New features

New features of the AIPS 2025

The information that is the subject of the survey is defined mainly by the list of PRODCOM products, acronym that refers to the first two syllables of the words COMMunity and PRODuction and which consists of a list of industrial goods and services harmonised with the International Trade Classification or Combined Nomenclature of the European Union.

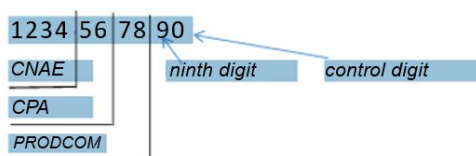
What is the PRODCOM list?

The word PRODCOM comes from the union of two French words "*PRO*Duction *COM*munitarie". It is the harmonised list of industrial products and services manufactured in Europe. An industrial sector is defined as belonging to sectors B, C, and E of the economy.

The PRODCOM list is harmonised with the Community Classification of Products and Economic Activities (CPA).

The European PRODCOM list classifies products according to the CPA and has a level of detail of up to 8 significant digits.

Each heading in the PRODCOM list is represented by an 8-digit code, allowing for the possibility of adding a ninth digit for specifications pertaining to each country.



But what happens in the Spanish case?

In the Spanish case, it is an adaptation of the European PRODCOM list with a little more detail. Instead of using 8 digits, 10 are used. The 9th digit is the significant one, in the sense that, if it is different from zero, then there is a difference with respect to the European coding. The 10th digit has no meaning; it is simply a control digit.

10-DIGIT RANKED LIST

- Level 1=> Economic sector.//Questionnaire template
- Level 2 => Economic activity: CNAE//CPA 2.2 4 digits
- Level 3 => 6-digit CPA
- Level 4 => European Prodcom 8 digits
- Level 5=> Spanish Prodcom 10 digits.

To make better use of the hierarchical information contained in the PRODCOM coding, and taking advantage of the change made by the adoption of the new NACE classification, and CPA rev2.1, this year we will present the data in the standard INEbase format, to make it easier for users to handle.

The following tables are therefore presented:

1. Domestic results by own production. (Quantity and value.) It's the same as the previous one, but now in a standard INEBase format. It also allows the user to choose a particular sector in the traditional way of a survey.
2. New. Grouped results of own production value at the domestic level, at the CNAE4D level, CPA (6 digits).
3. New. Results grouped at the Autonomous Community level of the value of own production at the CNAE4D level.

EXCEPTIONS IN CPA AND CNAE

Given the differences between NACE rev 2.1 and CNAE2025, the 4-digit subcodes of PRODCOM do not match up exactly with the CNAE2025.

Some PRODCOM product codes do not exactly match up with the 6-digit CPA.
