In the elections to the Parliament of Andalucía, 6,541,722 electors will be able to vote

Electors residing abroad who wish to vote must apply by 3 November

The electoral census can be consulted from 15 to 22 October

On 2 December 2018, 6,541,722 electors will be able to vote in the elections to the Parliament of Andalucía, of which 6,298,902 reside in Andalucía and 242,820 abroad.

Application for a vote by electors residing abroad

Electors residing abroad who wish to vote must apply to the Provincial Delegation of the Electoral Census Office corresponding to their registration until 3 November. The Electoral Census Office is sending the official application form to these electors with the right to vote.

Applications can be submitted online. To do so, it is necessary to have an electronic certificate recognised by the INE Electronic Office or to use the password sent with the official form.

The form is also available at consulates and on the websites of the Regional Government of Andalucía, of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation and of the National Statistics Institute.

Complaints from voters

The electoral census can be consulted from 15 to 22 October in the city councils and provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office. Electors resident abroad will be able to check their registration details at consulates on these same dates.

The electors may present claims on their registration data in the city councils, consulates or in the provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office, within the same period, from 15 to 22 October.

Census cards

From 5 November, the Electoral Census Office will send each voter residing in Spain a census card with the table and the voting place where they are entitled to vote.

Consultations of voters

On the website of the National Statistics Institute (http://www.ine.es), interesting information is available on the actions of the Electoral Census Office in these elections, count of voters, complaints, polling stations and voting places, postal voting, deadlines and legal regulations.

It is also available in the INE Electronic Office (<u>https://sede.ine.gob.es</u>) a consultation service to the registration data in the electoral census and the table and address of the voting place, upon accreditation of the identity of the voter with a recognised electronic certificate (electronic ID among others).



In addition, a general consultation service of polling stations and voting places is offered through the same Office, without the need for accreditation.

In addition, the provincial delegations of the Electoral Census Office deal with consultations on actions within their competence (registration in the census, polling stations and voting places, census cards, postal voting, etc.) in their offices and by phone at **901.101.900**.
