Municipal and Regional Elections on May 28, 2023

In the May 28 elections, 36,585,840 voters will be able to vote

Voters residing abroad may vote in the regional elections without the need for a prior request

The electoral roll can be consulted from 10 to 17 April

On May 28, 2023, municipal elections and regional elections will be held in 12 communities: Aragón, Principado de Asturias, Illes Balears, Canarias, Cantabria, Castilla-La Mancha, Comunitat Valenciana, Extremadura, Comunidad de Madrid, Región de Murcia, Comunidad Foral de Navarra and La Rioja, as well as elections to the Assemblies of the autonomous cities of Ceuta and Melilla.

In the municipal elections, 35,414,655 voters will be able to vote, including 414,581 belonging to EU countries and countries with which Spain has signed a reciprocity agreement to exercise the right to active suffrage and who have expressed their intention to vote in these elections.

In the regional elections that are held in 12 communities, 18,382,505 voters will be able to vote, of which 1,046,757 are absent residents living abroad (CERA).

Finally, 124,428 voters will be able to participate in the elections to the Assemblies of the autonomous cities of Ceuta and Melilla, of which 8,896 are CERA.

Elections are also held for the General Councils of the Historical Territory of Araba/Álava, Bizkaia and Gipuzkoa, the Island Councils of Canarías, the Island Councils of Ibiza, Mallorca and Menorca, the General Council of the Valle de Arán (Lleida) and, lastly, elections to entities with a territorial scope of less than a municipality (EATIM).

Vote of electors residing abroad

Voters residing abroad may vote in the regional elections and the Assemblies of Ceuta and Melilla without the need for a prior request. The Electoral Census Office (OCE) will send all voters the necessary documentation to vote in two independent mailings. Detailed information can be found at http://www.ine.es.

Consultation of the electoral census and claims

The electoral census of residents in Spain can be consulted from the 10 to 17 of April in the city councils and provincial delegations of the ECO. Votes resident abroad will be able to check their registration details at consular offices on these same dates.

Also available at the INE Electronic Headquarters (<u>https://sede.ine.gob.es</u>) is a service for consulting the registration data in the electoral census after accreditation of the voter's identity with the Cl@ve system (electronic DNI, among others). In the case of voters residing in Spain, it also shows the polling station and address.

Voters may present claims on their registration data in the city councils, consulates or in the provincial delegations of the ECO, within the same period, from 10 to 17 April.

As a new feature for these elections, voters residing in Spain may submit claims through the INE Electronic Office with the Cl@ve system and providing a valid certificate of registration in the Municipal Register of their residence.

Requests to opt out of receiving electoral propaganda

Those who make this request until 17 April will not receive electoral propaganda from political parties in the electoral campaign of these elections, in accordance with the provisions of the legislative change carried out in December 2018. Requests received later than 17 April will take effect in the following elections.

The request for exclusion can be made online, with the Cl@ve system, at the INE Electronic Headquarters or in the town halls, consular offices and provincial delegations of the OCE.

Delivery of copies of the electoral roll to the representatives of the proclaimed candidacies

In these elections, a new procedure for requesting and delivering copies of the electoral roll to the representatives of the proclaimed candidacies will be enabled, which consists of their capture from an INE portal that will be created for this purpose.

As a requirement, when requesting the copies, two email accounts must be provided that will be used to send the portal information and passwords for accessing the files and opening them.

Census cards

The census cards will be sent as of 1 May. They will inform you of the polling station and the polling place where the voter must vote.

Information

On the INE website (<u>http://www.ine.es</u>), relevant information is available on the actions of the ECO in these elections, count of voters, claims, polling stations and electoral premises, postal voting, deadlines and legal regulations.

In addition to the consultation of the current electoral roll, the following procedures are offered at the Electronic Headquarters of the INE, without the need for accreditation with electronic certificate:

- General consultation of polling stations and electoral premises
- Consultation of the status of the postal vote and certified sending number, if it was sent through the Post Office
- Completion of the vote-by-mail application

In addition, the provincial delegations of the ECO deal with consultations on actions within their competence (registration in the census, polling stations and voting places, census cards, postal voting, etc.) at their offices and via the telephone number +34 901 101 900.
