

Vital Statistics (Births, Deaths and Marriages))
First half of 2018. Provisional data

The number of births decreased by 5.8% in the first half of 2018, while the number of deaths increased by 2.1%

The natural population growth showed a negative balance of 46,590 people during the first half of the year


The number of marriages decreased by 5.7% as compared with the same period in 2017

Births

In the first half of the year, 179,794 births were registered, 5.8% less than in the same period the previous year.

The number of births in the first half of the year thus continues the downward trend of recent years, only interrupted in 2014.

Number of births during the first semester of each year




The number of births to foreign mothers accounted for 20.0% of all births, compared to 18.8% in the same half of 2017.

Deaths

During the first half of the year, 226,384 people died in Spain, 2.1% more than in the first half of 2017. This increase was mainly due to the high mortality recorded in January.

Number of deaths during the first semester of each year




Natural increase

During the first six months of 2018, natural population growth (i. e. the difference between births and deaths) was -46,590 people.

This negative balance, which is higher than that recorded in the same period of 2017, was due to both higher mortality rates and lower birth rates this year.


Natural growth during the first semester of each year



Marriages

During the first half of 2018, 69,777 marriages were registered, 5.7% less than in the same period in 2017.

Data by Autonomous Community

The number of births decreased during the first half of 2018 in all Autonomous Communities. La Rioja (-13.7%), Extremadura (-10.3%) and Cantabria (-7.8%) recorded the greatest decreases.

On the other hand, the number of deaths increased in 12 Autonomous Communities. The greatest increases were recorded in Canarias (10.2%), Andalucía (5.3%) and Cantabria (5.1%).



Natural increase by Autonomous Community. First semester of 2018




The natural increase (births minus deaths) was positive in the first half of 2018 in three Autonomous Communities: Comunidad de Madrid (3,714 people), Región de Murcia (997) and Illes Balears (428).

In contrast, the highest negative natural increases were found in Galicia (-9,135 people), Castilla y León (-7,857) and Comunitat Valenciana (-5,959).

Regarding the number of marriages, the greatest increases were registered in Cantabria (6.8%), La Rioja (5.6%) and Canarias (1.1%), while the most pronounced decreases were registered in Galicia (-14.7%), Comunidad de Madrid (-14.1%) and Extremadura (-10.2%).

Review and update of data

Methodological note

The Vital Statistics (VS) quantify the number of births, deaths and marriages taking place on Spanish territory. Its main sources of information are the birth, death and marriage bulletins which are completed at the time of registering said demographic events in the Civil Register, and transmitted by those who are responsible to the Provincial Delegations of the INE.

This operation is prepared in collaboration with the statistical services of the Autonomous Communities, pursuant to the agreement signed with them for this purpose.

Based on the Vital Statistics, the INE compiles the Mortality Tables for Spain, and a collection of Basic Demographic Indicators, which allow a follow-up of the historical evolution of the behaviour of the population resident in Spain with regard to births, deaths and marriages.

Population scope: births, deaths and marriages of persons occurring in Spanish territory.

Geographical scope: national, Autonomous Communities and Cities, provinces and islands.

Reference period of the results: population data are provided as at 1 January and 1 July of each year.

Frequency of dissemination: six-monthly.
