Survey on Company Expenditure on Environmental Protection Year 2008

Expenditure on industrial environmental protection increases 3.9% in 2008 as compared with the previous year

Expenditure by industrial establishments on environmental protection rose to 3,129.4 million euros in the year 2008, indicating an increase of 3.9% as compared with the previous year.

The current expenditure allocated to environmental protection increased 4.7%, while the investment in integrated equipment and in independent equipment increased 3.0%.

Expenditure by environmental area

¹ In the 2008 questionnaire, a specific new section has been introduced for the area of land, ground and surface waters, corresponding to area 4 of the Classification of environmental protection activities

² It includes the sections of the questionnaire that cannot be assigned directly to a specific environmental area.

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The most important investments³ were aimed at the reduction of atmospheric emissions (although their total value recorded a 0.7% decrease as compared with the previous year), at the management of wastewater (its value increased 4.5%) and at waste management (which increased 5.6%).

Data by industrial sector

The electricity sector invested the most in environmental protection during the year 2008, with 567.2 million euros, 14.3% more than the previous year.

Likewise, worth noting was the investment by the sectors *Metallurgy and manufacture of metallic products* (180.7 million euros, indicating an annual increase of 10.8%), *Various non-metallic ore products* (146.4 million euros and a reduction of 2.5%) and the *Chemical and pharmaceutical* industry (134.2 million euros and a 2.7% decrease).

Investment by industrial sector

³ Investment in each of these areas of environmental protection includes both expenditure on investment in independent equipment and installations, and expenditure in relation to investment in integrated equipment.

Regarding current expenses, worth noting were the sectors *Food, beverages and tobacco* (331.6 million euros and an increase of 8.5%), the *Chemical and pharmaceutical* industry (323.1 million, that is, 4.5% more) and *Metallurgy and manufacture of metallic products* (261.4 million euros and growth of 6.9% as compared with 2007).

Data by Autonomous Community

Galicia was the Autonomous Community that invested the most in environmental protection during the year 2008 in industry, with 245.6 million euros, which accounted for 16.0% of the national total.

Similarly, Cataluña (with 234.8 million euros, 15.3% of the total) and Castilla y León (214.2 million euros, 14% of the total) were of note.

As regards current expenditure, Cataluña also spent the most, with 445.1 million euros, 27.9% of the national total.

Also of note were Andalucía (with 179.5 million euros, 11.3% of the total), Comunitat Valenciana (with 158.5 million euros, 9.9%) and País Vasco (with 155.1 million, 9.7% of the total).
