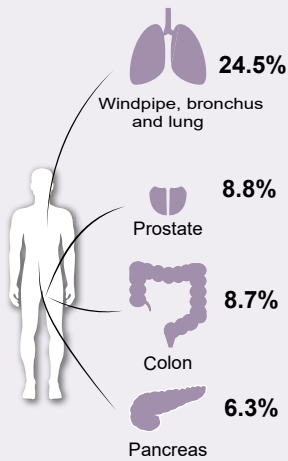
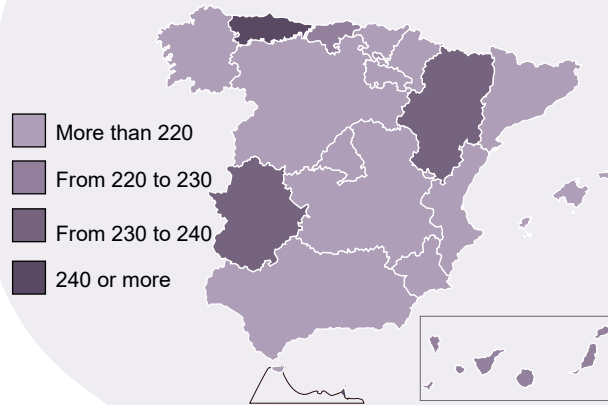

() Variations with respect to 2023



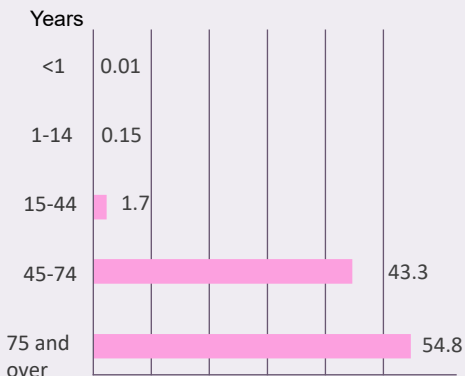
Standardised death rate of cancer
(Per 100,000 inhabitants)



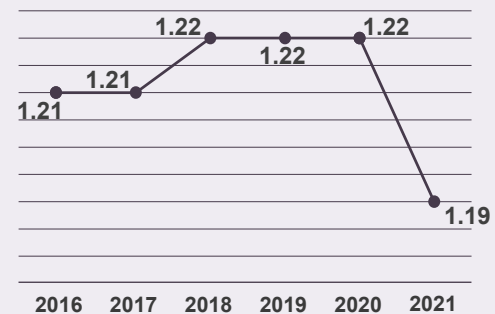
Percentage of total deaths from cancer in men

Cancer is the first cause of death in men

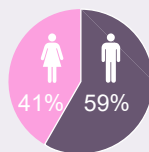
Cancer deaths by age
