Structural Business Statistics: Trade Sector
Advance year 2017

Turnover in the Trade sector increased by 5.7% in 2017 and stood at 766,153 million euros

Retail trade accounted for 30.0% of the total turnover in the sector and for 55.1% of the employed personnel

Turnover of companies in the Trade sector¹ reached 766,153 million euros in 2017, which represented an increase of 5.7% as compared with the previous year.

The gross value added generated by companies in this sector stood at 106,949 million euros, 2.8% more than the previous year.

¹ The population under study comprises the total number of companies whose main activity is described in Section G of the CNAE-2009, that is, *Wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, Wholesale trade and commission trade and Retail trade*.

Results by divisions of activity³

The activity *Wholesale trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles* invoiced 453,009 million euros, which represented 59.1% of the sector and 7.0% more than in 2016. Wholesale companies employed 35.1% of the total personnel.

Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles accounted for 30.0% of the total turnover for the sector and for 55.1% of employed personnel. Turnover in the retail trade sector increased by 2.5%.

On the other hand, turnover in *Wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles* increased by 7.9%.

Results by groups of activity

At a more disaggregated level, the activity groups with the greatest contribution to total turnover were *Wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco* (17.5% of the total), *Other specialised wholesale*⁴ (17.4%) and *Wholesale of household goods* (13.1%).

The groups of activity that employed the greatest number of people were *Retail sale in non-specialised stores* (17.1% of employment in the sector), *Retail sale of other goods in specialised stores* (15.4%) and *Wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco* (11.8%).

On the other hand, those whose turnover increased the most with respect to the previous year were *Non-specialised wholesale trade* (16.1%), *Other specialised wholesale* (14.2%) and *Retail trade not in stores, stalls or markets*⁵ (13.8%).

³ The companies studied were classified according to their main activity. Likewise, all of the study variables referring to the company are assigned to said activity.

⁴ *Other specialised wholesale trade* includes wholesale trade of solid, liquid and gaseous fuels and related products, metals and metal ores, wood, construction materials and sanitary equipment, hardware, plumbing and heating equipment and supplies, chemical products, other half-finished products, scrap and waste.

⁵ *Retail trade not in stores, stalls or markets* includes trade conducted over the Internet, by mail order, at home, in vending machines, etc.


Productivity

Productivity (value added per employed person) for the Trade sector was 33,971 euros in 2017, 1.5% more than in the previous year.

The groups of activity that registered the highest productivity were *Wholesale of information and communication equipment* (59,273 euros), *Wholesale of household goods* (58,917 euros) and *Other specialised wholesale* (57,161 euros).

In turn, the least productive activities were *Retail sale via stalls and markets* (8,783 euros), *Retail sale of food, beverages and tobacco in specialised stores* (16,774 euros) and *Retail sale of other household equipment in specialised stores* (20,796 euros).

Year 2017**




Geographical destination of sales

In 2017, 88.1% of sales in the Trade sector were made within Spain, 7.4% went to other European Union countries, and 4.5% to the rest of the world.

The groups of activity with the highest percentage of sales outside Spain were *Retail trade not in stores, stalls or markets* (22.7% of total sales), *Wholesale of household goods* (19.2%) and *Wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco* (18.6%).

Investment in tangible assets

Investment in tangible assets carried out by the Trade sector amounted to 11,237 million euros in 2017. 49.4% came from companies engaged in *Wholesale trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles*, and 37.4% from companies in *Retail trade, excluding motor vehicle and motorcycles*.

In relation to the value added, investment in tangible assets accounted for 13.8% for companies involved in *Wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles* and for 10.5% of the value added for companies involved in *Wholesale trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles*.

Investment in tangible assets by divisions of activity. Year 2017



Results by size of the company

Trade is characterised by the predominance of very small companies. In 2017, 95.2% of the companies in the sector had less than 10 employees. These companies provided employment for 44.7% of personnel and their turnover represented 26.2% of the total.

In turn, large companies (with 250 or more employees) represented 0.1% of Trade companies, and their turnover accounted for 29.7% of the total in the sector. These companies employed 25.3% of the personnel.


Distribution (in percentage) of the number of companies, employed personnel and turnover by size of the company. Year 2017



Size of the company and productivity

Medium-sized companies (of 50 to 249 employees) had the highest productivity in 2017, with 55,174 euros. In turn, companies with less than 2 employees were the least productive, with 16,351 euros.

Results by Autonomous Communities

The Autonomous Communities with the greatest participation in turnover for the Trade sector in the year 2017 were Comunidad de Madrid (with 24.6% of the total), Cataluña (19.3%) and Andalucía (12.1%).

In turn, those with the least weight were La Rioja (0.5%), Cantabria (0.9%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1.3%).

The Autonomous Communities that most increased their turnover as compared with the previous year were Comunidad de Madrid (10.2%), País Vasco (9.2%) and Illes Balears (8.9%).

In contrast, Castilla y León and Aragón were the only ones that registered turnover decreases in the Trade sector (-1.1% and -1.0%, respectively).

Review and update of data

The data published today provide a preview of results. The final results, in greater detail, will be published in June 2019.

Methodological note

The Structural Business Statistics: Trade Sector is an annual structural statistical operation aimed at companies engaged in Trade, which includes wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, wholesale trade and commission trade, and retail trade.

This operation, governed by Regulation 295/2008 of the Parliament and of the Council of the European Union, allows us to ascertain the main structural and economic characteristics of companies in the sector under study by means of a broad set of variables relating to employed personnel, turnover and other income, purchases and consumption, personnel expenses, taxes and investments. The statistic includes economic aggregates such as the value of production and gross value added, as well as main indicators.

Type of survey: annual continuous survey.

Population scope: companies whose main activity is described in section G of CNAE-2009, which includes the sale and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, wholesale trade and commission trade and retail trade.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period: the calendar year, which, with some exceptions, coincides with the company's accounting year.

Sample size: the sample for the Results Preview is approximately 34,000 companies. The complete sample for the Final Results is made up of some 61,000 companies.

Collection method: completion of the questionnaire by the respondent, mainly via the Internet (IRIA system) and use of administrative sources.

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Annex

Structure and evolution in the Industry, Trade and Services sectors

The combined turnover of the *Industry, Trade and Non-financial Market Services* sectors exceeded 1,882 billion euros in 2017. Turnover in the *Industrial* sector increased by 7.9%, that of the *Services* sector by 6.0% and that of *Trade* by 5.7%.

The *Industrial* sector accounted for 32.8% of this turnover and employed 18.5% of the personnel. *Trade* invoiced 40.7% of the total, although its gross value added represented 22.5%. On the other hand, the *Services* sector accounted for 26.5% of turnover, 47.8% of the value added and employed 54.1% of the personnel of the three sectors.
